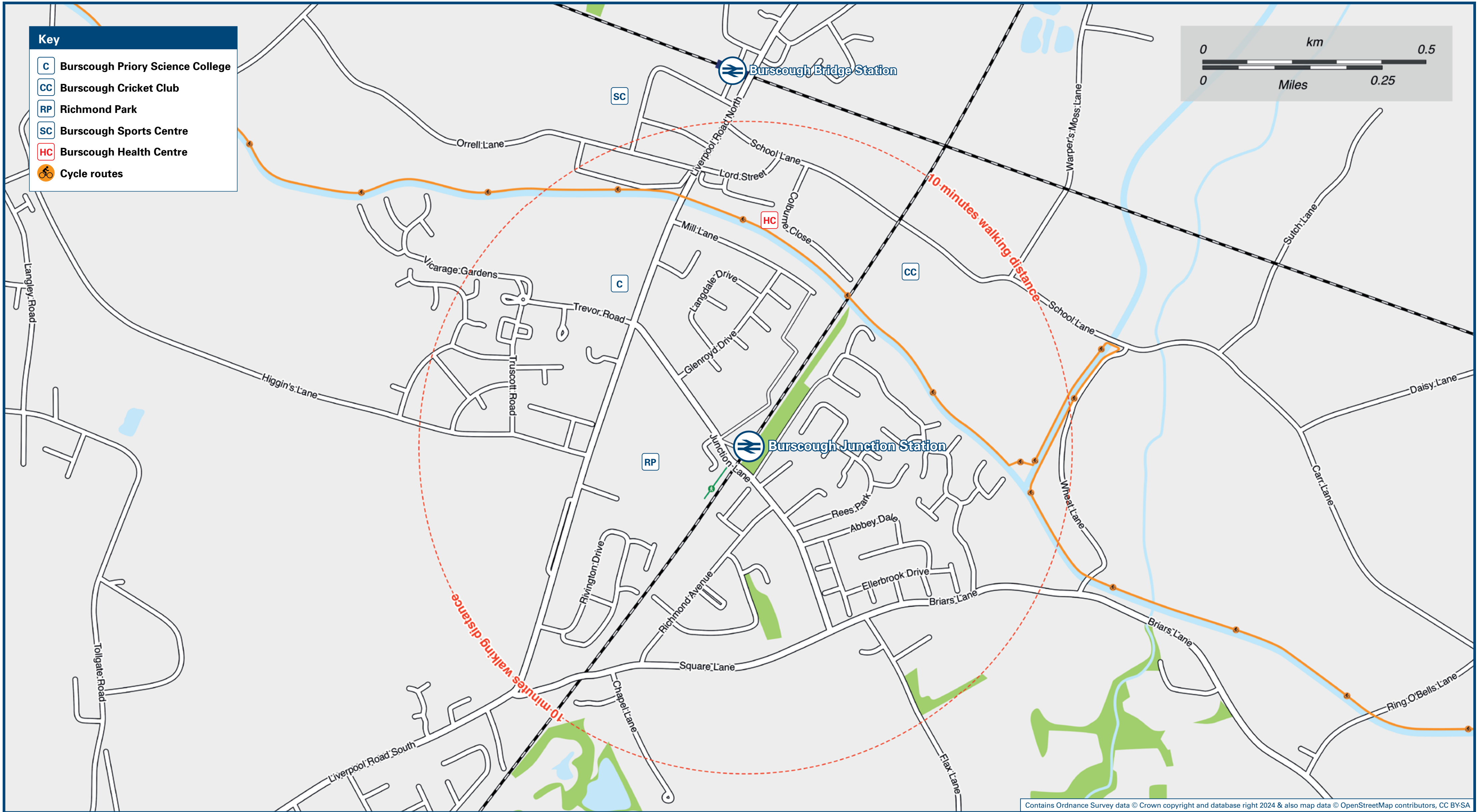




# Burscough Junction Station
