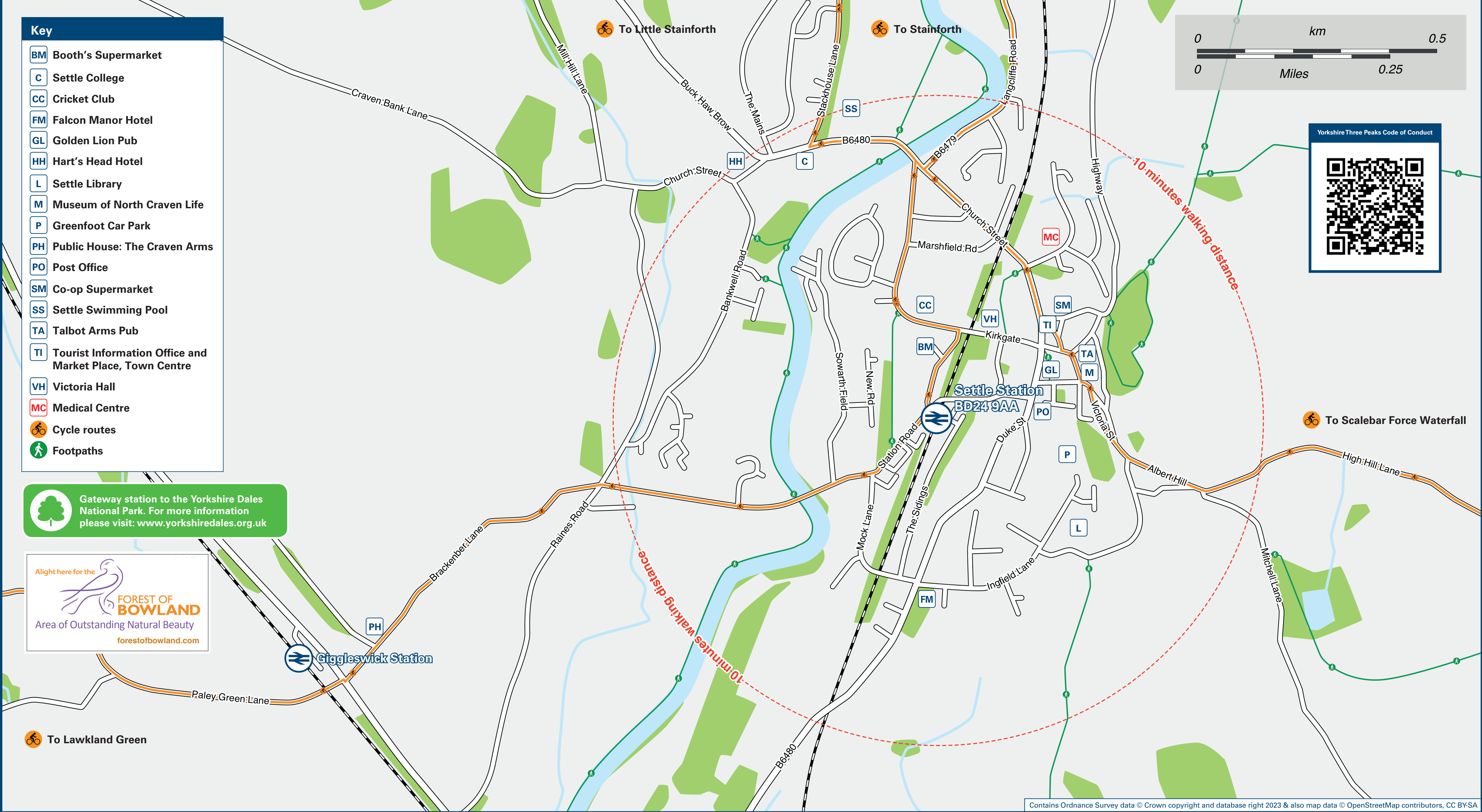

Notes

Bus routes 580 and 581 (The Craven Connection) operate Mondays to Saturdays from Settle to Skipton (580) and to Ingleton and Kirkby Lonsdale (581) with onward connections to Lancaster on bus routes 81 and 82. Additional bus services operate into the Yorkshire Dales National Park on Sundays & Bank Holidays during the summer months. Visit www.dalesbus.org for full details of local bus services.

Direct trains operate to Skipton, Gargrave, Hellfield, Long Preston and Horton-in-Ribblesdale Station.

* Bus route 11 operates a limited service Mondays to Saturdays only from Settle to Tosside and Horton in Ribblesdale.

+ Bus route 75 operates a limited service Saturdays during the summer months only from Settle to Malham, Kirkby Malham, Gargrave and Skipton. During the winter months operates between Malham and Skipton only.
