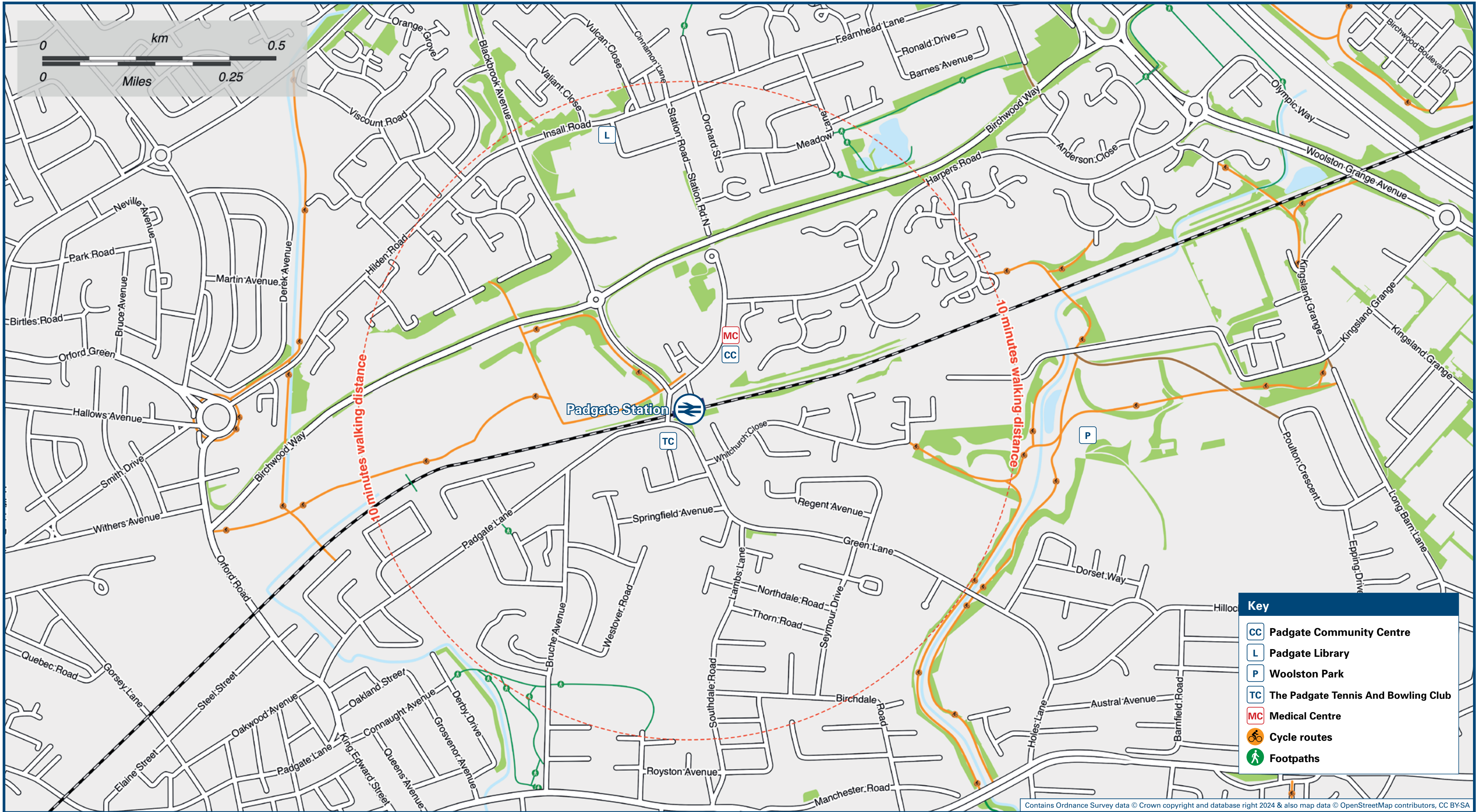




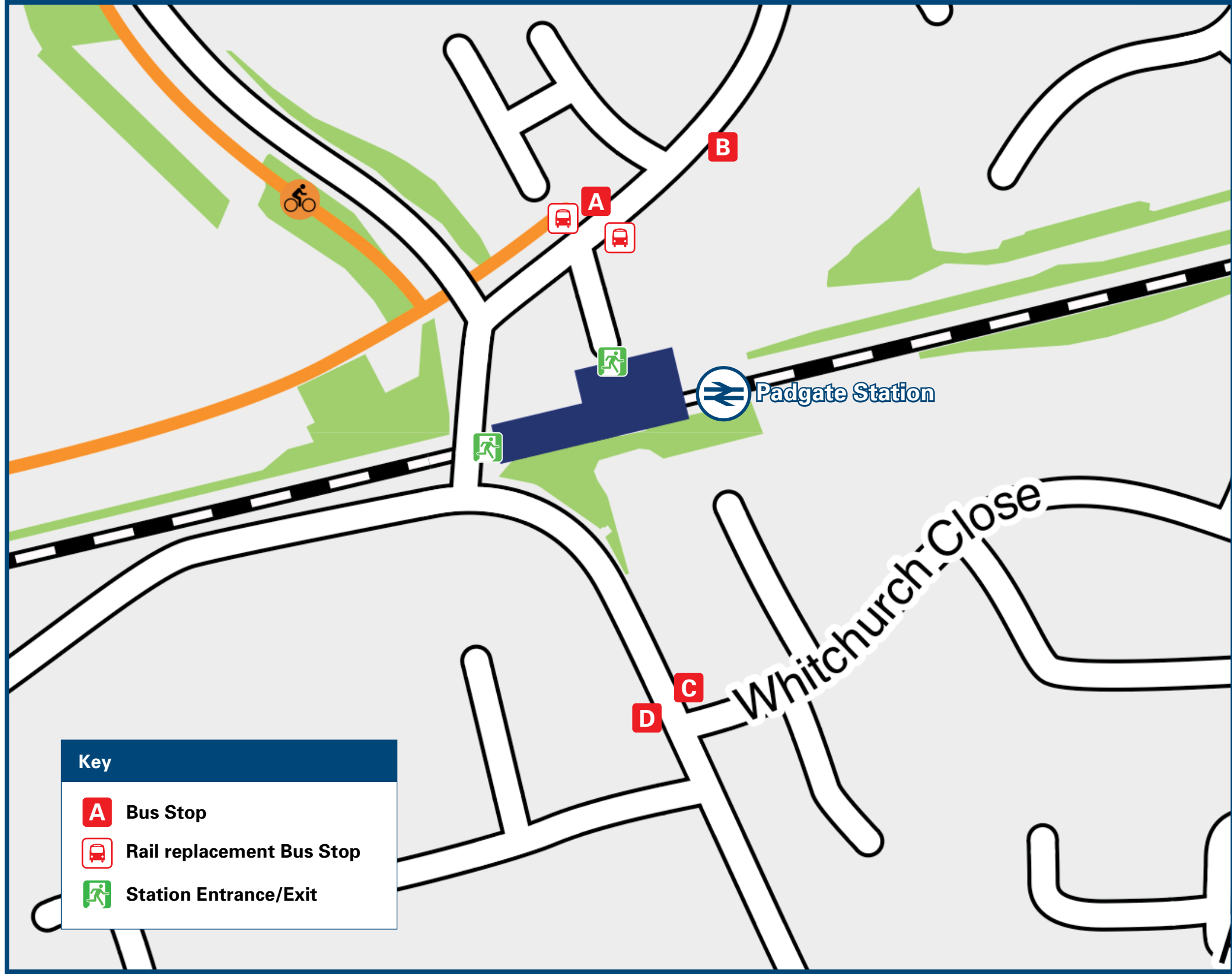
Padgate Station
