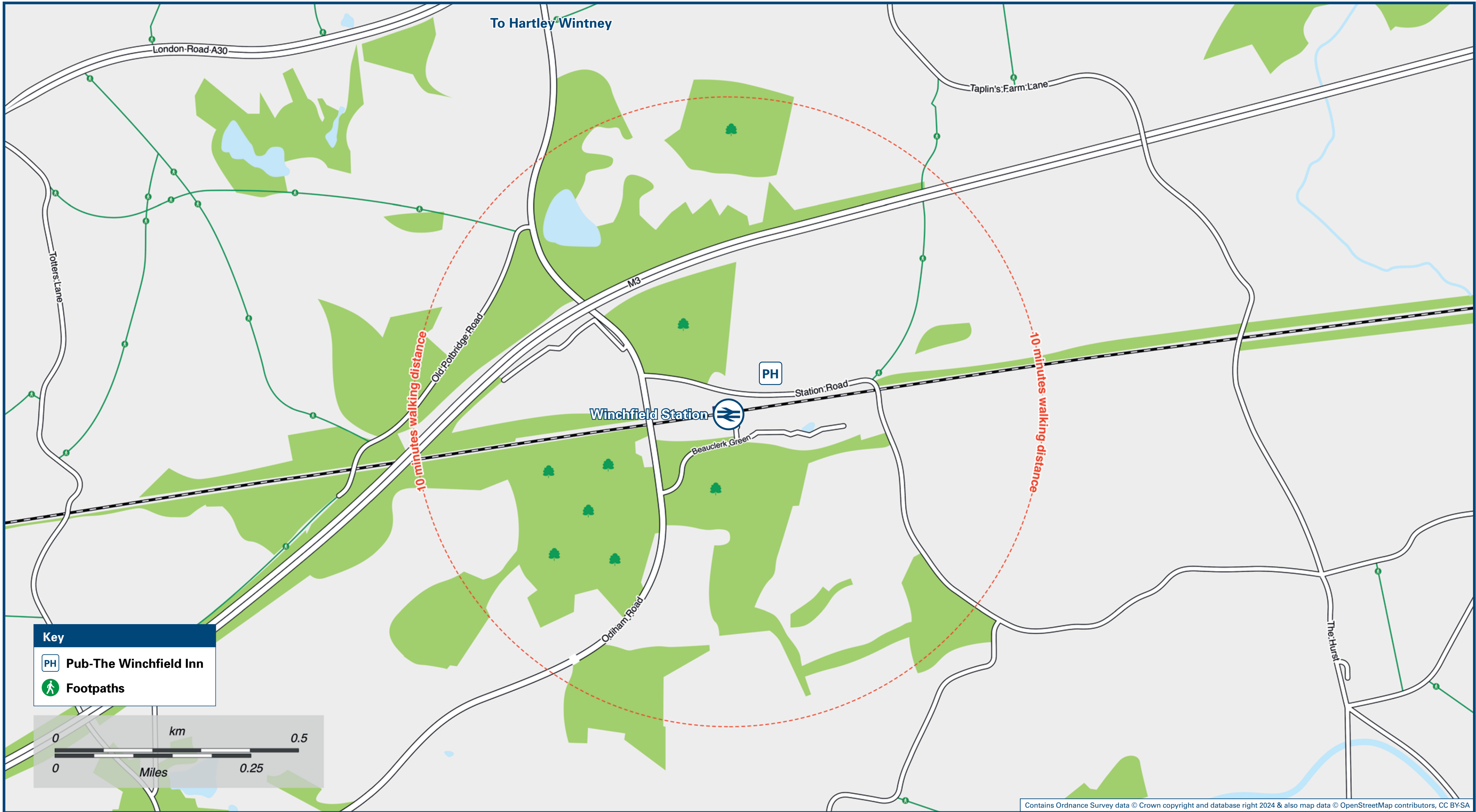




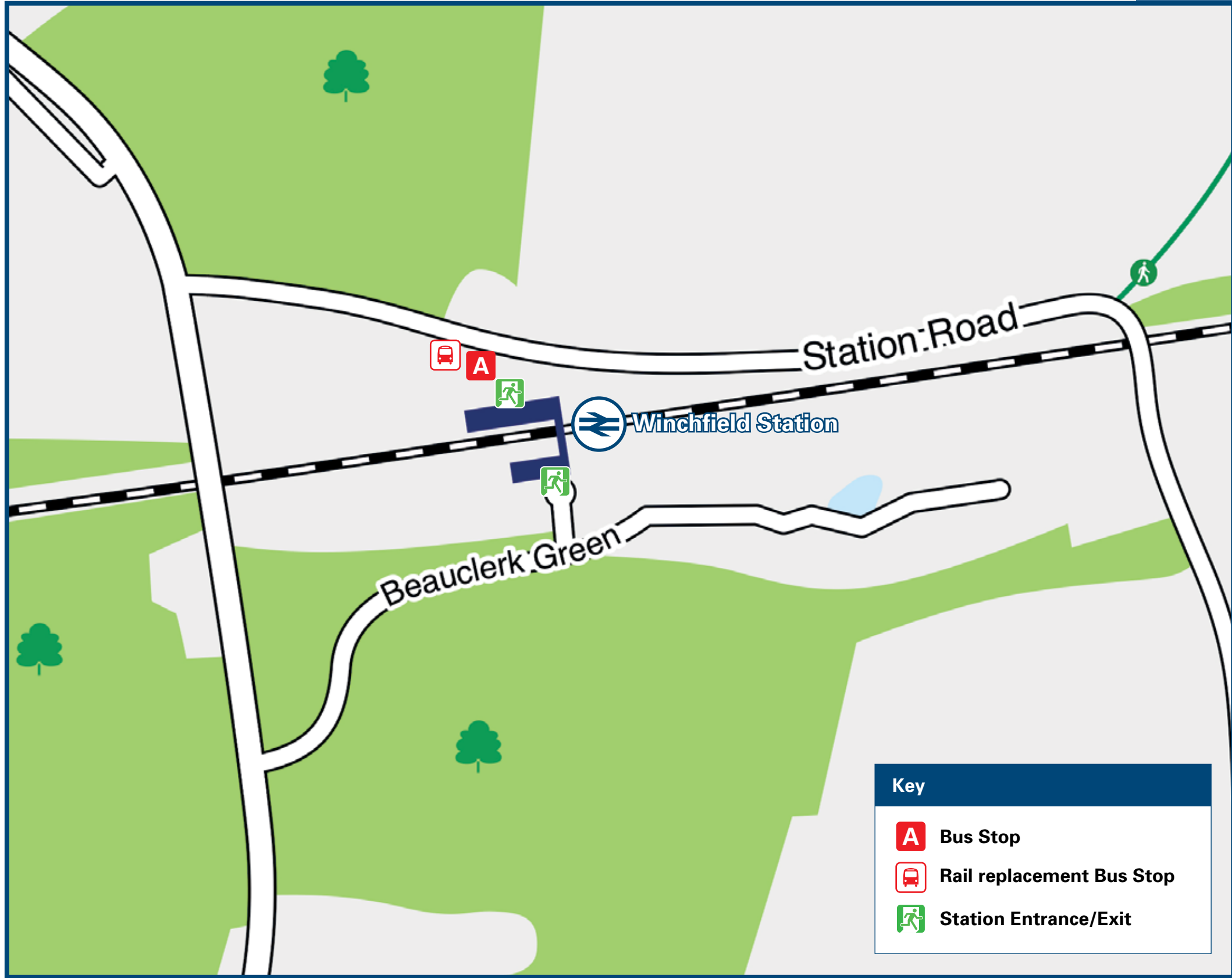

THERE ARE NO FREQUENT BUS SERVICES SERVING WINCHFIELD STATION

A limited bus service operates from Winchfield station stop {A} on Mondays and Wednesdays only (No booking is required for this service):

Bus route 2 operates at 09:00 to Hook, Phoenix Green, Hartley Wintney, Yateley, Blackwater and The Meadows Shopping Centre.

Bus route 2 operates at 11:20 to Phoenix Green, Hartley Wintney, Yateley, Blackwater and The Meadows Shopping Centre.

Bus route 2 operates at 12:50 to Hook and Phoenix Green.
