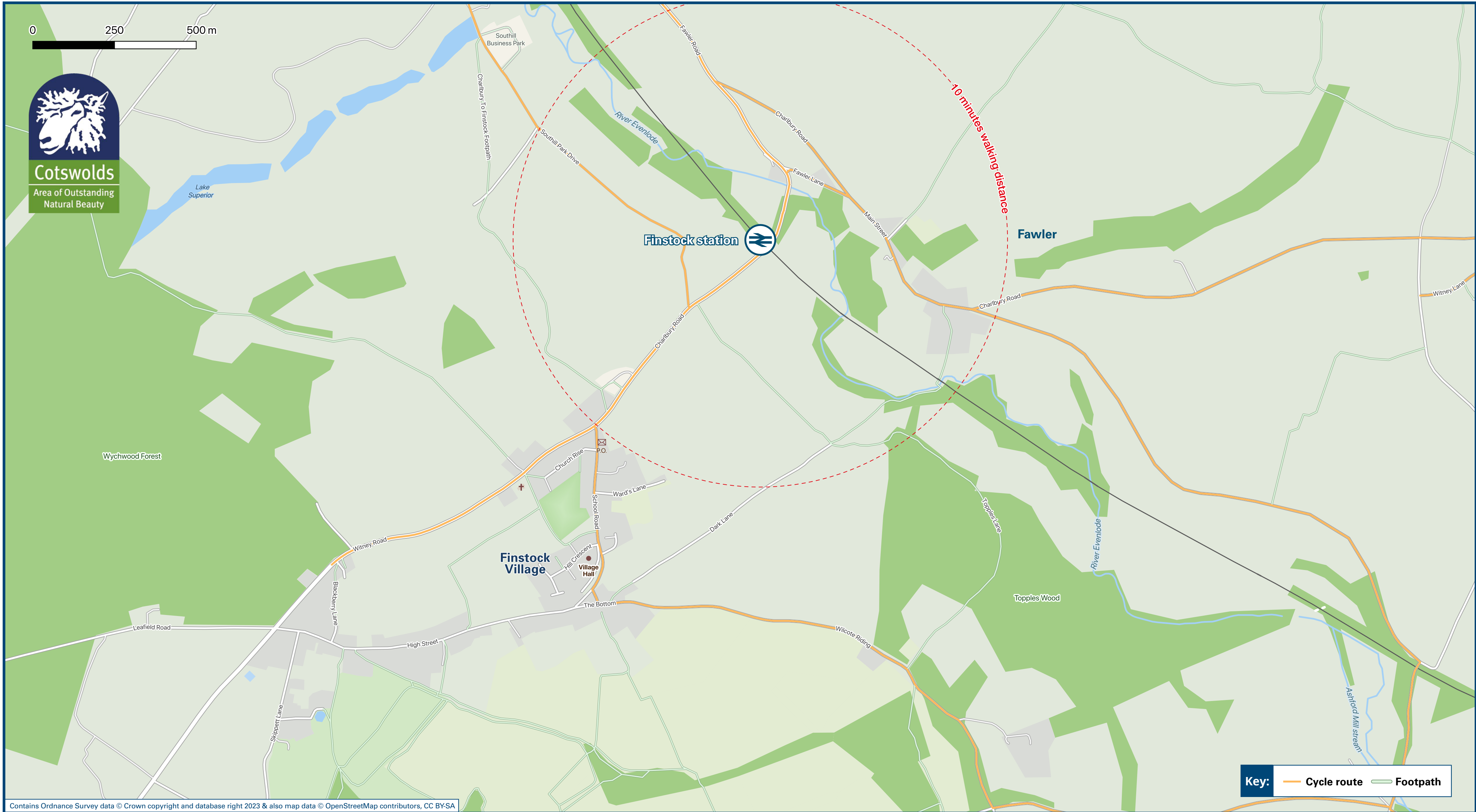




Finstock Station
