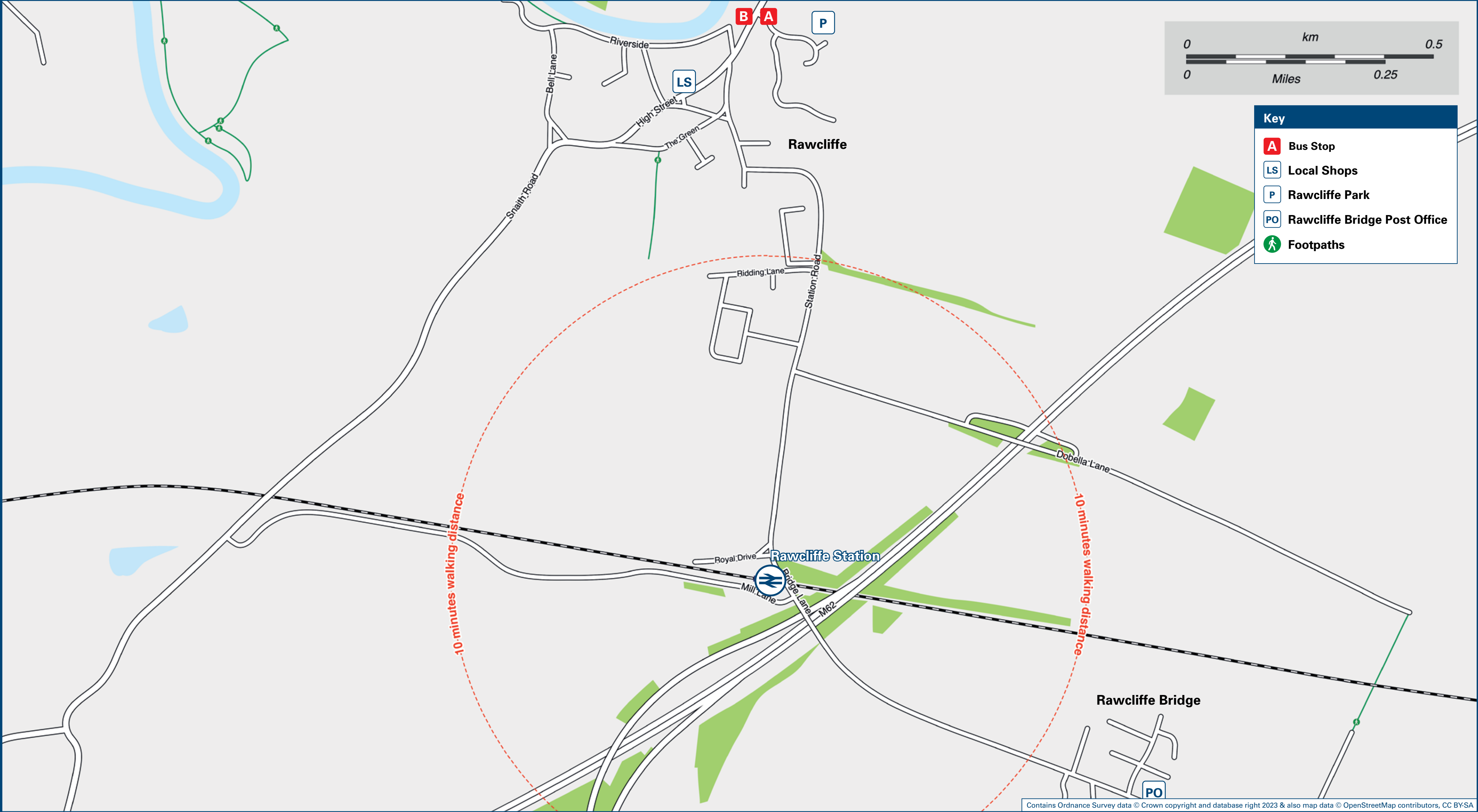




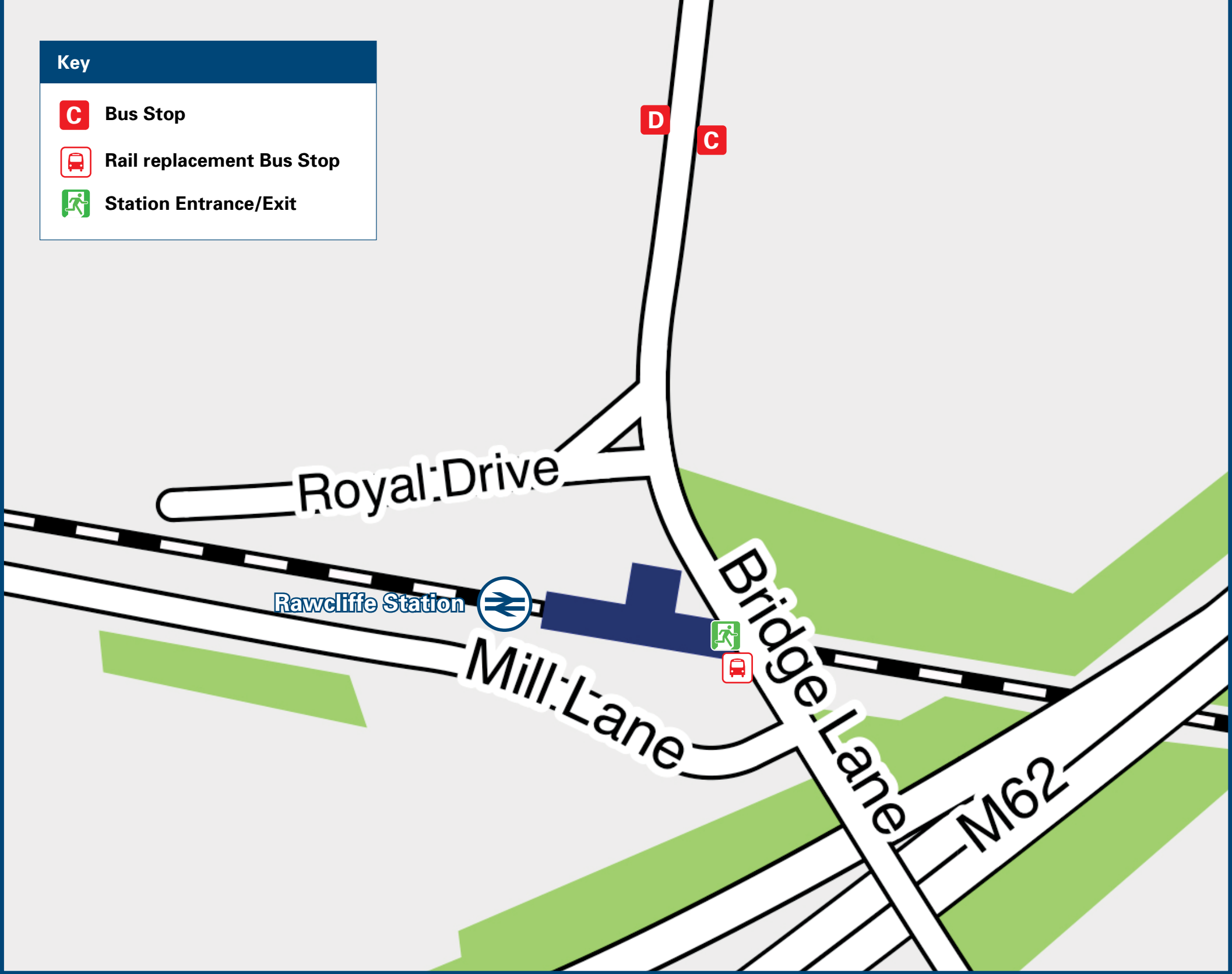
# Rawcliffe Station

#### THERE ARE NO FREQUENT LOCAL BUS SERVICES CALLING AT RAWCLIFFE RAILWAY STATION

The nearest bus stop is stop **C**, on Station Road, where bus route 88 runs a (limited Mondays to Saturdays only service) Southbound to Rawcliffe Bridge; Or a Northbound bus 88 (limited Mondays to Saturdays only) service from stop **D** to Goole; Or bus stops **A** and **B** at Rawcliffe Hall Gardens - please see local map - where bus route 401 runs a Mondays to Saturdays service; Eastbound from stop **B** calling at: Goole. Westbound from stop **A** calling at: West Cowick, Snaith, Camblesforth and Selby.

Rawcliffe Station has no taxi rank or cab office. Advance booking is essential, please consider using the following local operators: (Inclusion of this number doesn't represent any endorsement of the taxi firm)
