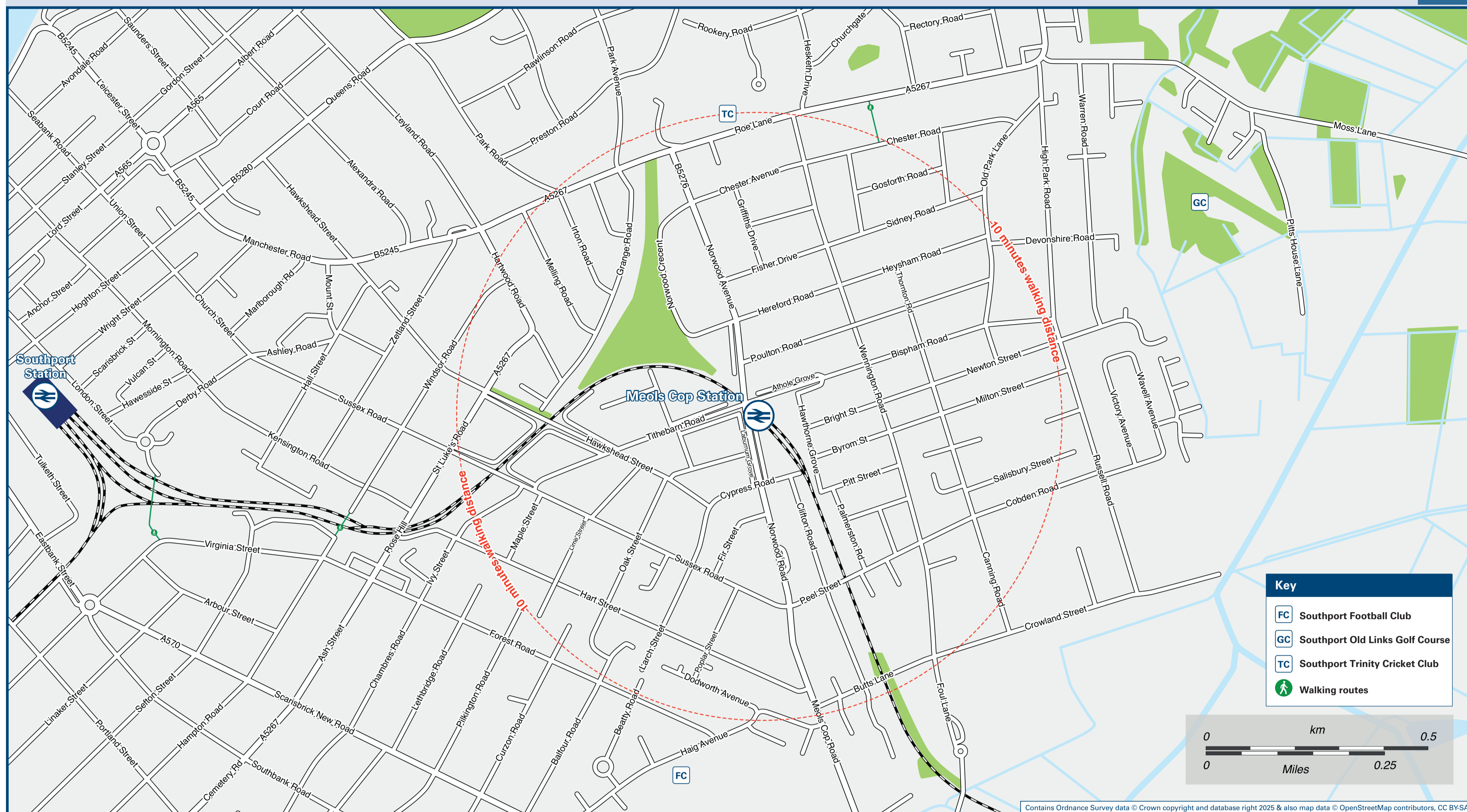




# Meols Cop Station
