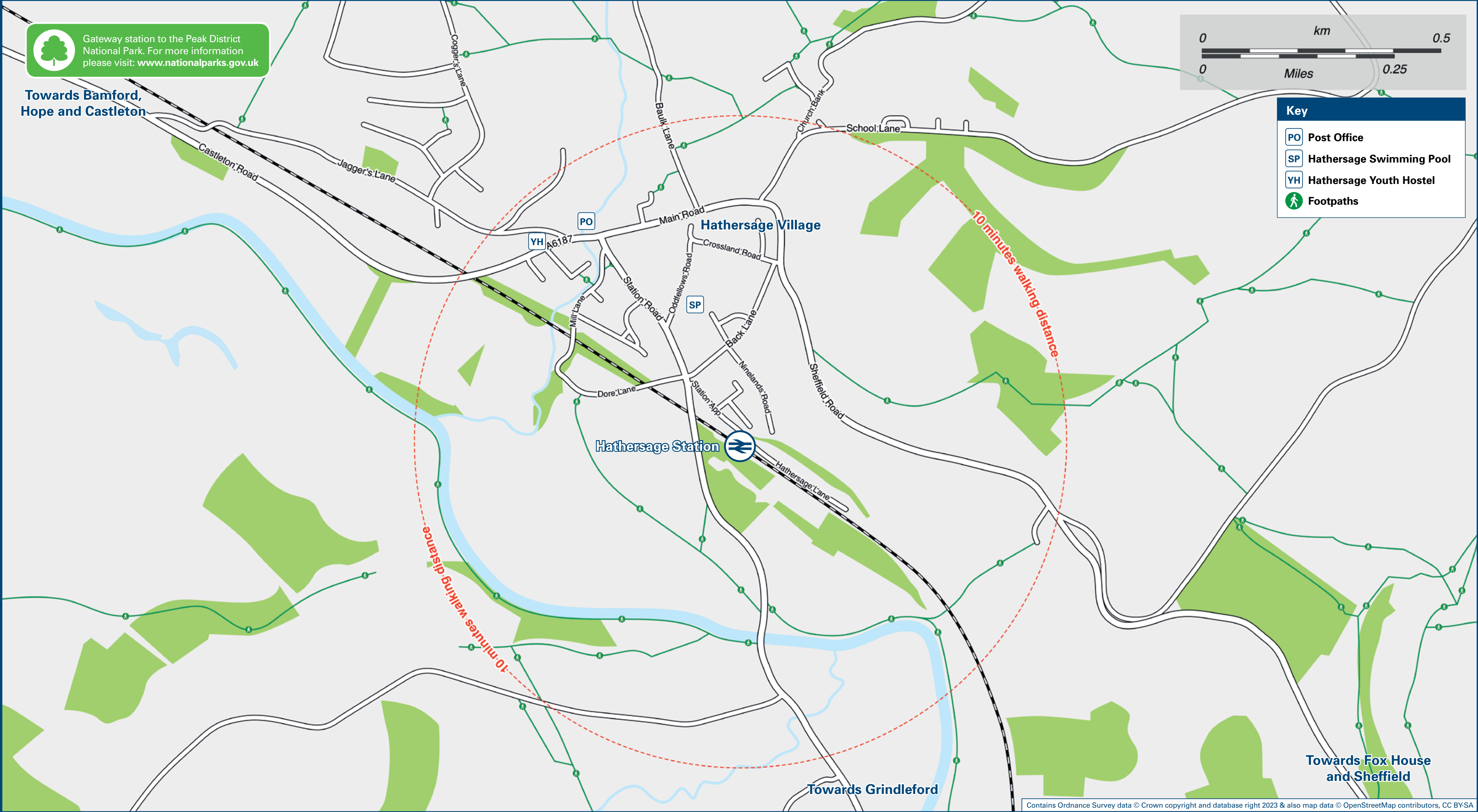




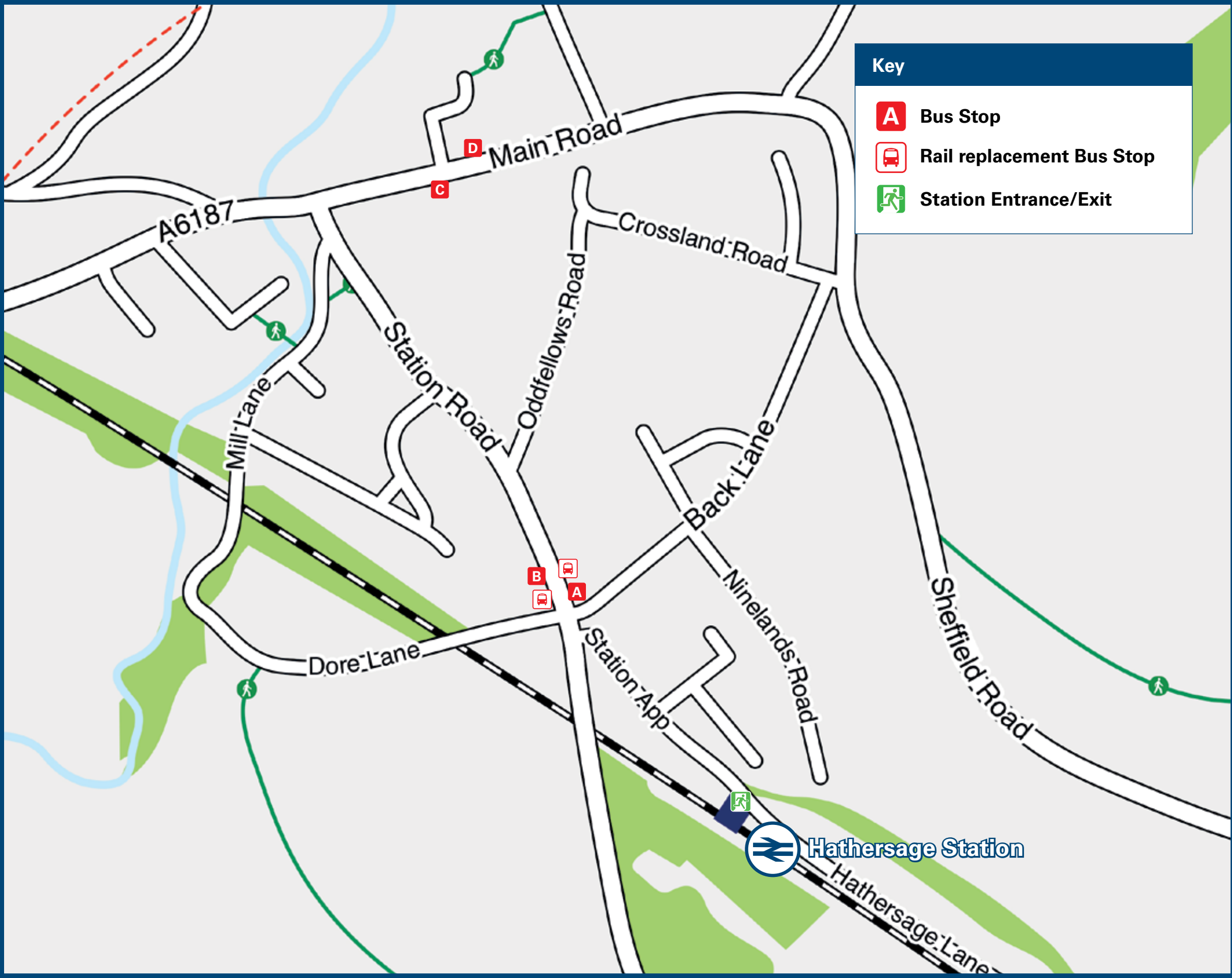
# Hathersage Station
