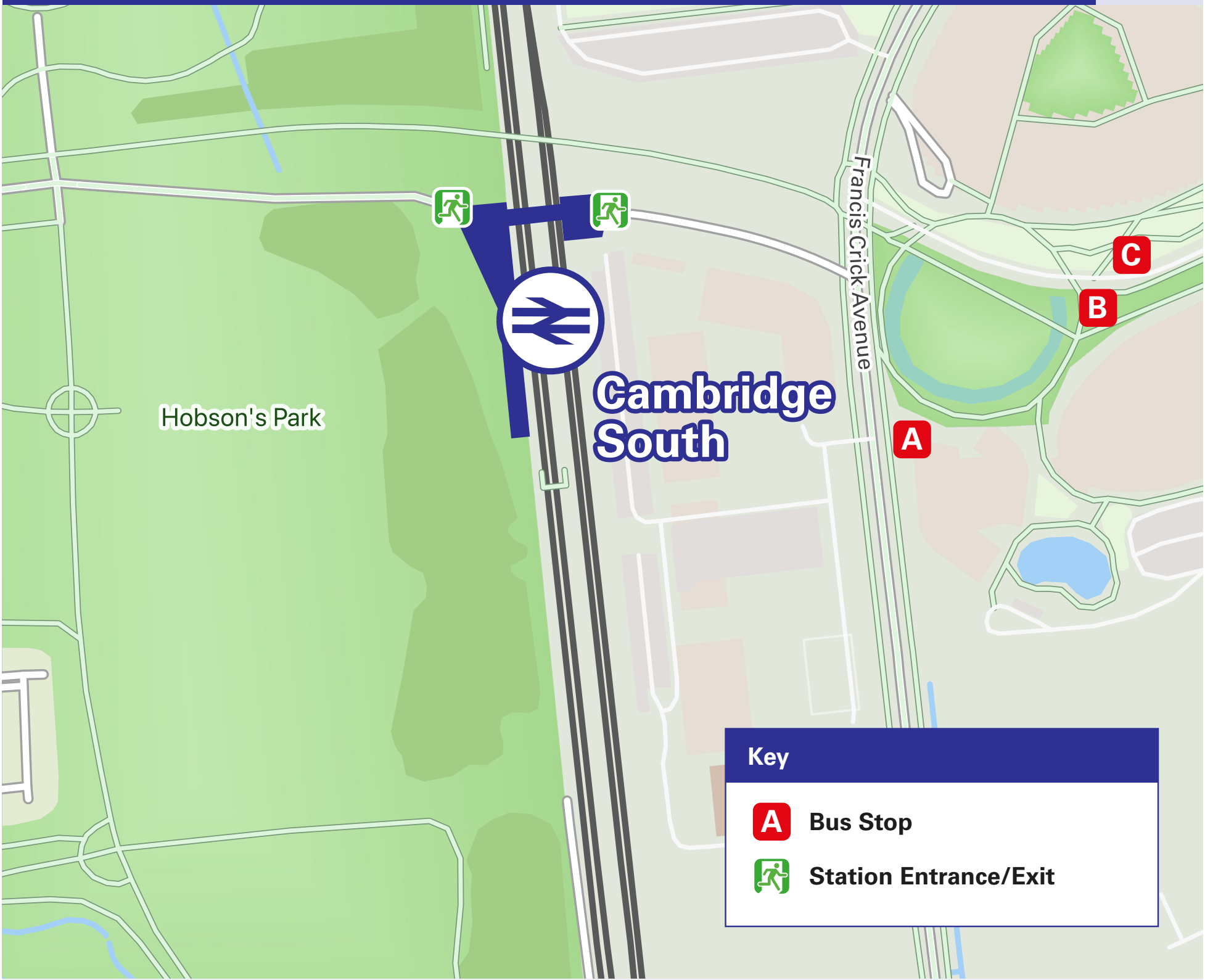

Key

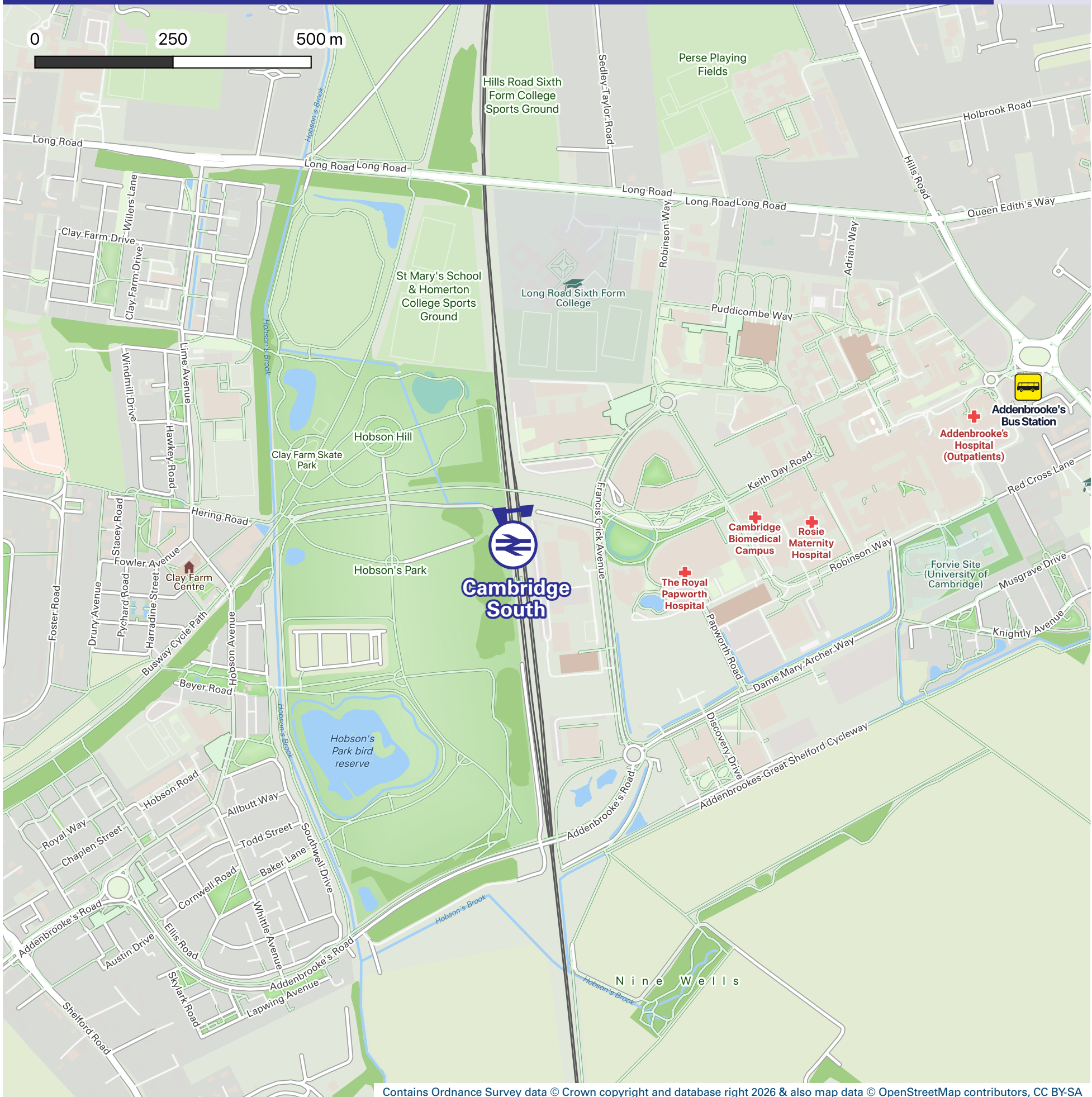
- A** Bus Stop

Passengers travelling from Cambridge South should go to Cambridge station to board rail replacement buses for their onward journey.

Passengers travelling to Cambridge South should use the rail replacement bus to Cambridge station, then continue their journey using local bus services or other onward travel options.
