THERE ARE NO FREQUENT BUS SERVICES SERVING SUNNYMEADS RAILWAY STATION

Bus route 305 operates Schooldays only from stop {A} at 08:01 to Wraysbury Village, Hythe End, Staines High Street and Egham Hythe (Magna Carta School).

Bus route 305 operates Schooldays only from stop {B} at 15:44 to Horton Village and Colnbrook.

Additional limited bus route 305 buses depart from Wraysbury Village Mondays to Fridays only to Horton Village, Colnbrook, Hythe End and Staines.

Bus route A60 operates early mornings daily from stop {A} to Heathrow Airport Terminal 5. This service starts from 28th August 2023, call Carlone Buses on 01784 488 009 for more details.

For bus times from Wraysbury Village call Traveline on 0871 200 22 33 or Bear Buses on 020 8867 0617

It's a 20 to 25 minutes walk from Sunnymeads station to Wraysbury Village Centre.
