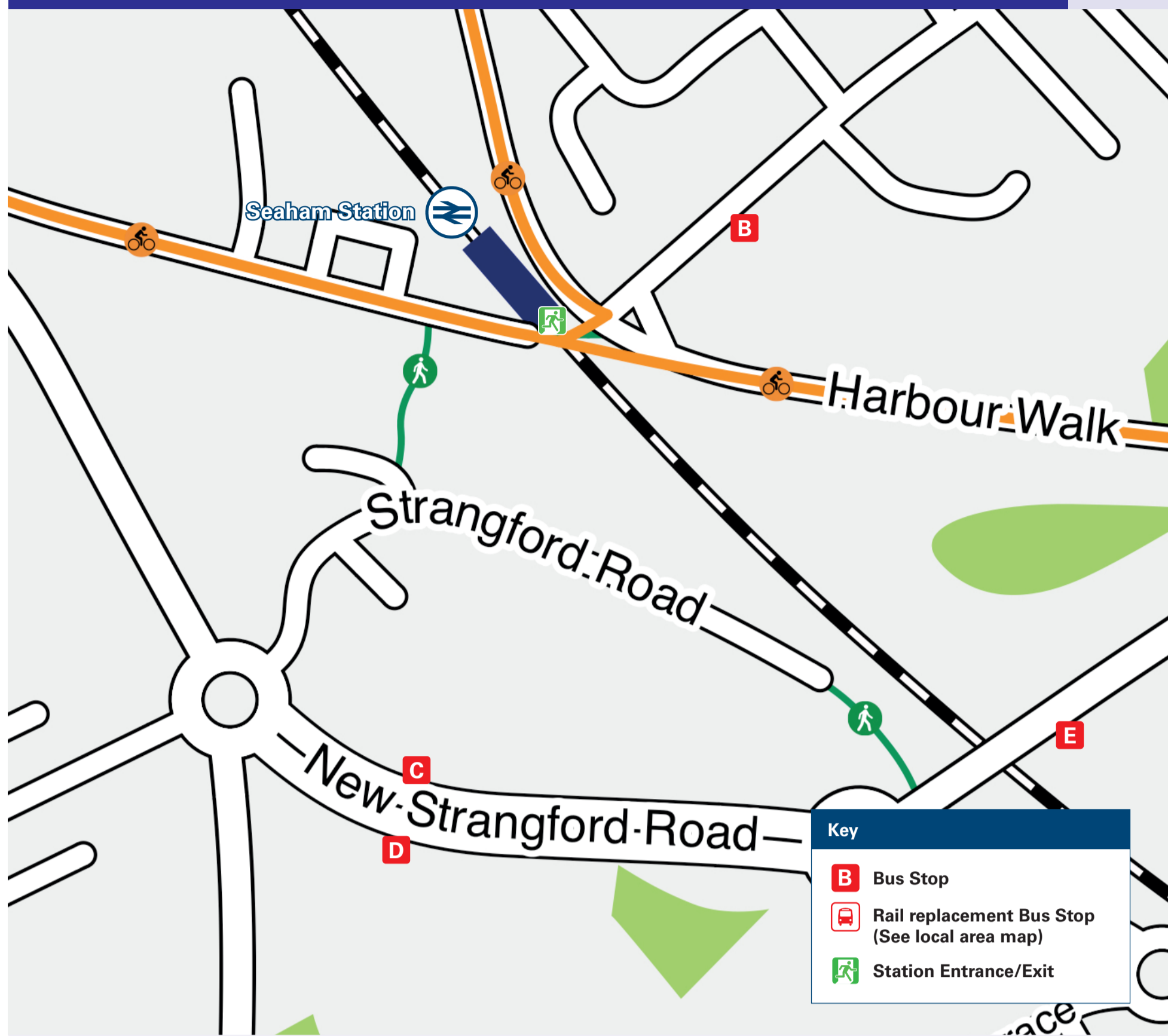

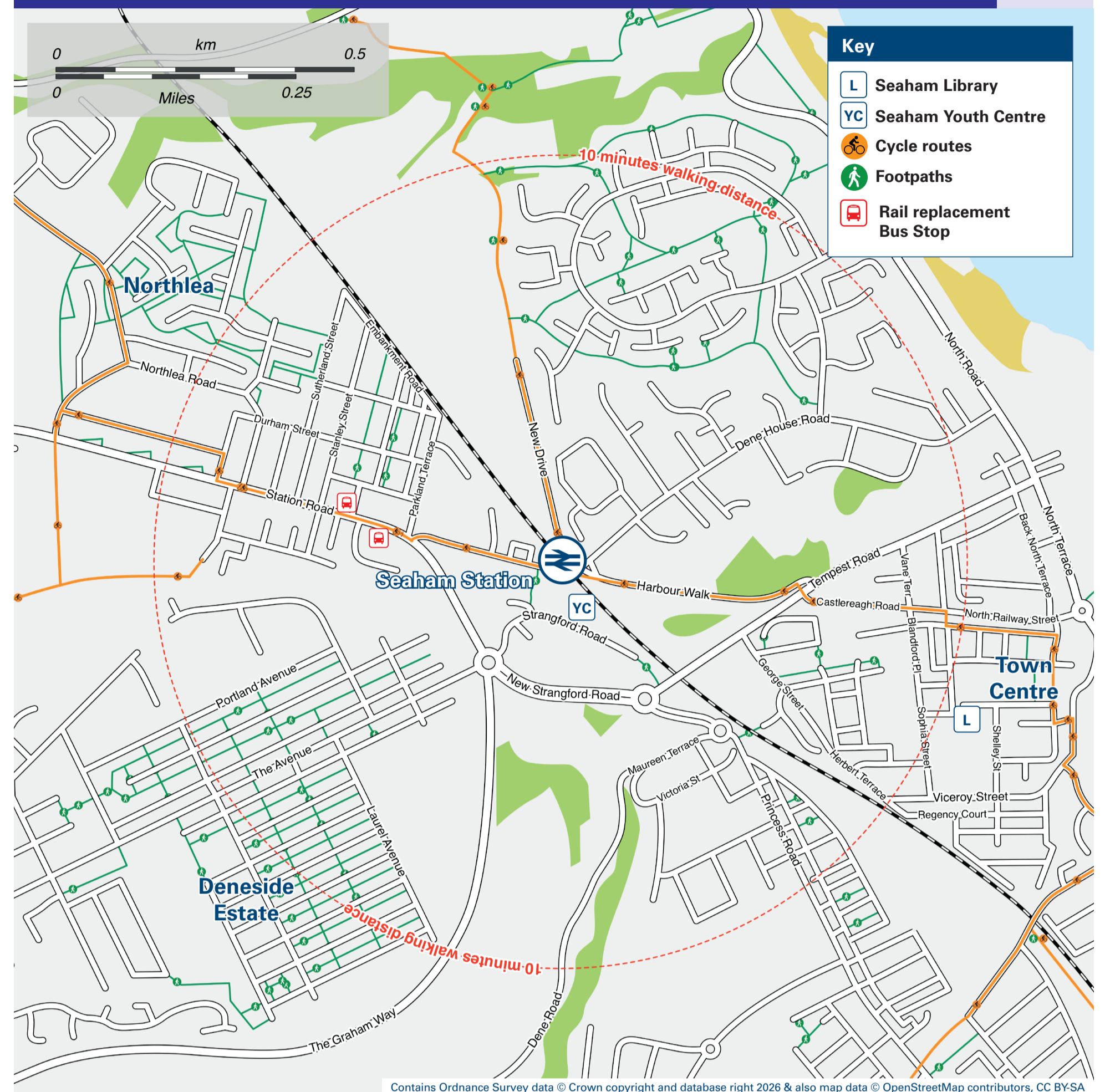
Seaham Station
