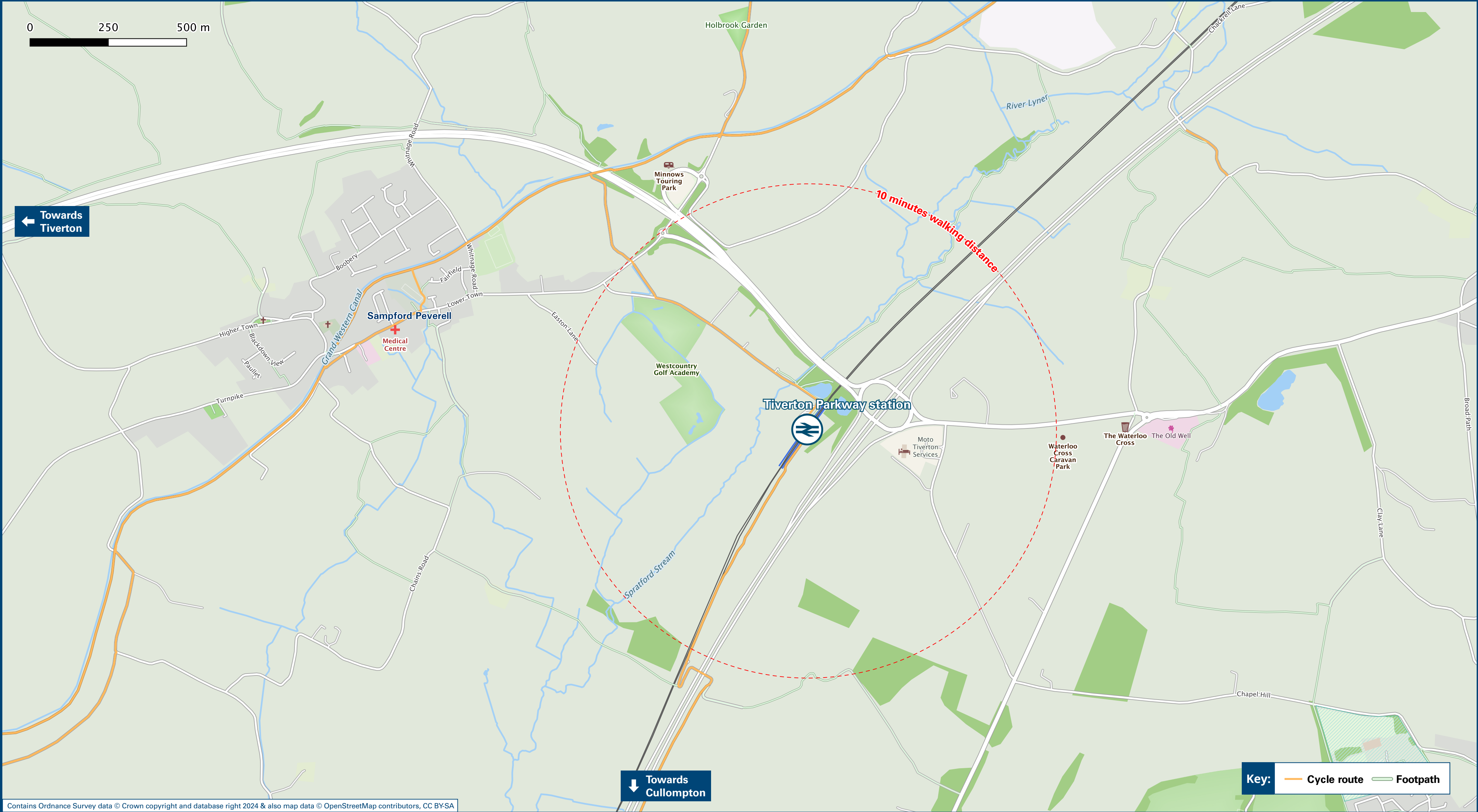




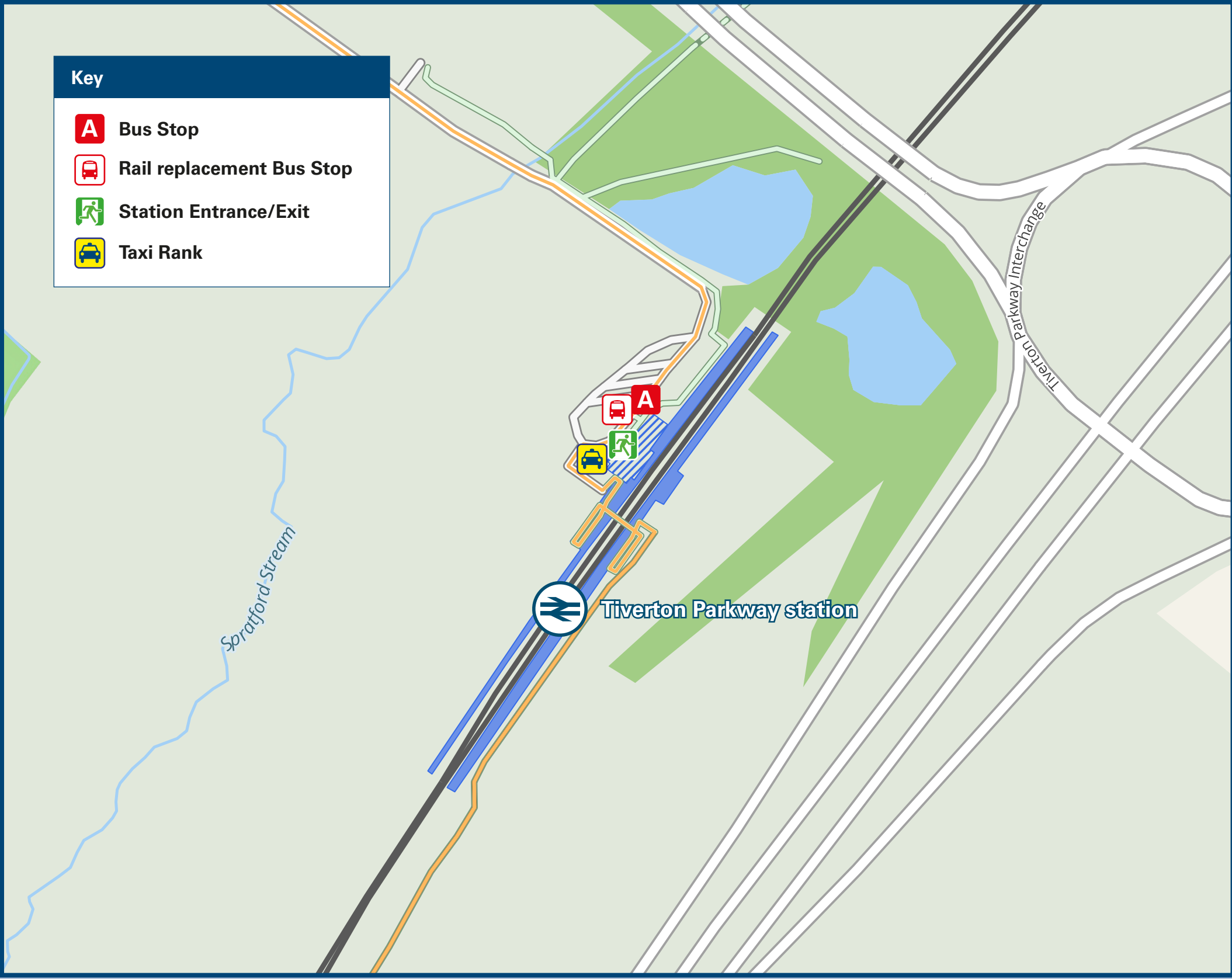
Tiverton Parkway Station
