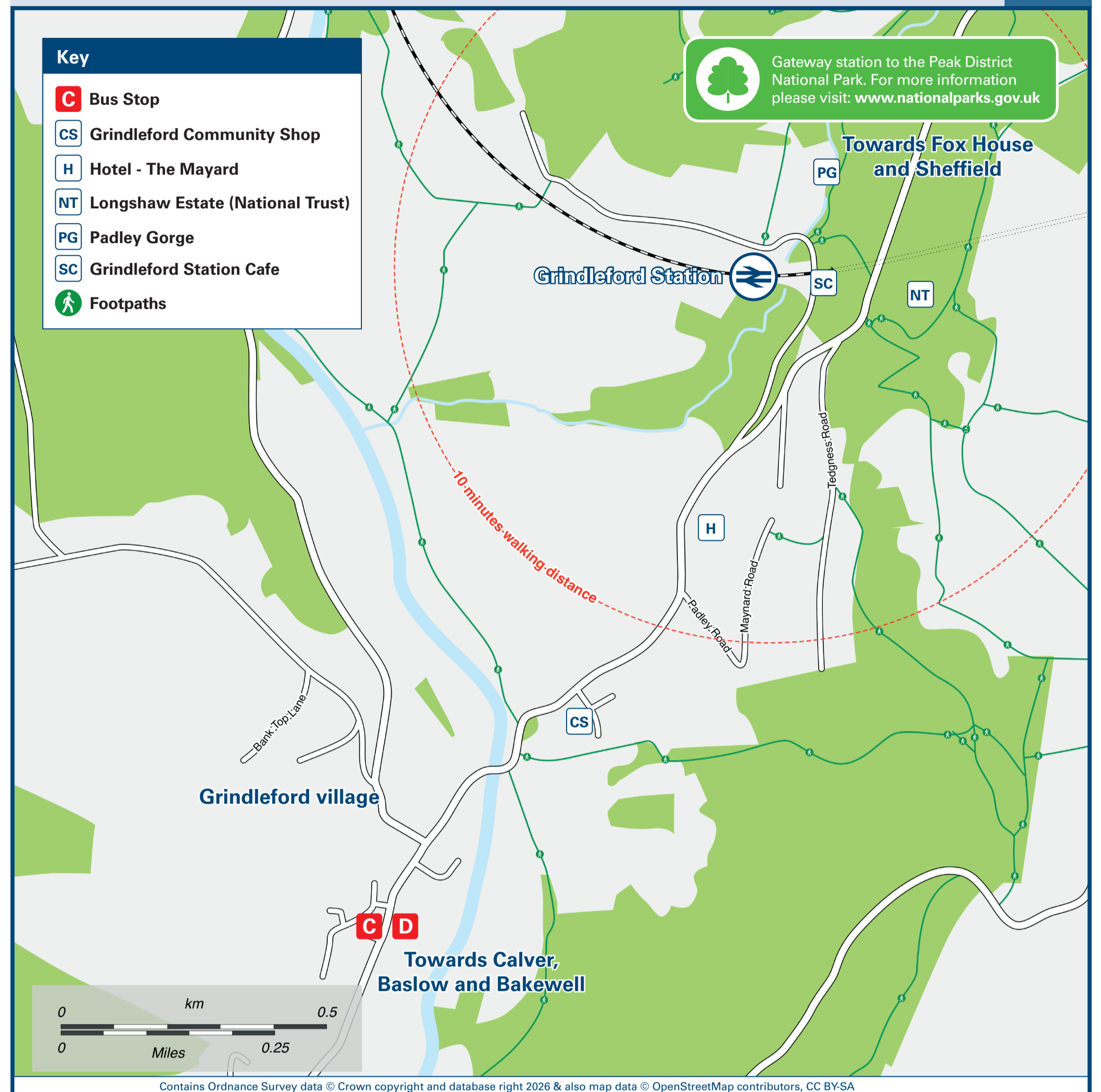
Onward Travel Information

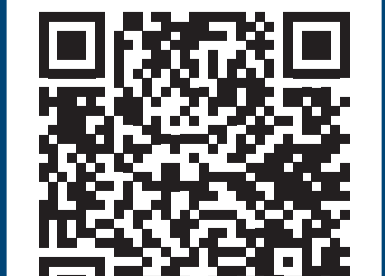
