




# Milford (Surrey) Station

Bus route 70 operates Mondays to Saturdays.  
Bus route 71 operates daily.  
Bus route 503 operates a limited service on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays only.  
Bus route 523 operates a limited service on Tuesdays and Thursdays only.

\* Direct trains operate to this destination from this station.  
\* There is a limited bus service at this station from bus stops (A) and (B), please check with Traveline for bus times and signal clearly for the bus to stop.  
# Please note: It's a 20 to 25 minutes walk to this destination from this station (see Local area map). Please be aware that roads and footpaths around this station have no lighting at night.  
+ Bus route 71 on Sundays and Public Holidays changes to route 70 at Haslemere to Midhurst, same bus, no need to change.
