

Service Alterations

West Highland Line

Saturday 9 to Tuesday 12 November



If you travel to / from any of the stations marked in red above, your journey may be affected as follows:

Glasgow Queen Street – Oban / Fort William / Mallaig services

- Buses replace trains between Glasgow Queen St and Crianlarich calling all stations from Dalmuir.
- A direct bus service will also operate between Glasgow Queen St and Crianlarich

On Sunday 10 November only, buses will replace trains Fort William to Mallaig and Glasgow Queen St to Crianlarich.

The following last train services from Oban – Glasgow Queen St are cancelled in their entirety and replaced by bus calling all stations:

- **Saturday 9 November:** 2042 dept Oban
- **Monday 11 & Tuesday 12 November:** 2131 dept Oban

An express bus will also operate from Oban to Glasgow Queen St calling at Crianlarich only.
