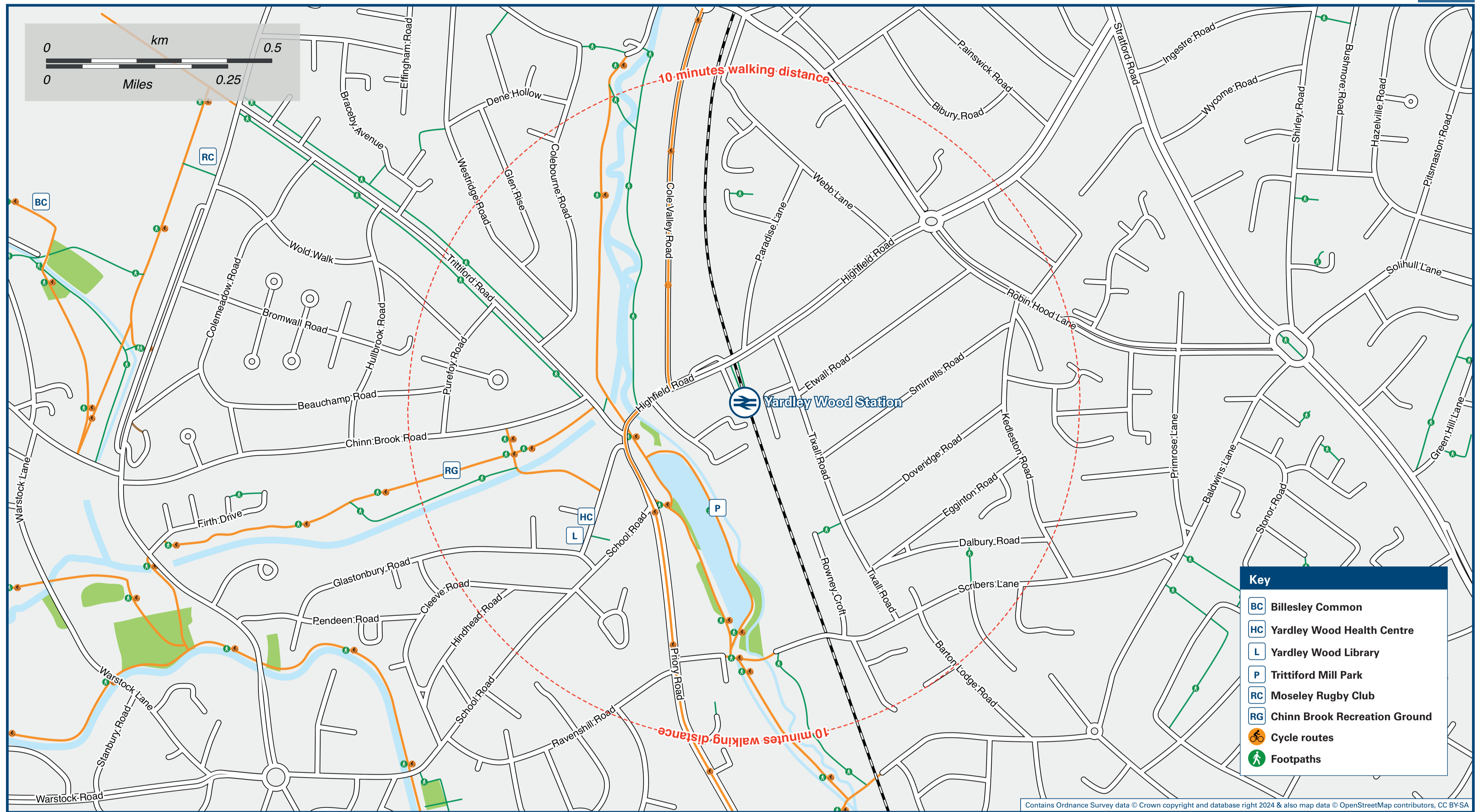




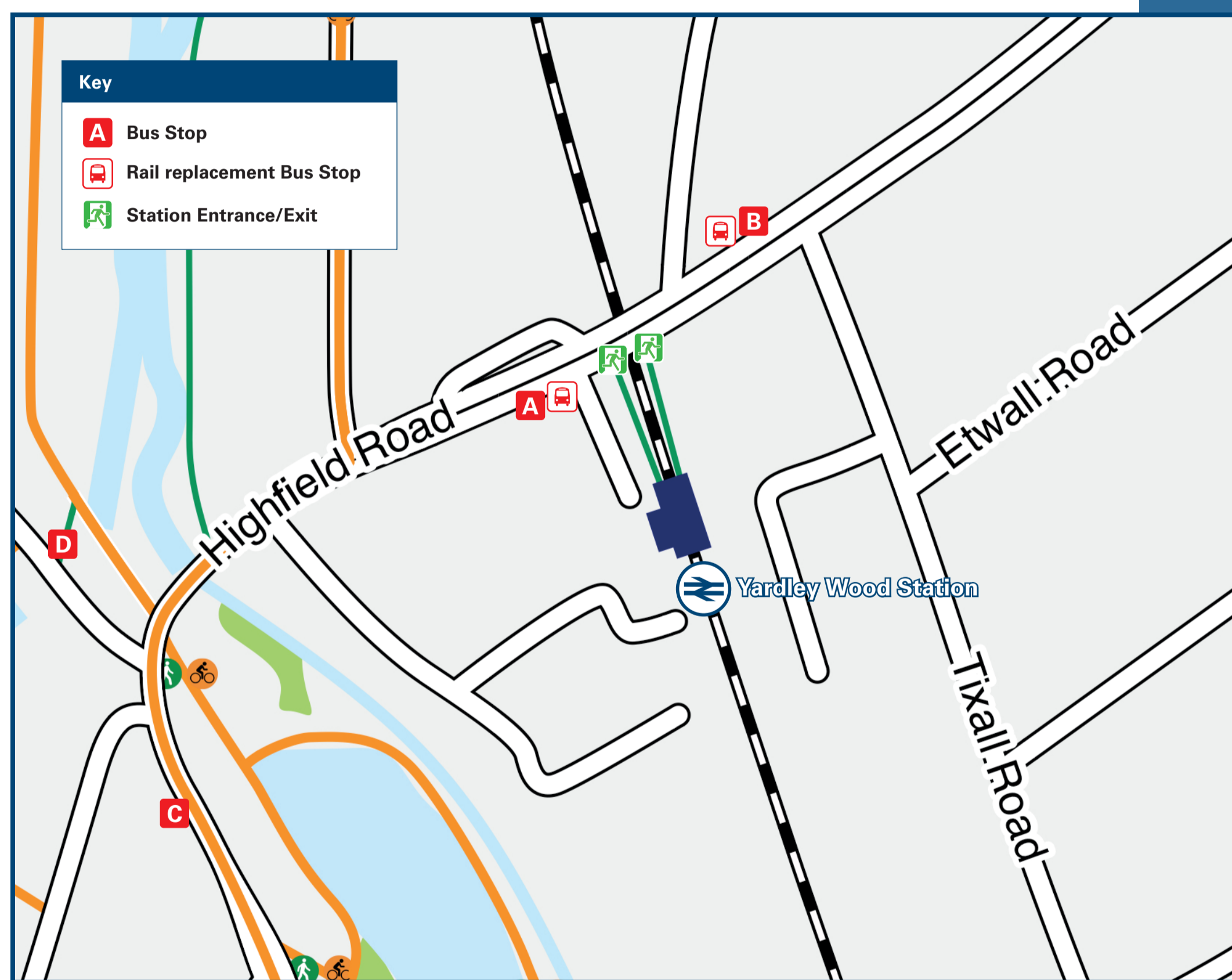
# Yardley Wood Station

Rail replacement buses/coaches services to Shirley will collect from the public service bus stop outside the station (stop A). Services to Birmingham will call at the public service bus stop opposite the station on Highfield Road near to the junction with Paradise Lane (stop B).
