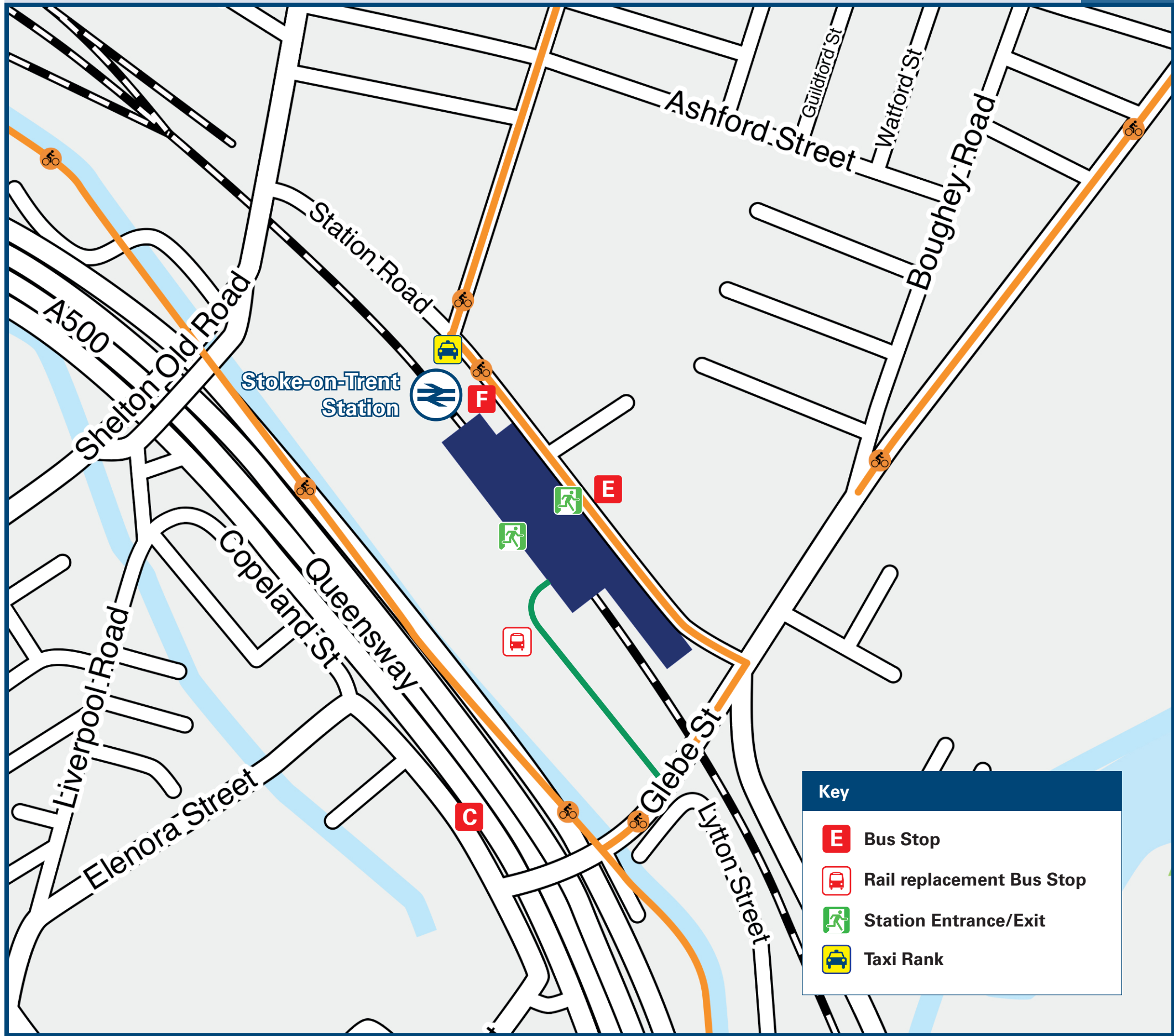

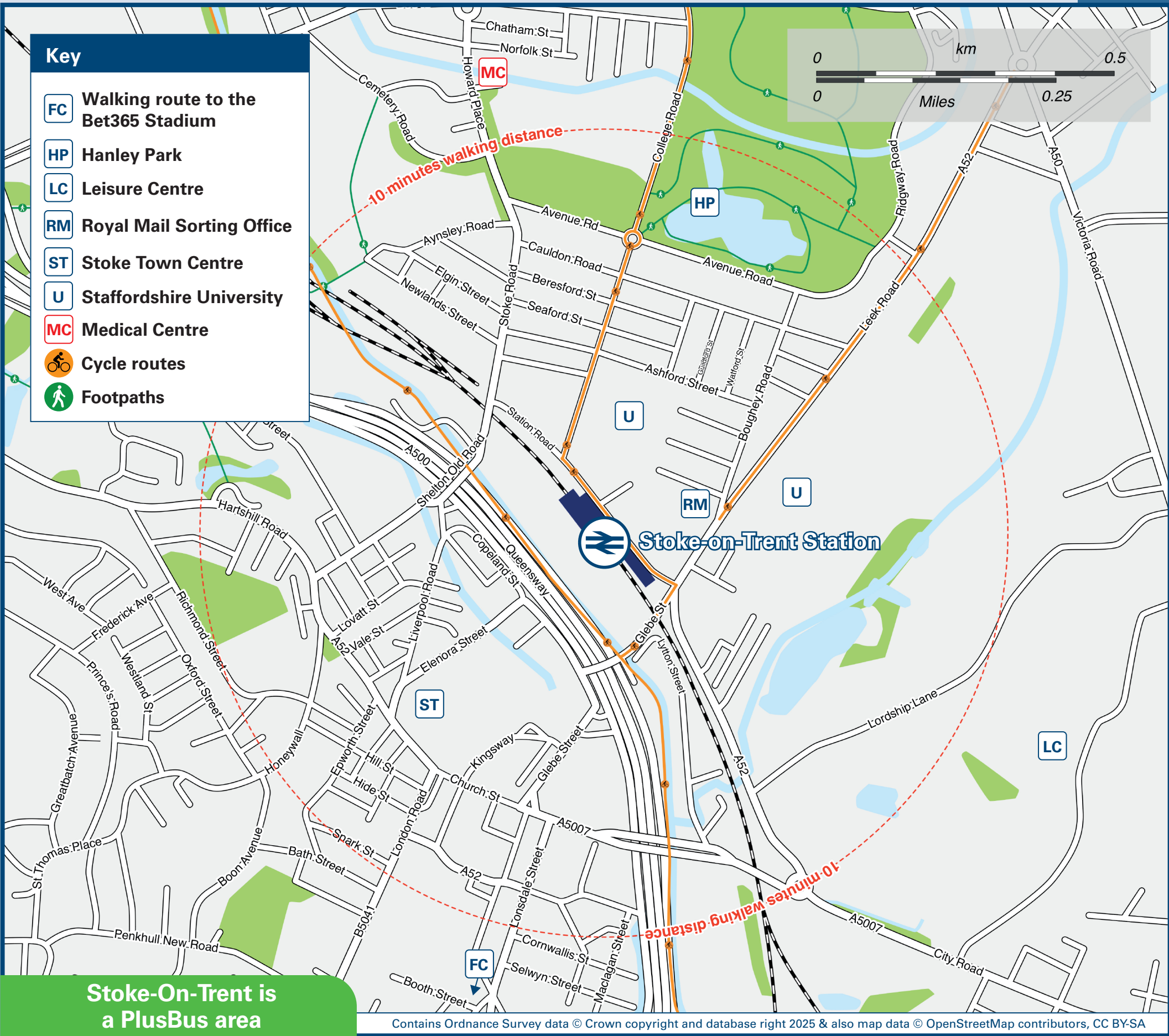

- *** Alight bus 100 at Wedgwood Drive - it's a 10 minutes walk from there to the Wedgwood Visitor Centre.
- ~ Additional bus services to other local destinations depart from Hanley and Newcastle-under-Lyme bus stations.
- # Bus route 40A operates a limited daytime service on Saturdays, only. No Mondays to Fridays or Sundays service.
- ## Bus route 32A departs from this station at 08:30 on Mondays to Saturdays, and only operates when Alton Towers is open to the public.
- ① Direct trains operate to this destination from Stoke-on-Trent station.
