





Bruton Station

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING BRUTON STATION

Bus route 667 runs a limited Mondays to Saturdays service at 09.28, 11.25, 13.28 & 15.40 from stop **A to Castle Cary and Street.**

Bus route 667 runs a limited Mondays to Saturdays service at 08.41, 10.26, 12.26, 14.41 & 18.51 on Mondays to Fridays and also on 16.56 on Saturdays only, from stop **B to Wincanton.**
