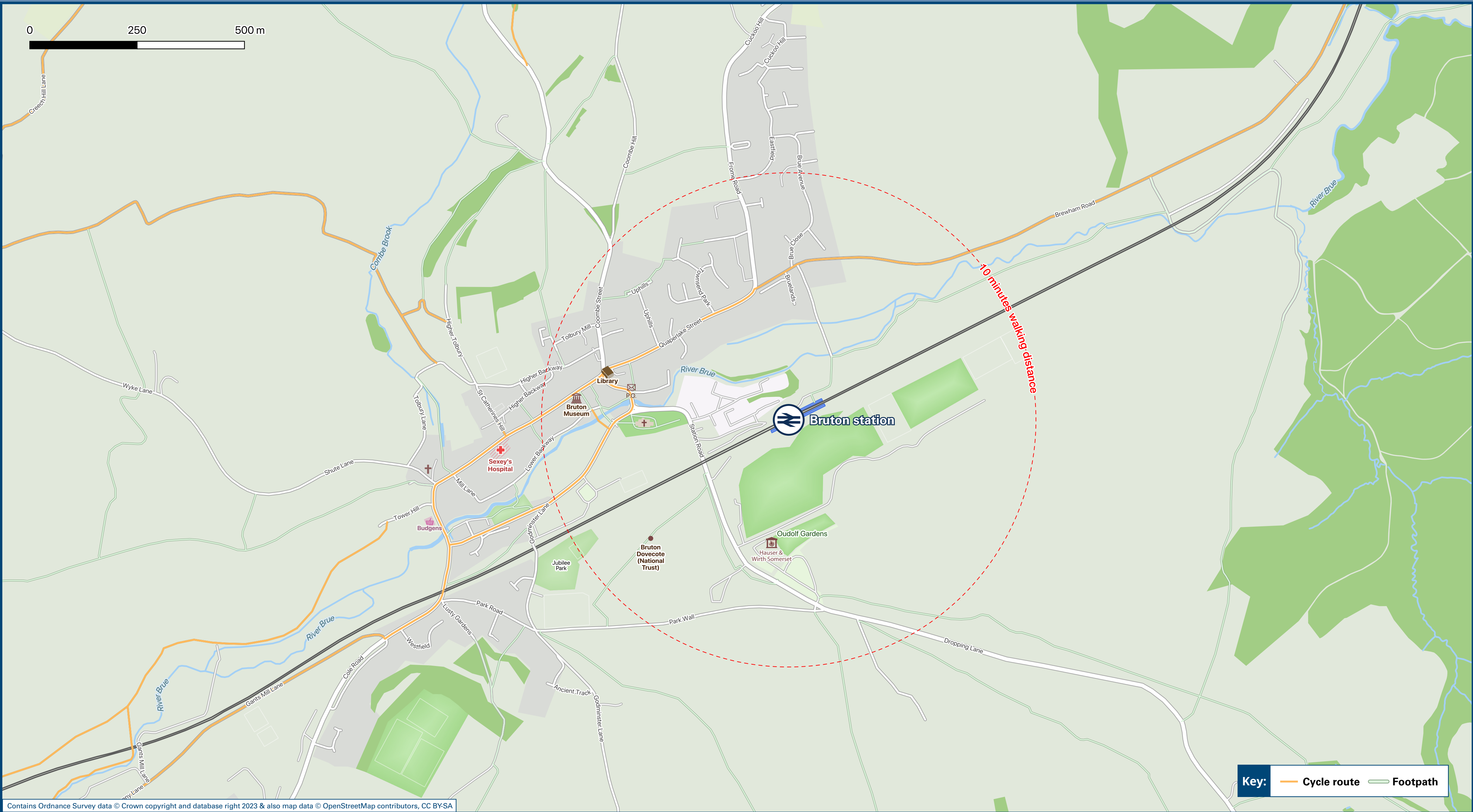

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING BRUTON STATION

Bus route 1B runs 1 service at 07.40, from stop A, Mondays to Fridays only, to Yeovil.

Bus route 667 runs a limited Mondays to Saturdays service at 09.28, 11.25, 13.28 & 15.55, from stop A to Castle Cary and Street.

Bus route 667 runs a limited Mondays to Saturdays service at 08.26, 10.26, 12.26, & 14.26 Mondays to Fridays and also on 16.56 on Saturdays only, from stop B to Wincanton.
