- Bus route 1E operates late nights on Fridays and Saturdays only.
- < All bus routes call at Thatcham Broadway: Bus route 1a runs via Lower Way, 1c runs via Henwick Lane/Westfield Road and 1 (jet black) runs via Bath Road.
- @ Bus V1 operates daytime Mondays to Fridays from stop (U) outside this station. This is a private contract bus service for the use of Vodafone staff, contractors and visitors only and not a public bus service. Contact Vodafone on 01635 33251 for more information.
