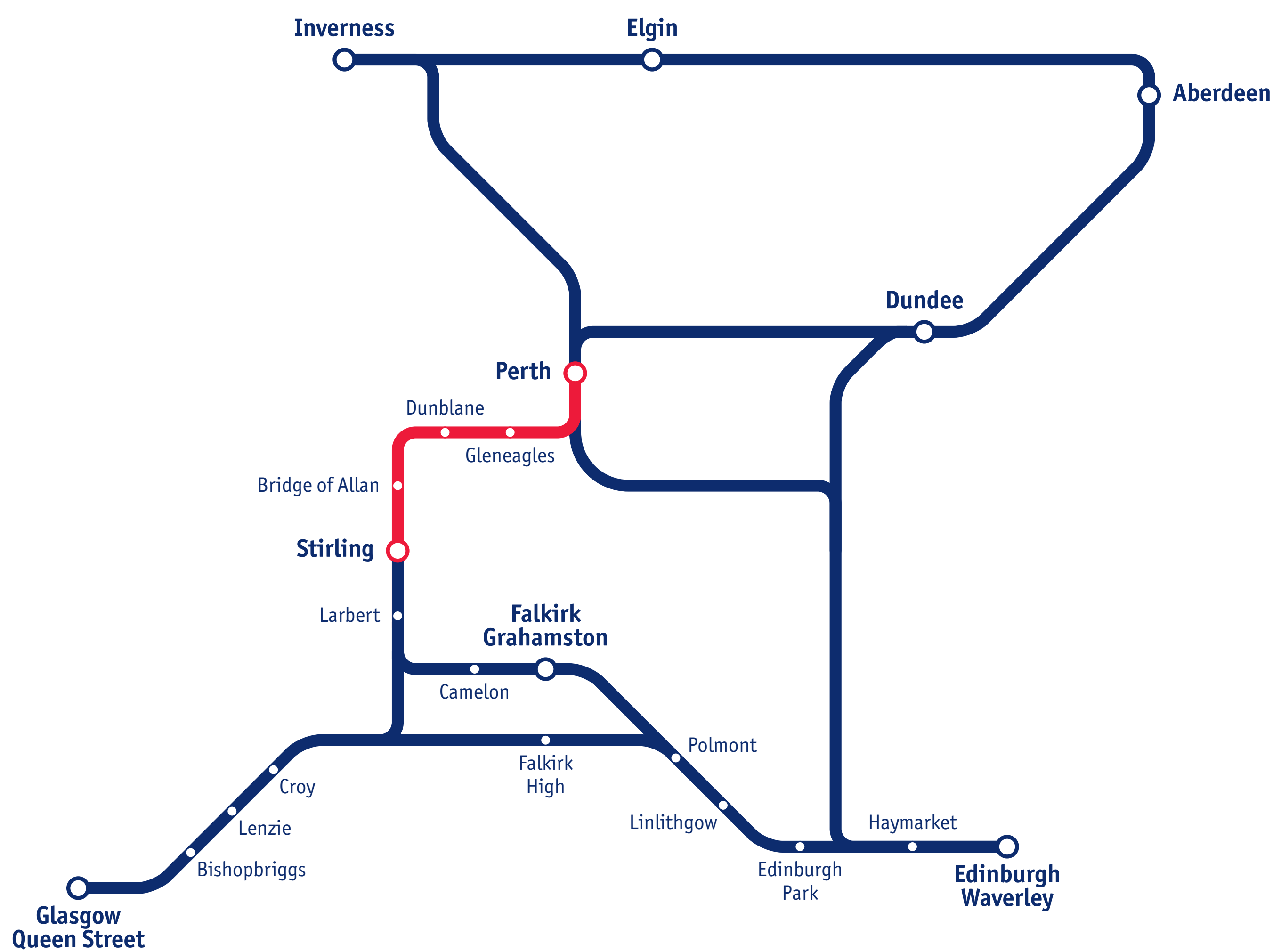


Service Alterations

Glasgow / Edinburgh – Inverness / Aberdeen

Central Scotland

Saturdays 2 & 9 September



If you travel to / from any of the stations marked in red above, your journey may be affected as follows:

Edinburgh – Inverness

- Trains are diverted and do not call at Stirling.

Edinburgh – Dunblane

- Buses replace trains between Stirling and Dunblane, calling at Bridge of Allan.

Glasgow Queen Street – Inverness / Elgin

- Buses replace trains between Glasgow Queen Street and Perth, calling at intermediate stations.

Glasgow Queen Street – Aberdeen

- Buses replace trains between Glasgow Queen Street and Perth, calling at intermediate stations.

Glasgow Queen Street – Perth / Dundee / Arbroath

- Trains operate between Glasgow and Stirling, and between Perth and Dundee / Arbroath only.
- Buses replace trains between Stirling and Perth, calling at Bridge of Allan, Dunblane and Gleneagles.
- 2305 and 2335 Glasgow Queen Street to Perth are cancelled and bus replaced throughout.
