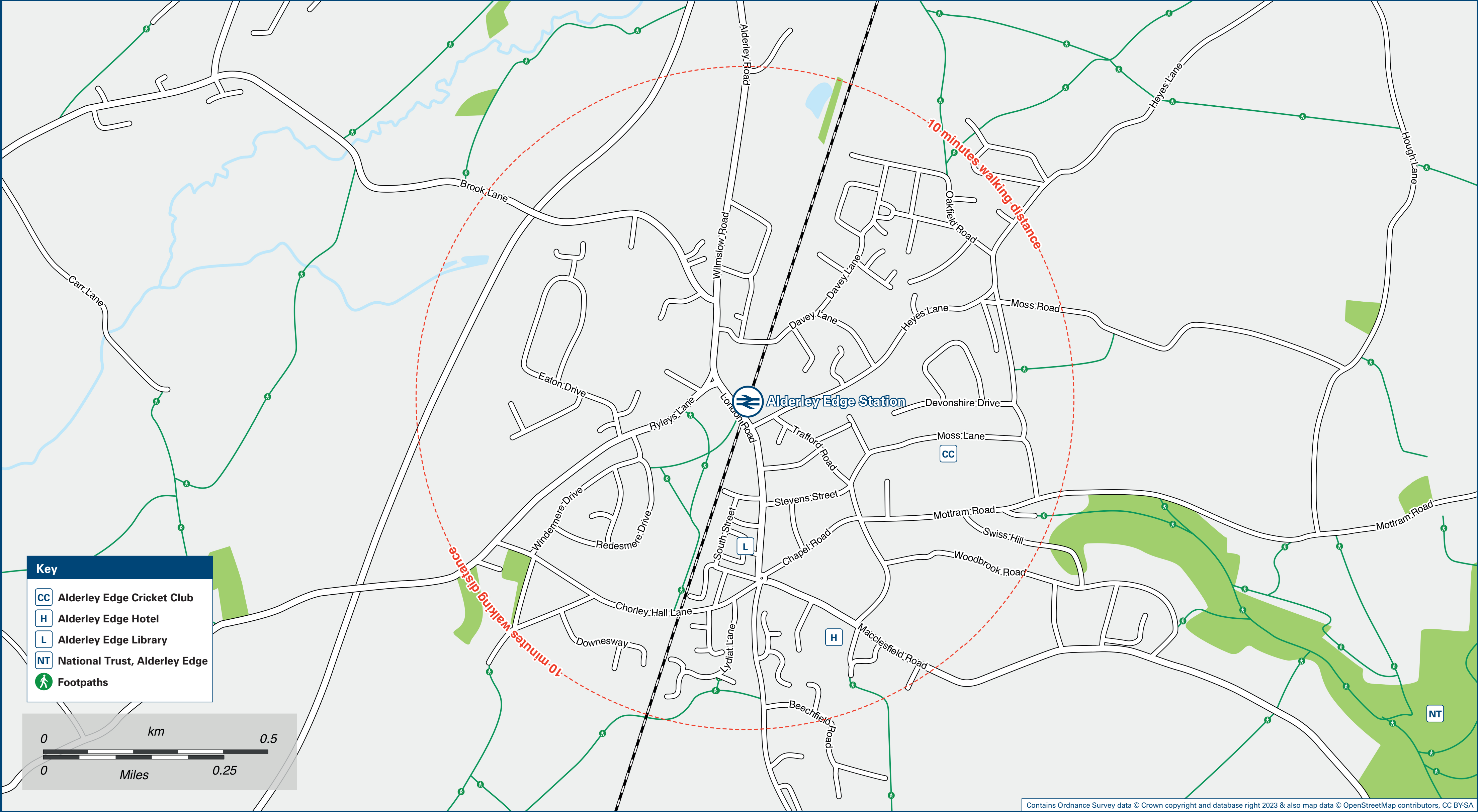




Alderley Edge Station
