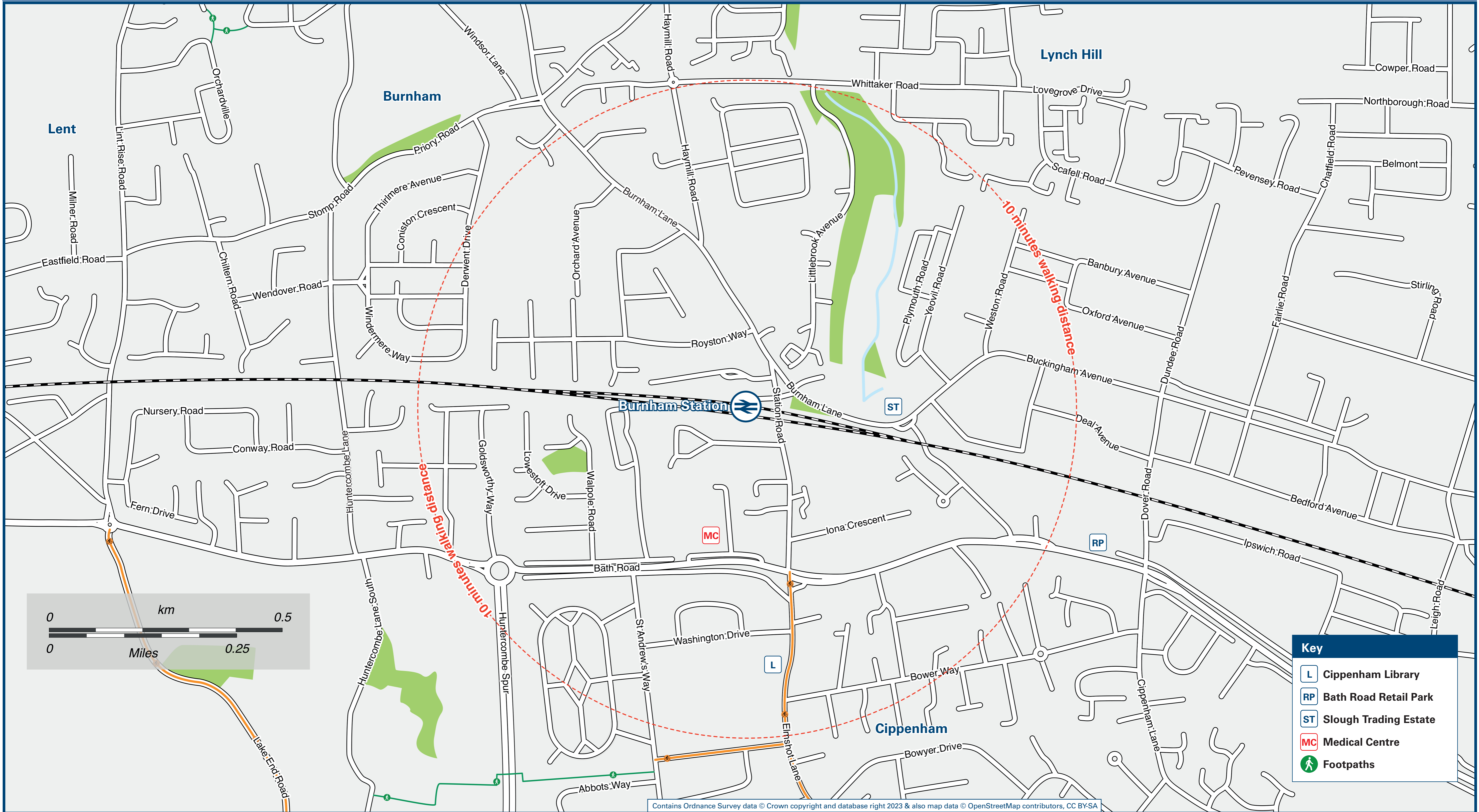




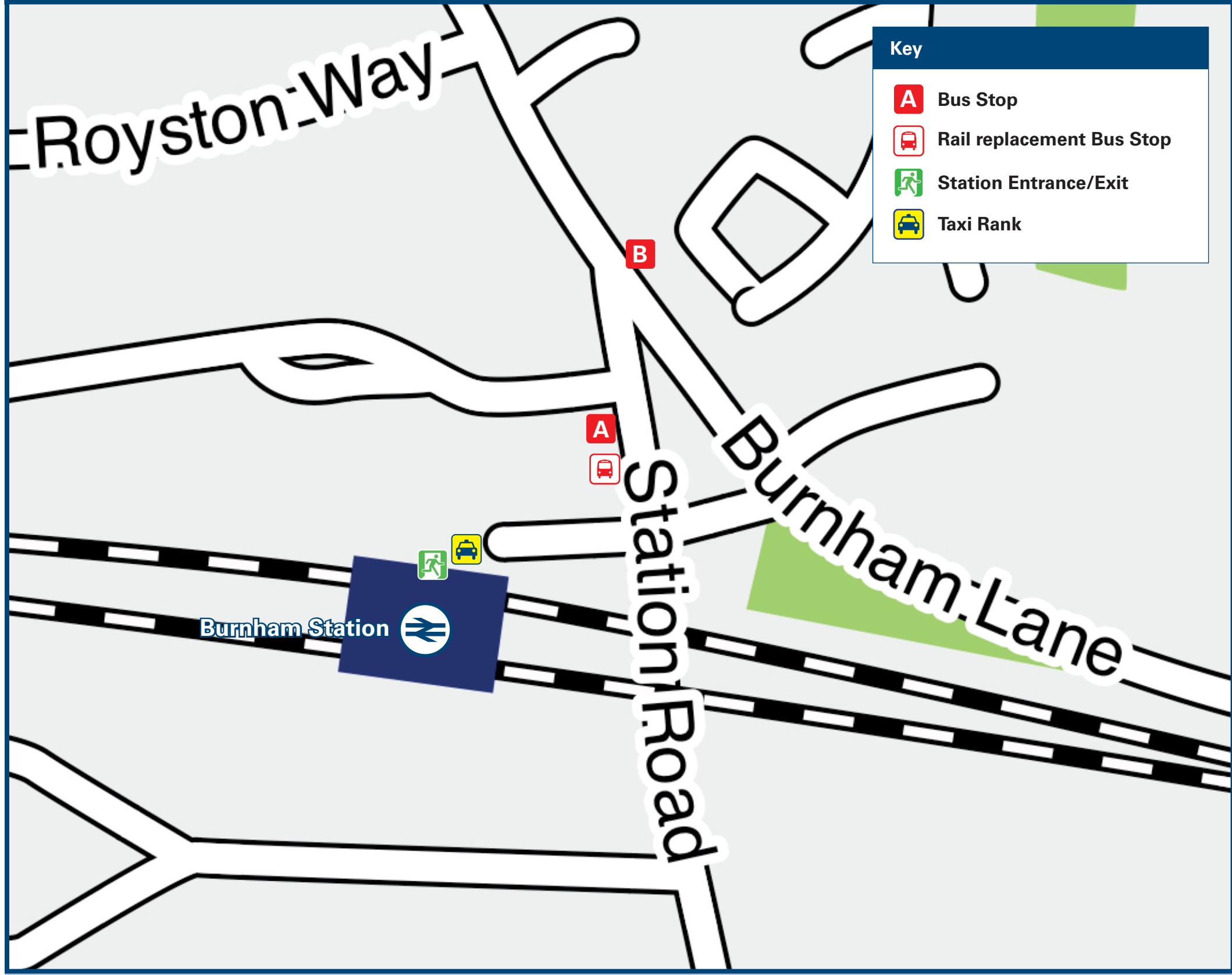
Burnham Station
