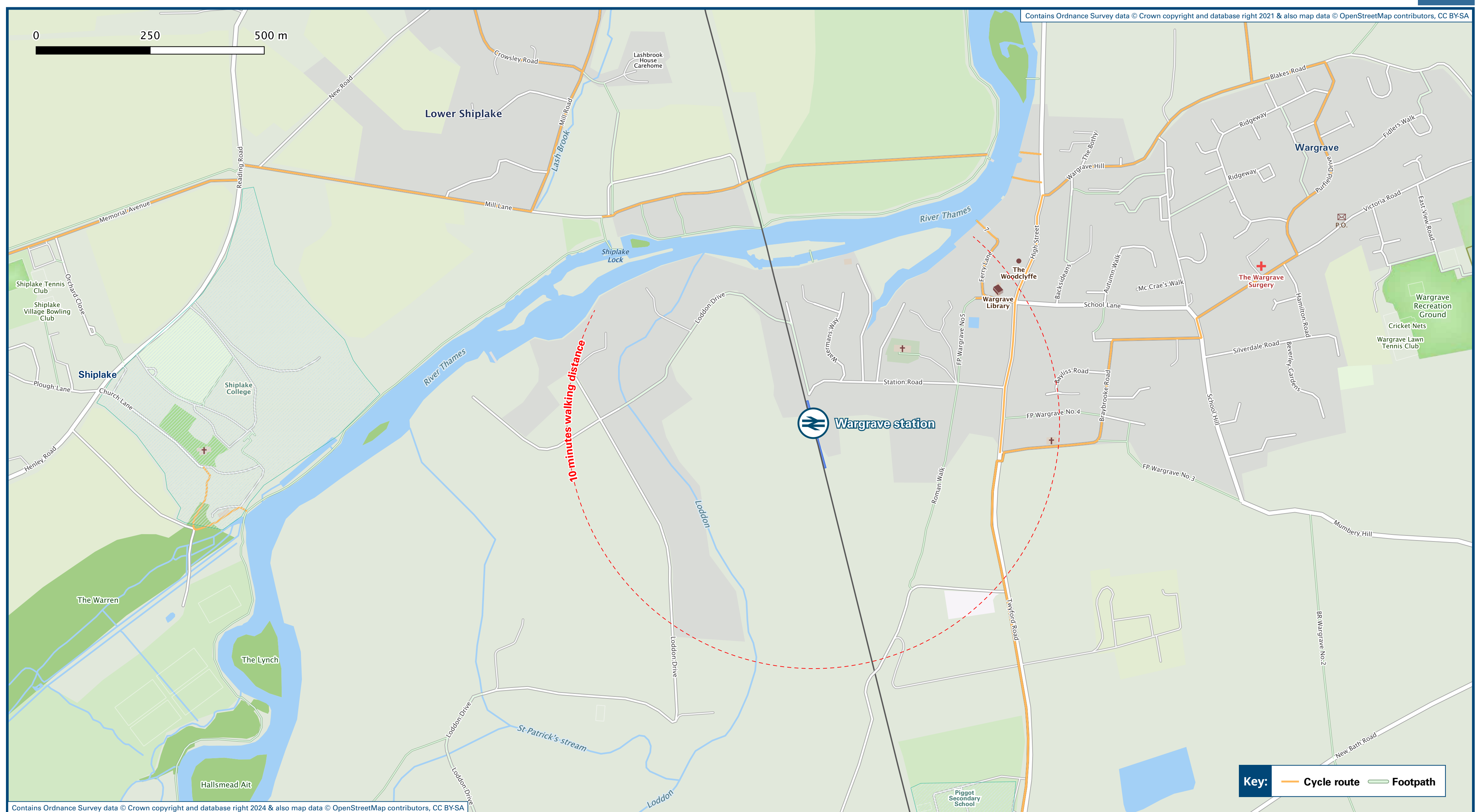




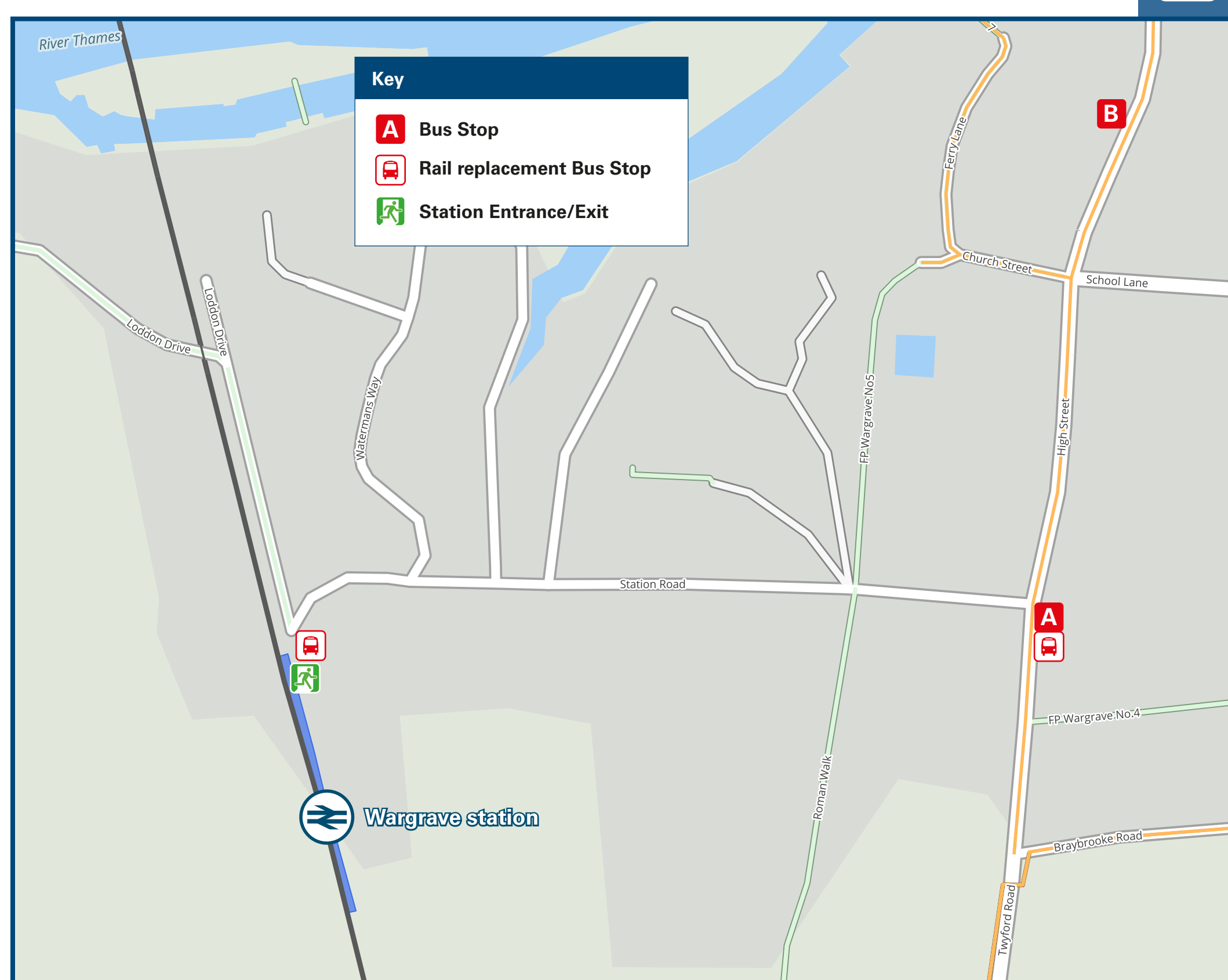
Wargrave Station
