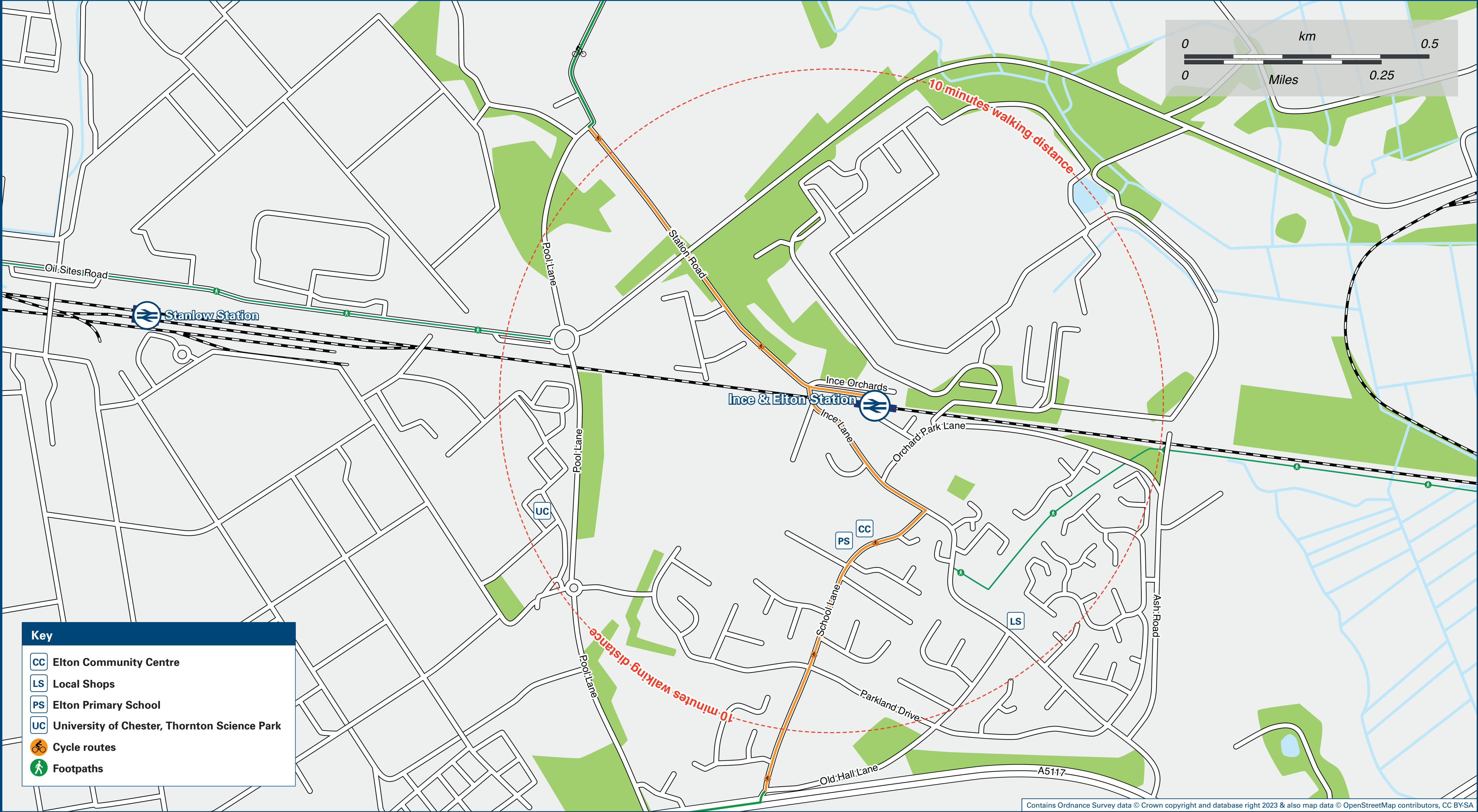




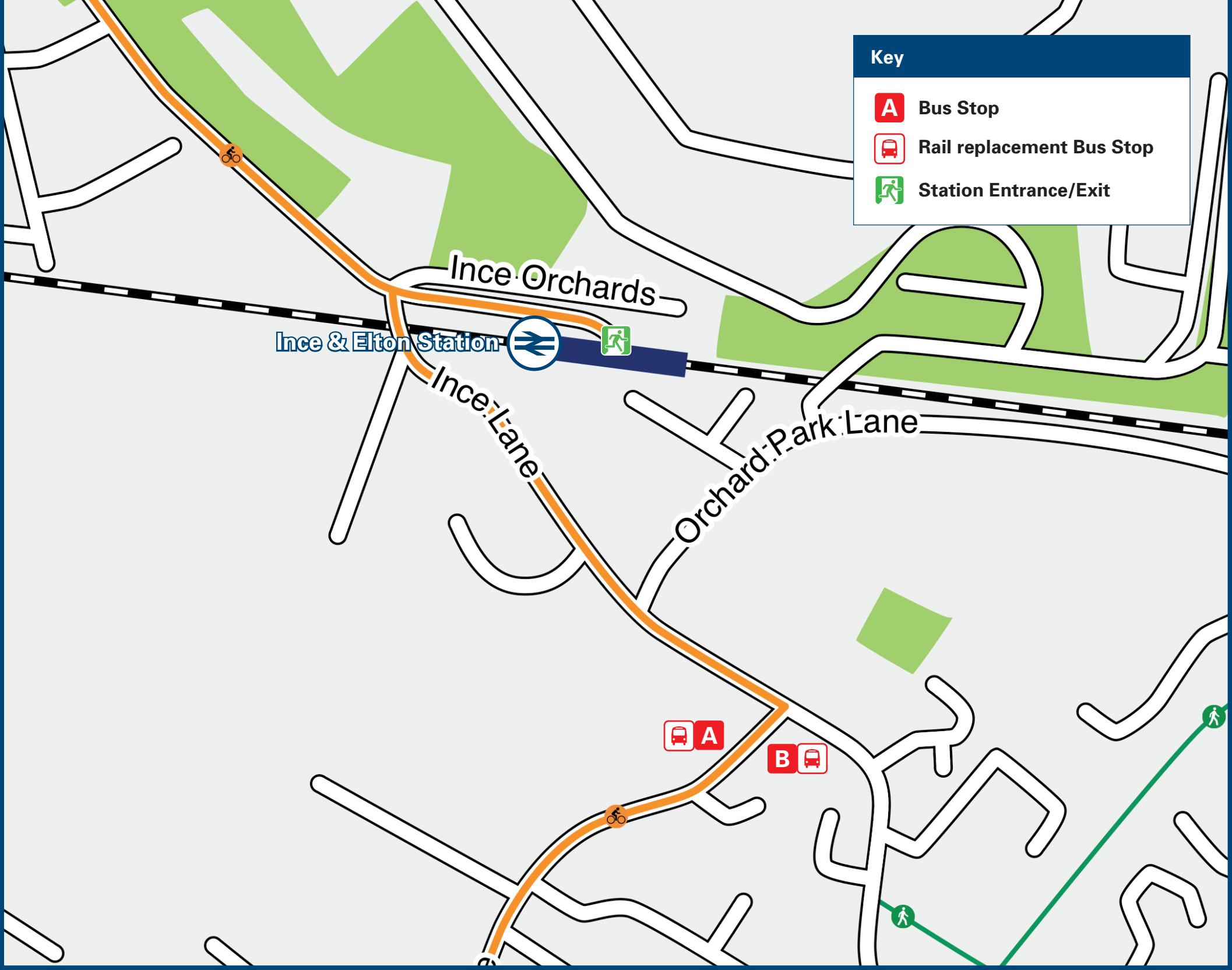
Ince & Elton Station
