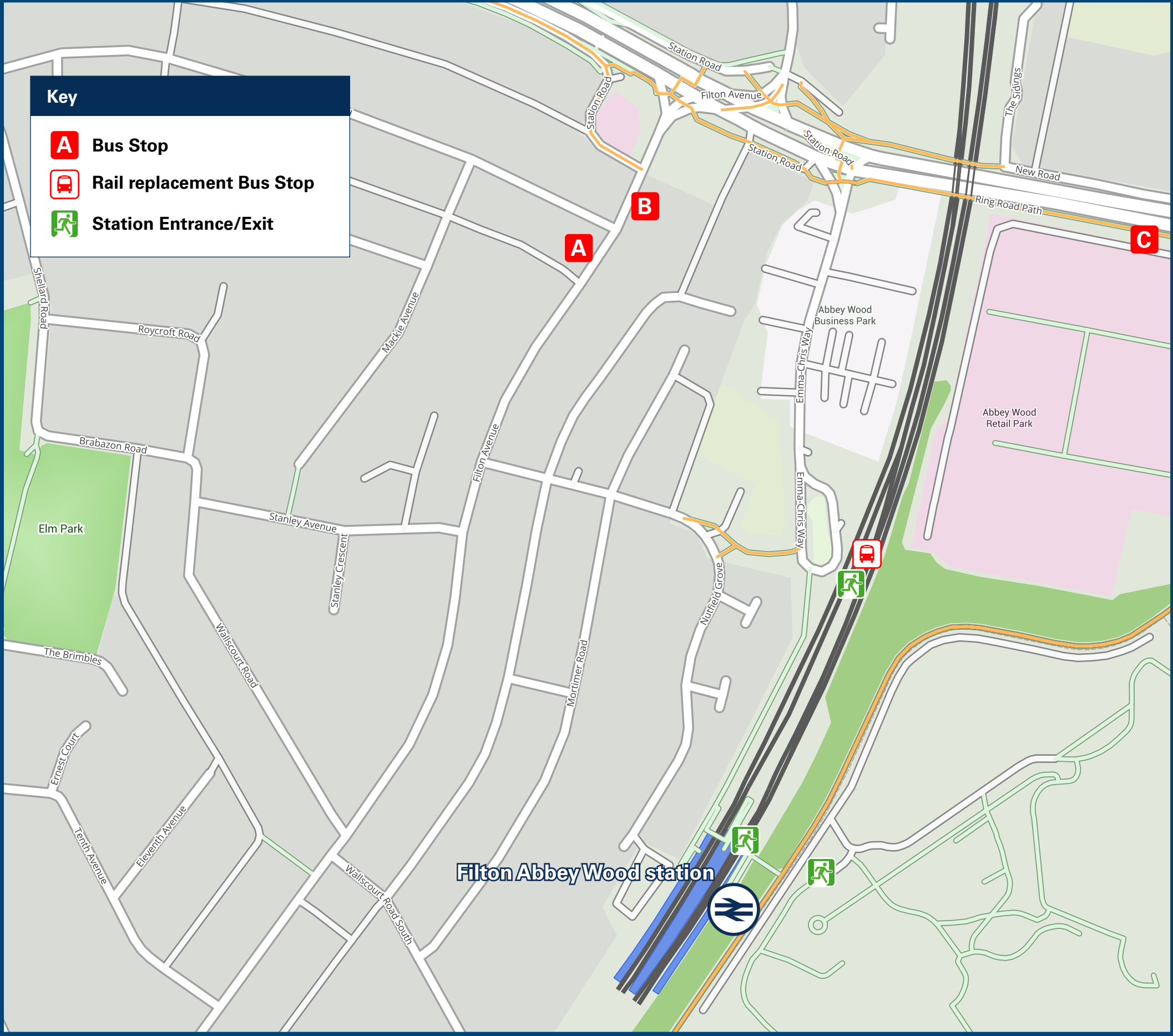

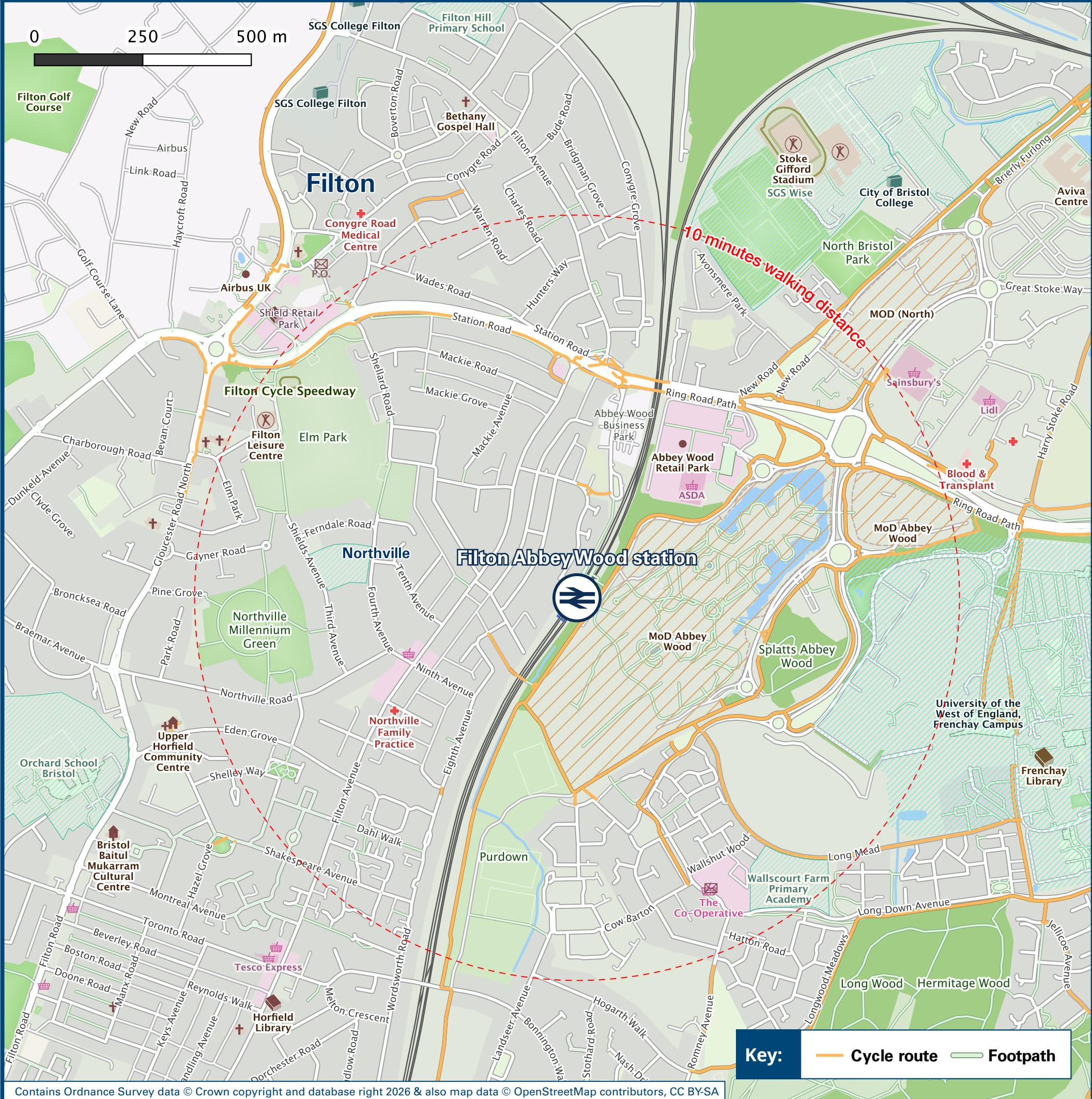

With no fixed timetable or route, WESTlink runs with a fleet of minibuses across most of the West of England outside Bath and Bristol city centres. You can book a journey by selecting your pick-up and drop-off points in the WESTlink mobile app, or by calling 0117 457 8561 (Monday–Saturday, 5:30am–9:30pm). 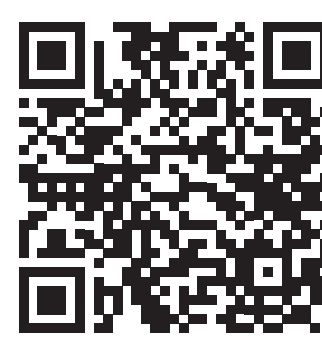
