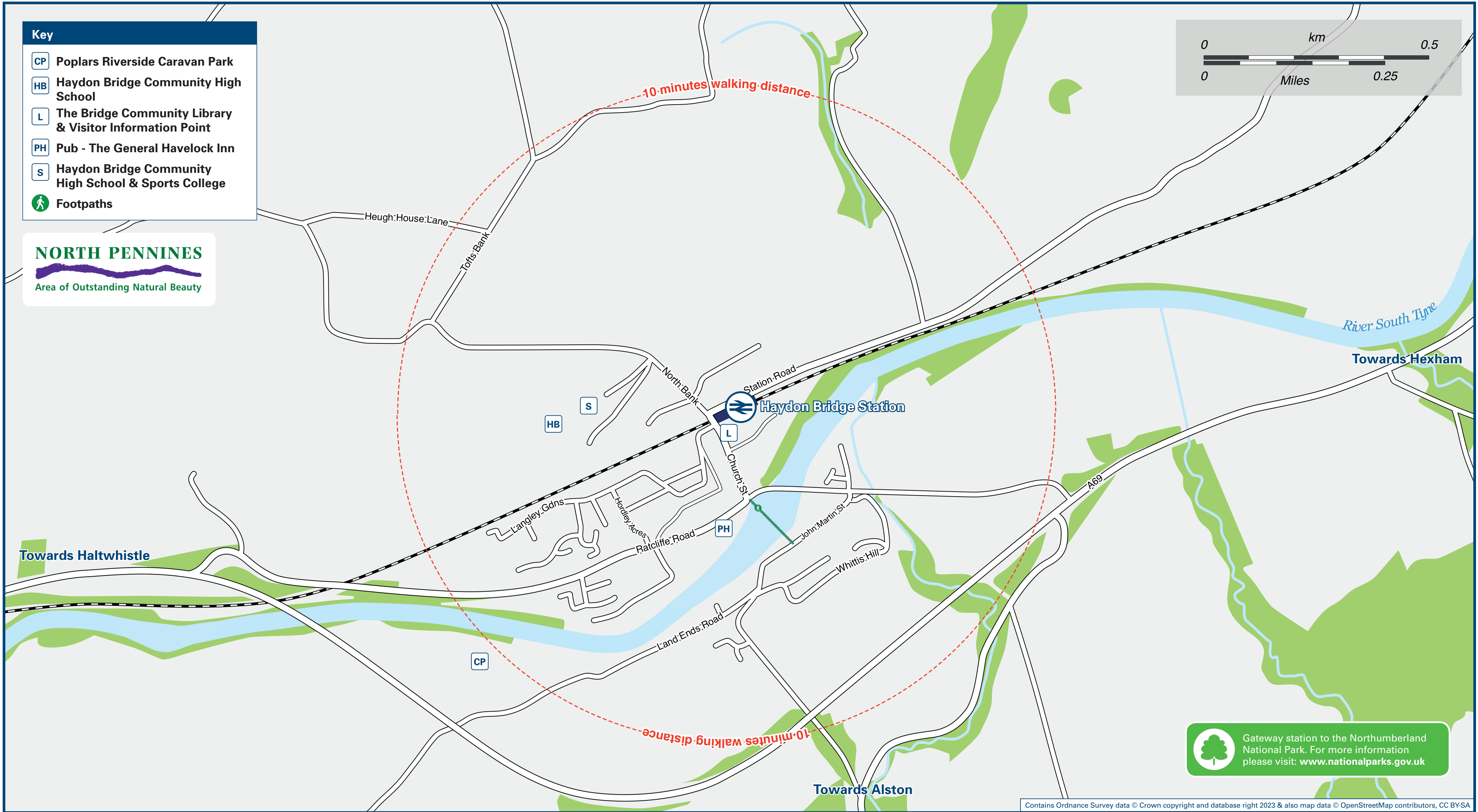




Haydon Bridge Station
