

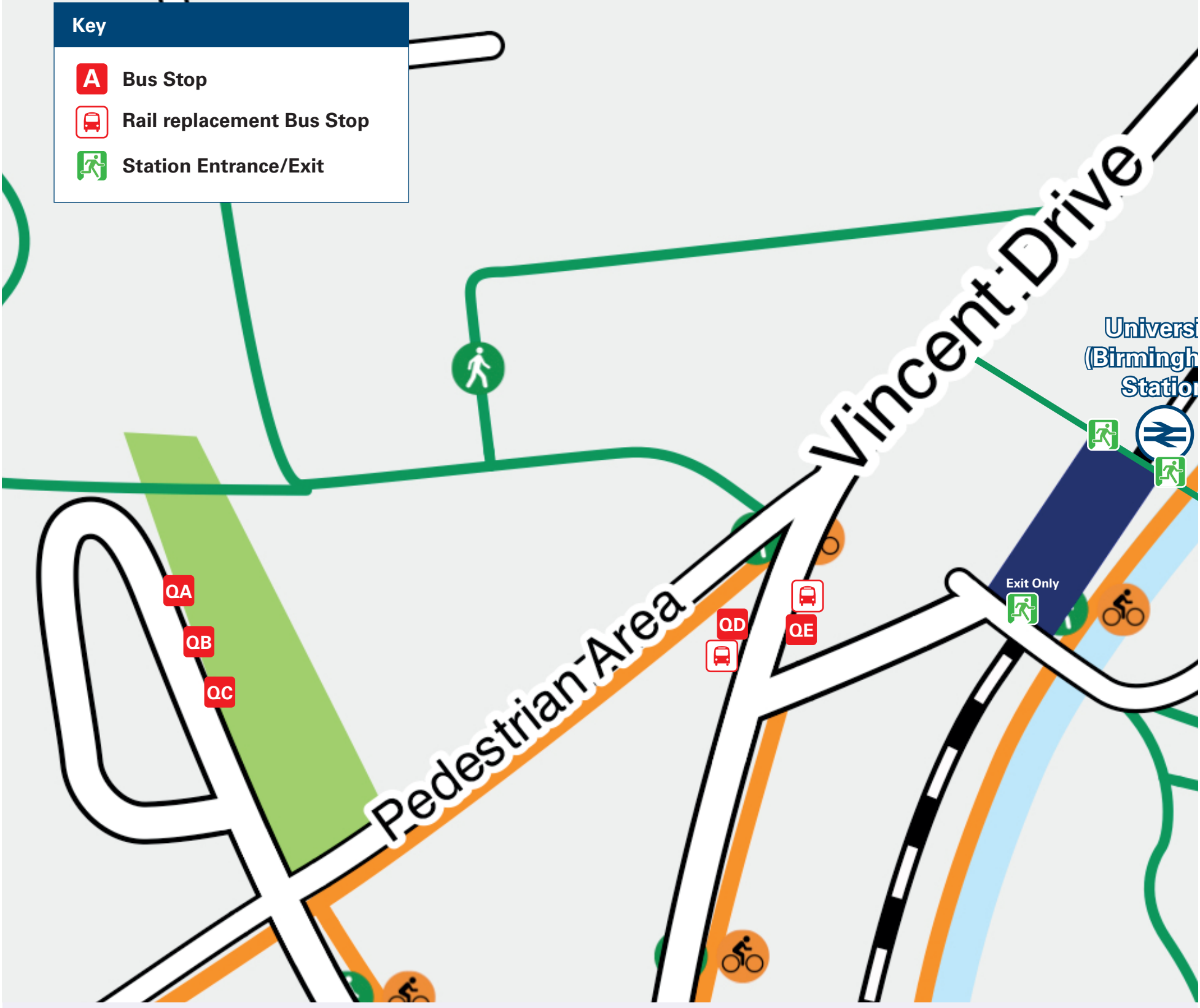

Buses





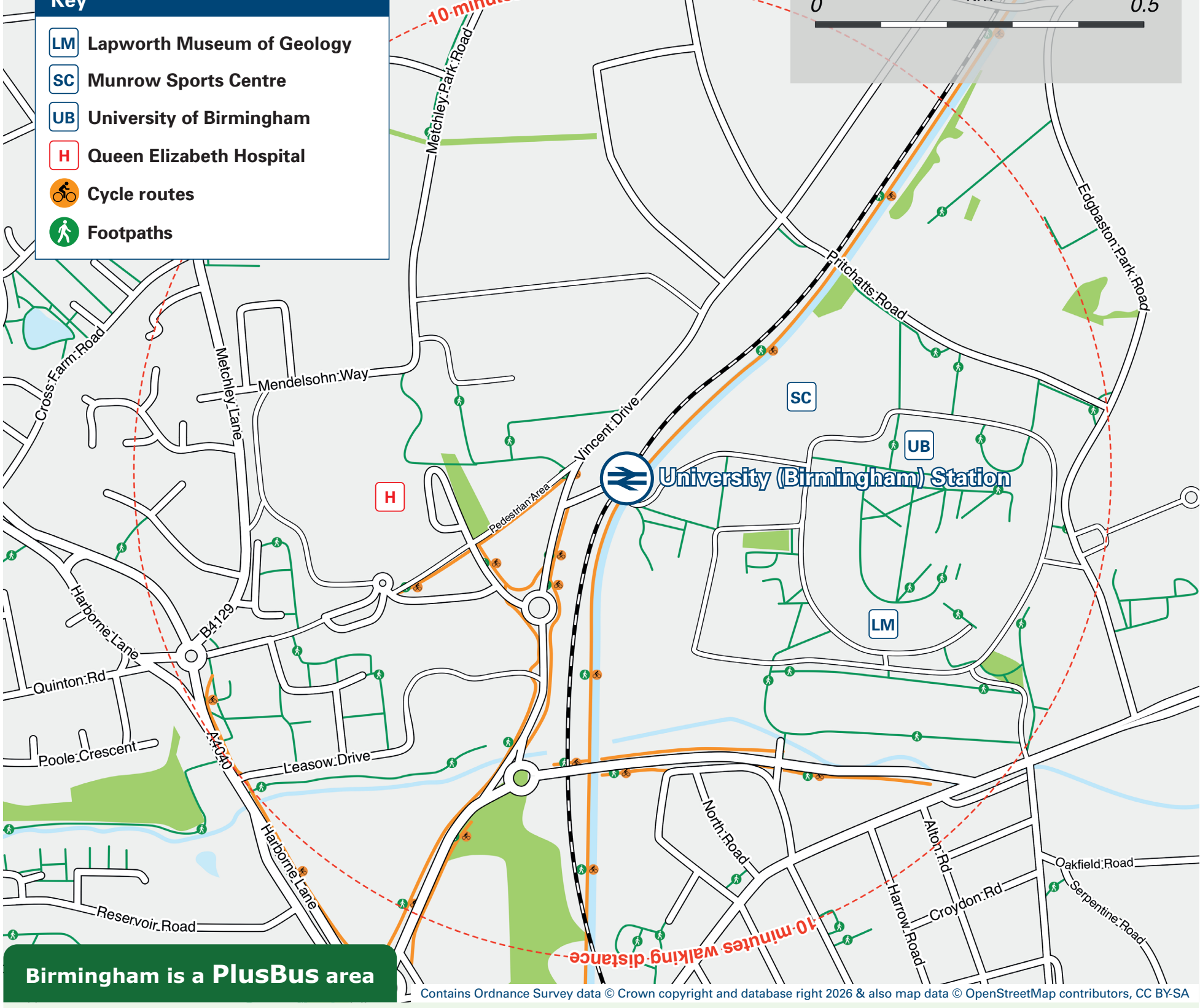
Key
