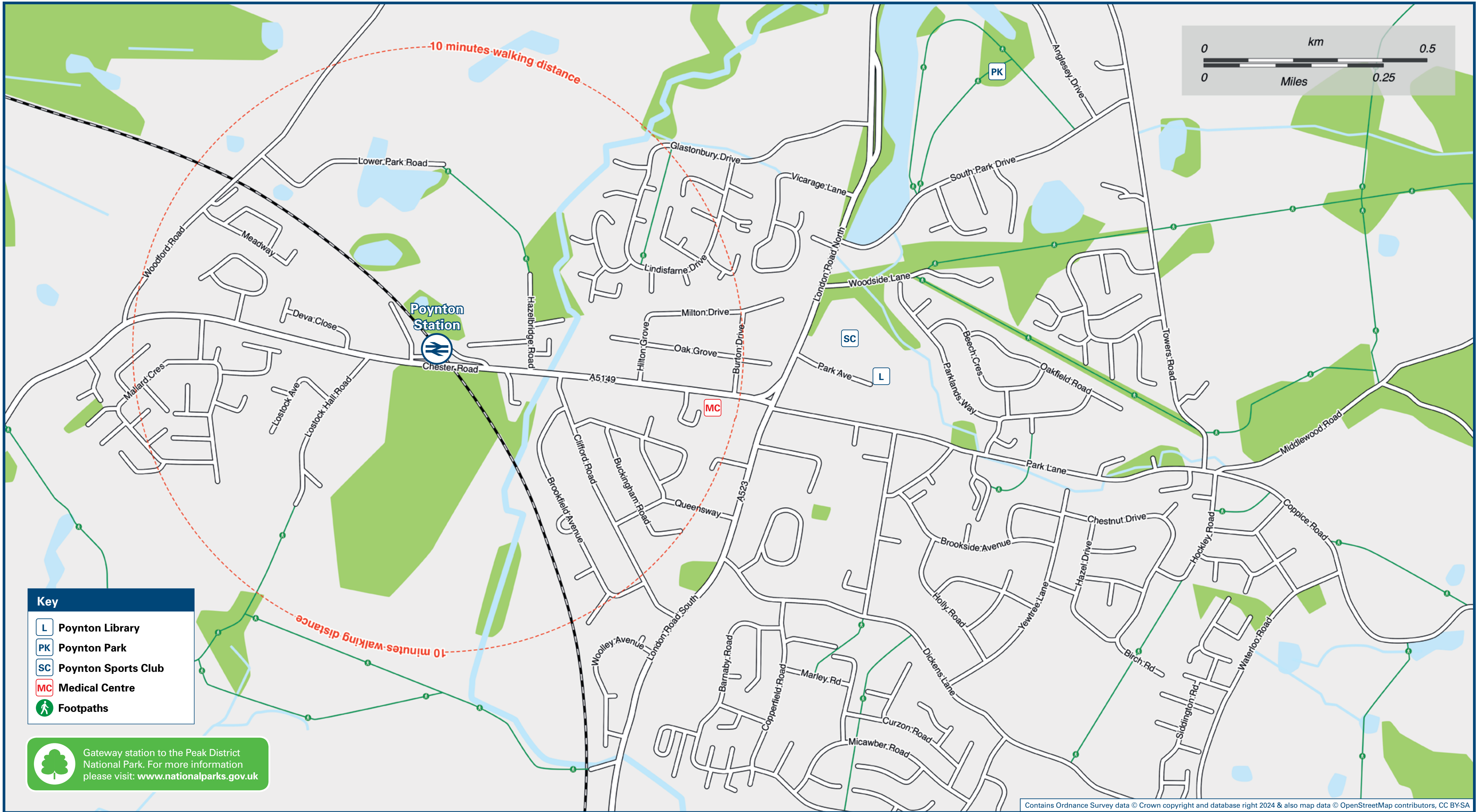




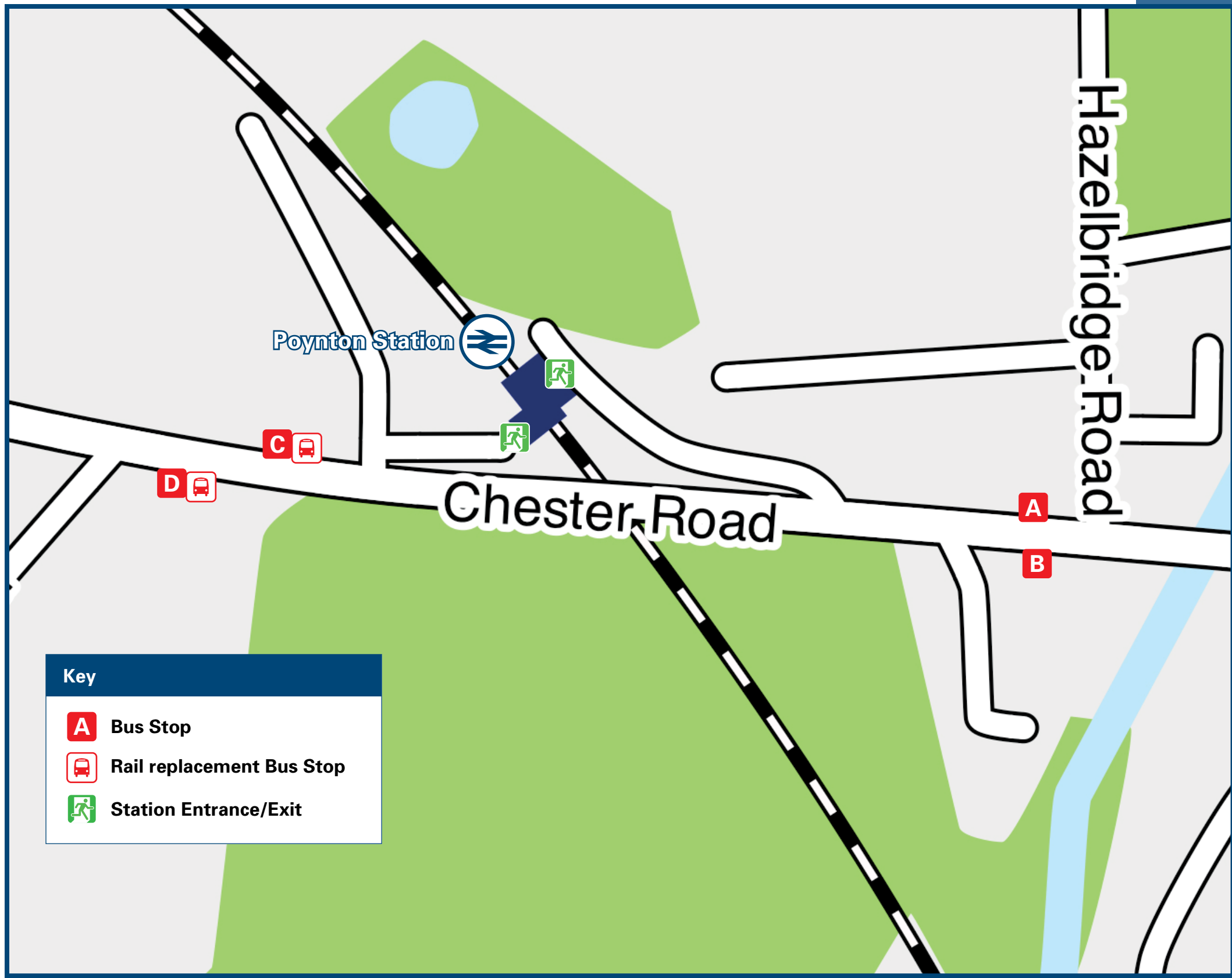
Poynton Station
