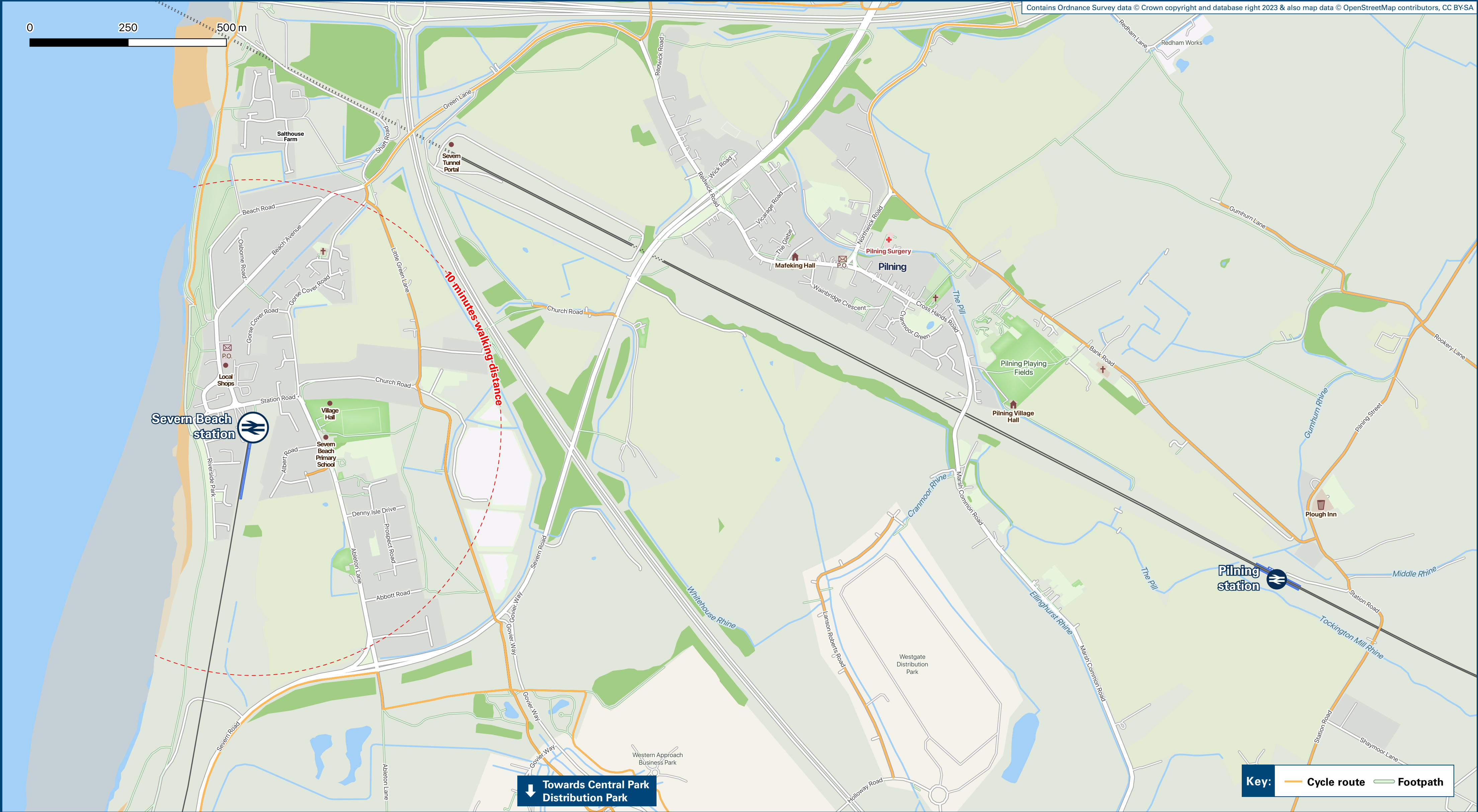




# Severn Beach Station
