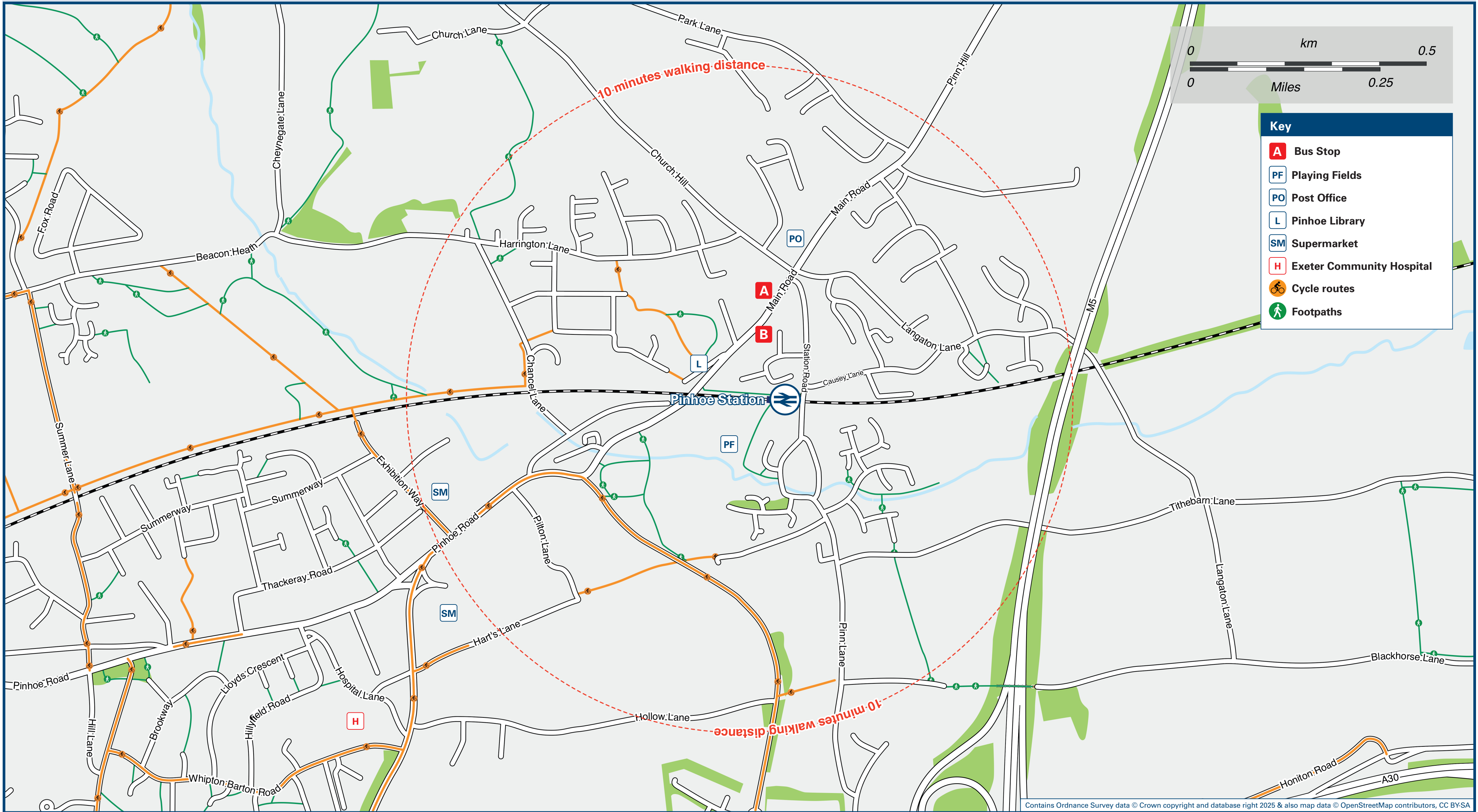




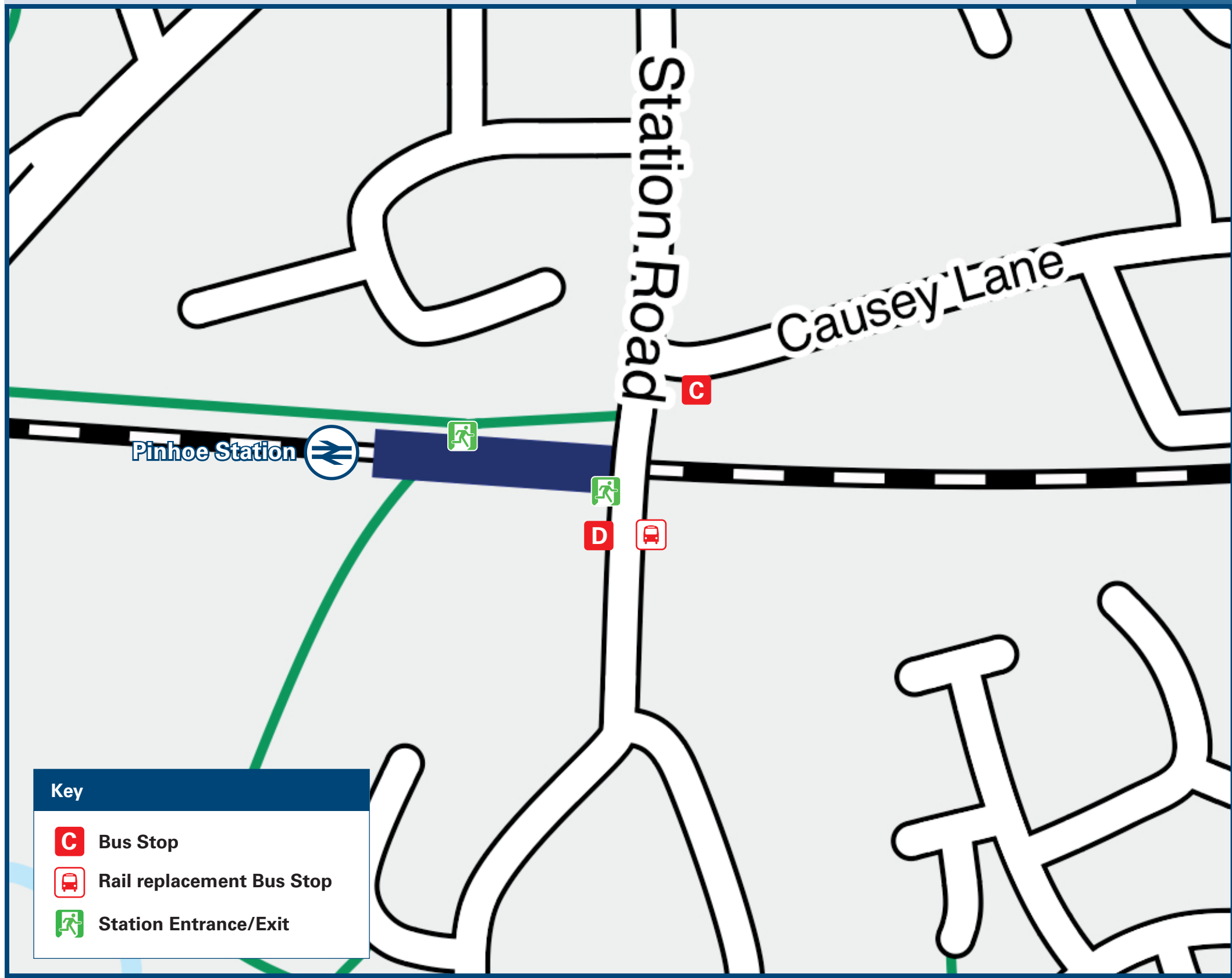
Pinhoe Station

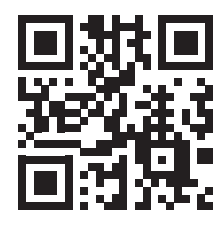
