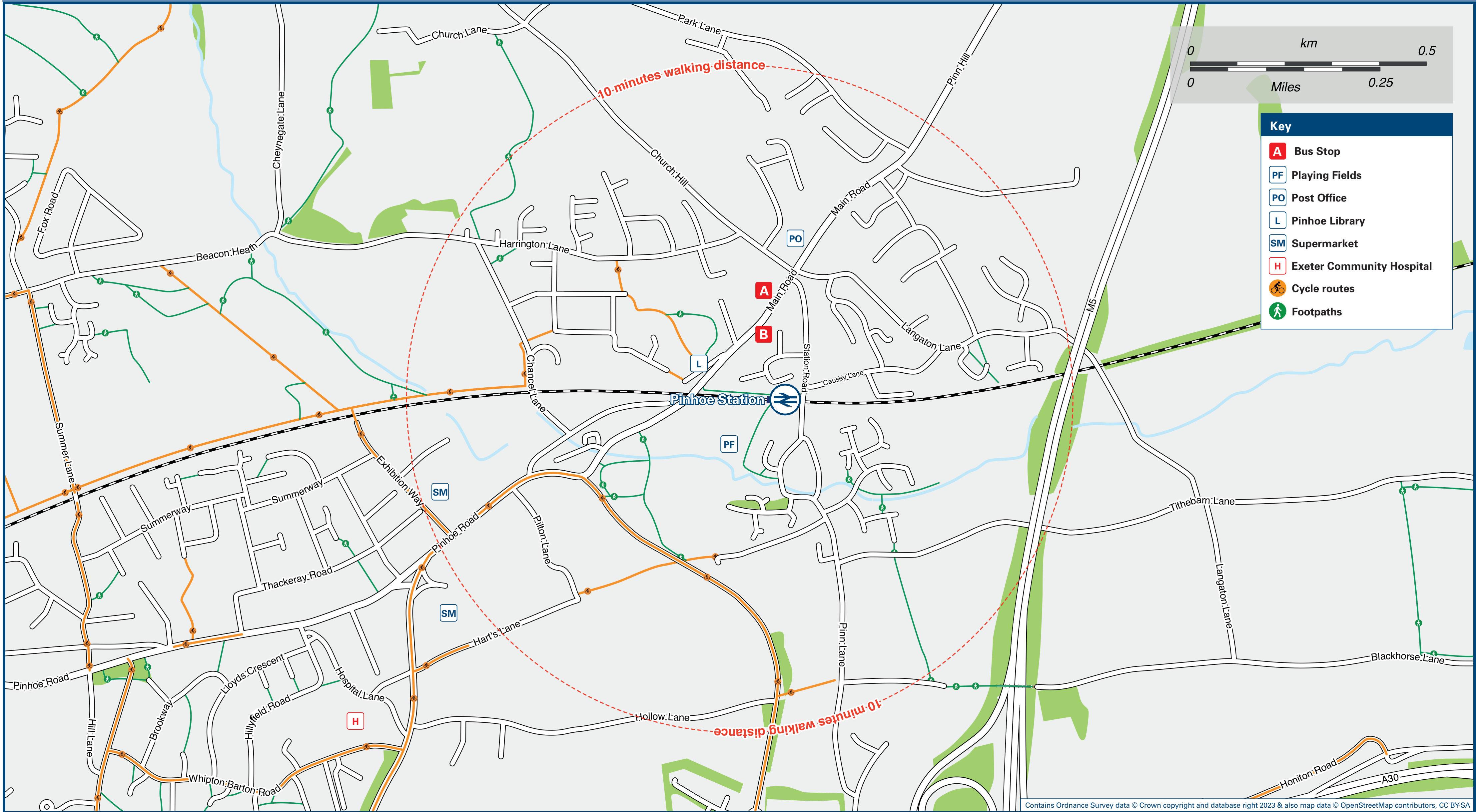




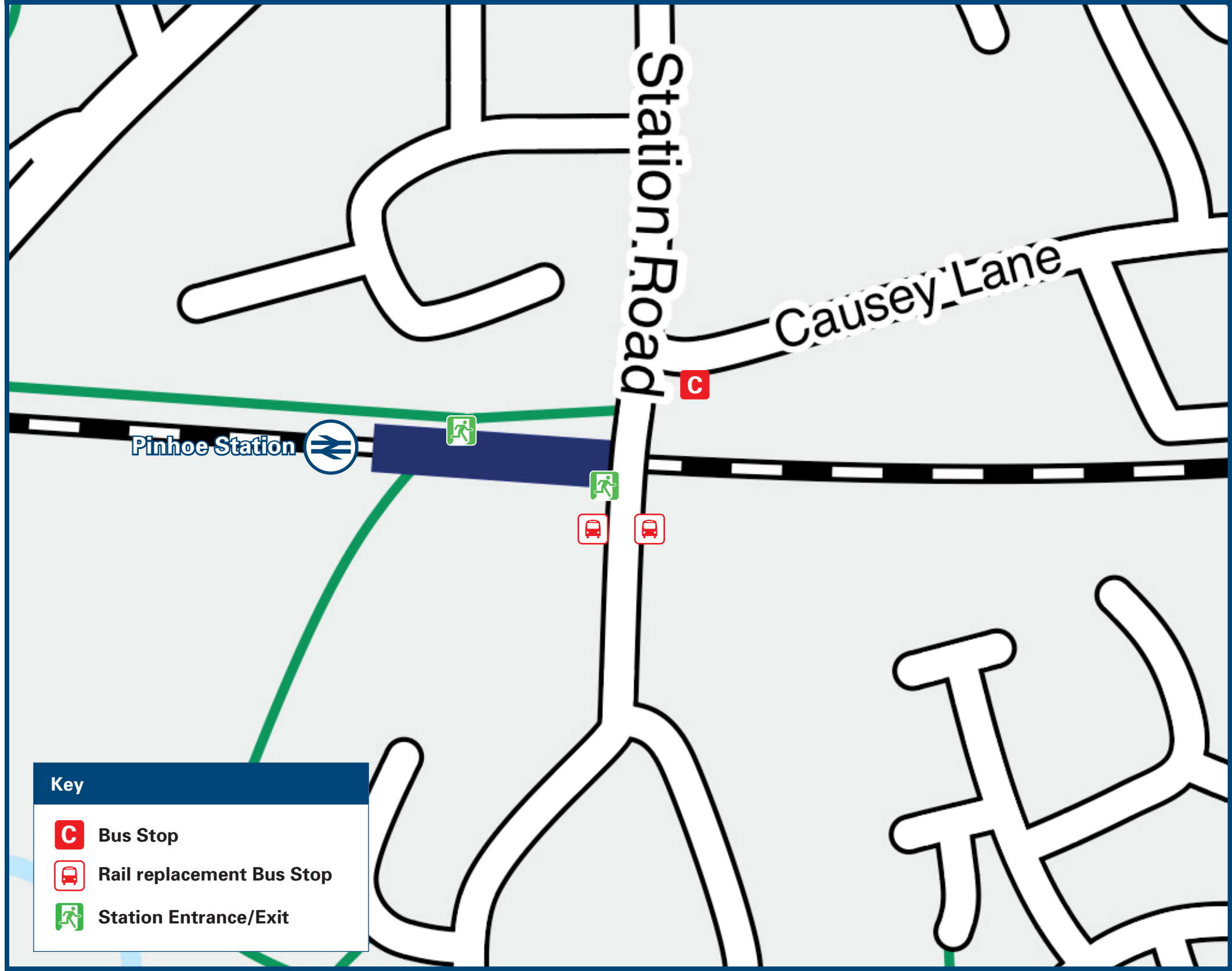
Pinhoe Station

Bus route E1 operates a limited morning and late-night service on Mondays to Saturdays, and all day on Sundays.

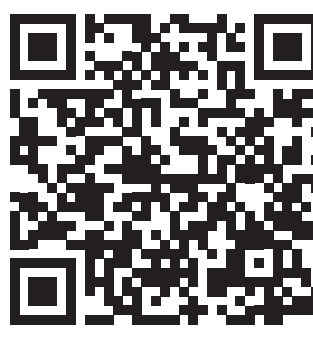
