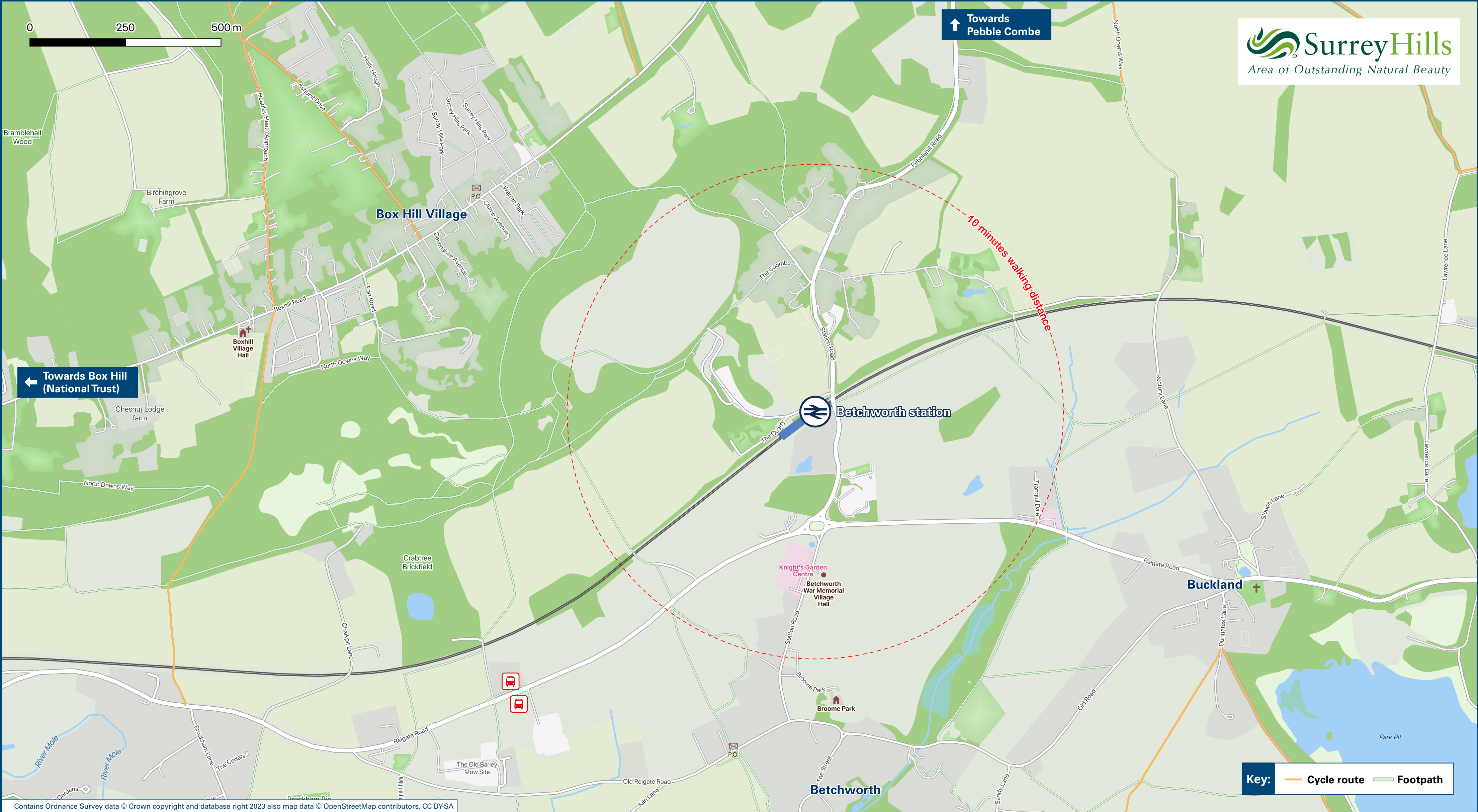

Notes

Bus route 21 operates daytime Mondays to Saturdays only. No service on Sundays or Public Holidays.
Bus route 32 operates daily from Betchworth village centre, Post Office, 10 minutes walk from this station to Dorking, Guildford and Redhill (less journeys on Sundays).

Direct trains operate from this station to Dorking Deepdene station.

"Mole Valley Connect" is an On Demand bus service available in the Mole Valley area around Dorking and including Betchworth. "Mole Valley Connect" operates Monday to Friday 7am to 7pm and Saturday 8am to 6pm, this service is available to anyone.
