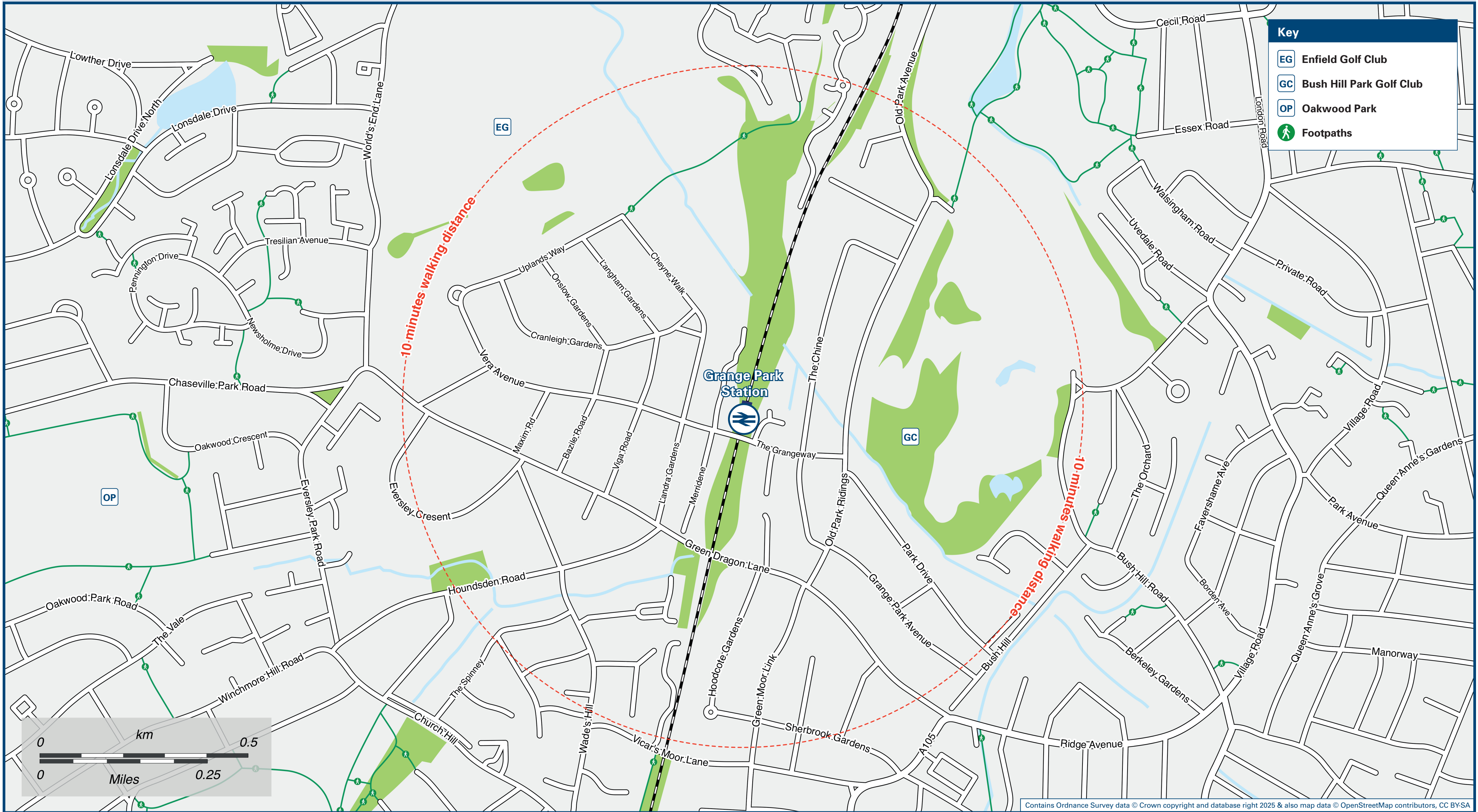




Grange Park Station
