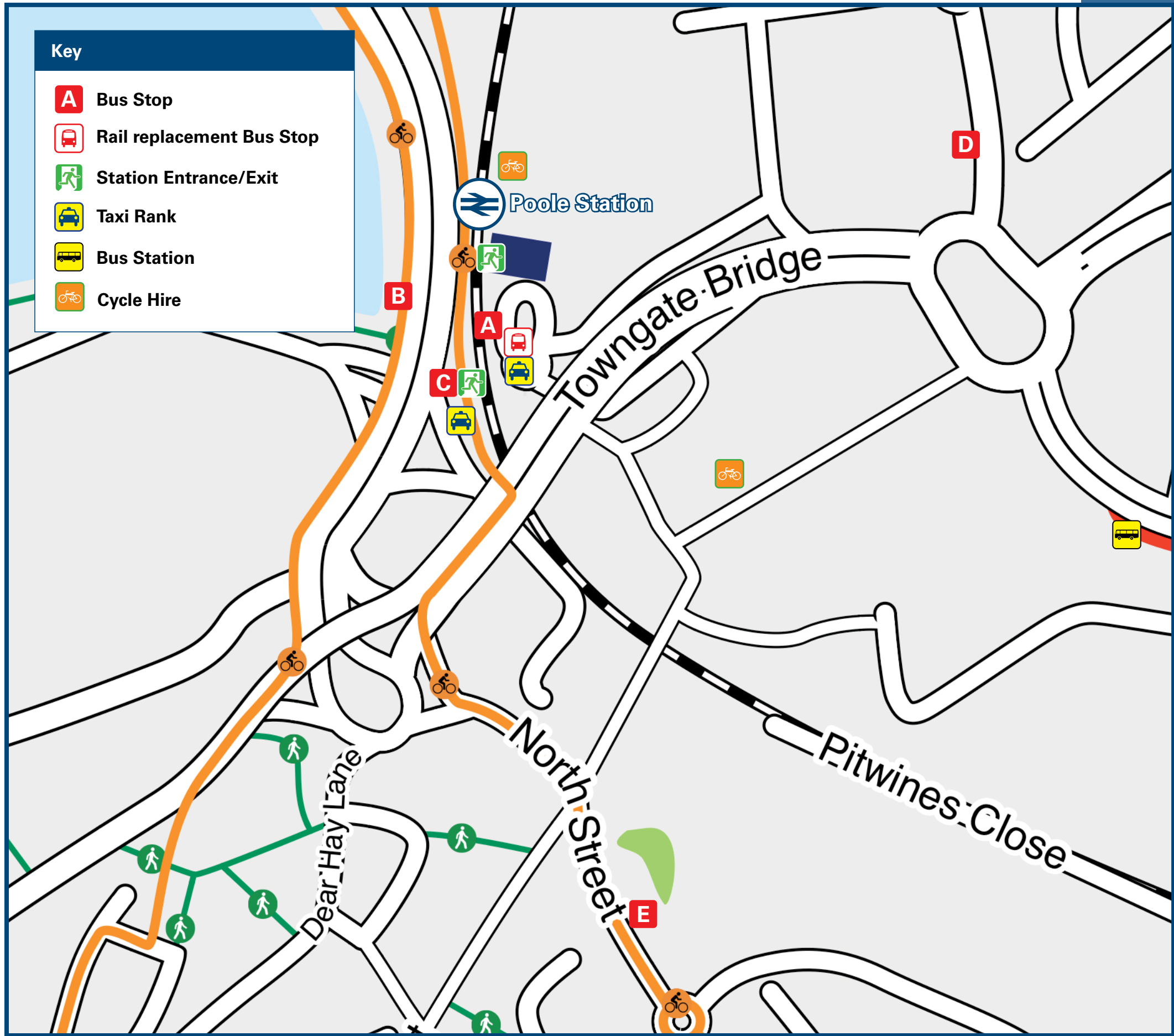

Notes

Bus routes RouteOne and 10 run Mondays to Saturdays only, no Sunday services.
All other bus routes listed on this poster operate daily services.
☁ Direct trains operate to this destination from this Station.
* Take bus RouteOne to Poole Quay for the Foot Ferry to Brownsea Island and Sandbanks.
** Take bus RouteOne to Poole Quay from where it is approximately 15 minutes walk to Poole Ferry Terminal.
Bus route 60 runs a reduced frequency service Mondays to Saturdays during Winter months. Sunday service from the Spring.
~ Bus route 3x runs a Mondays to Fridays service, only. No Saturday or Sunday service.
