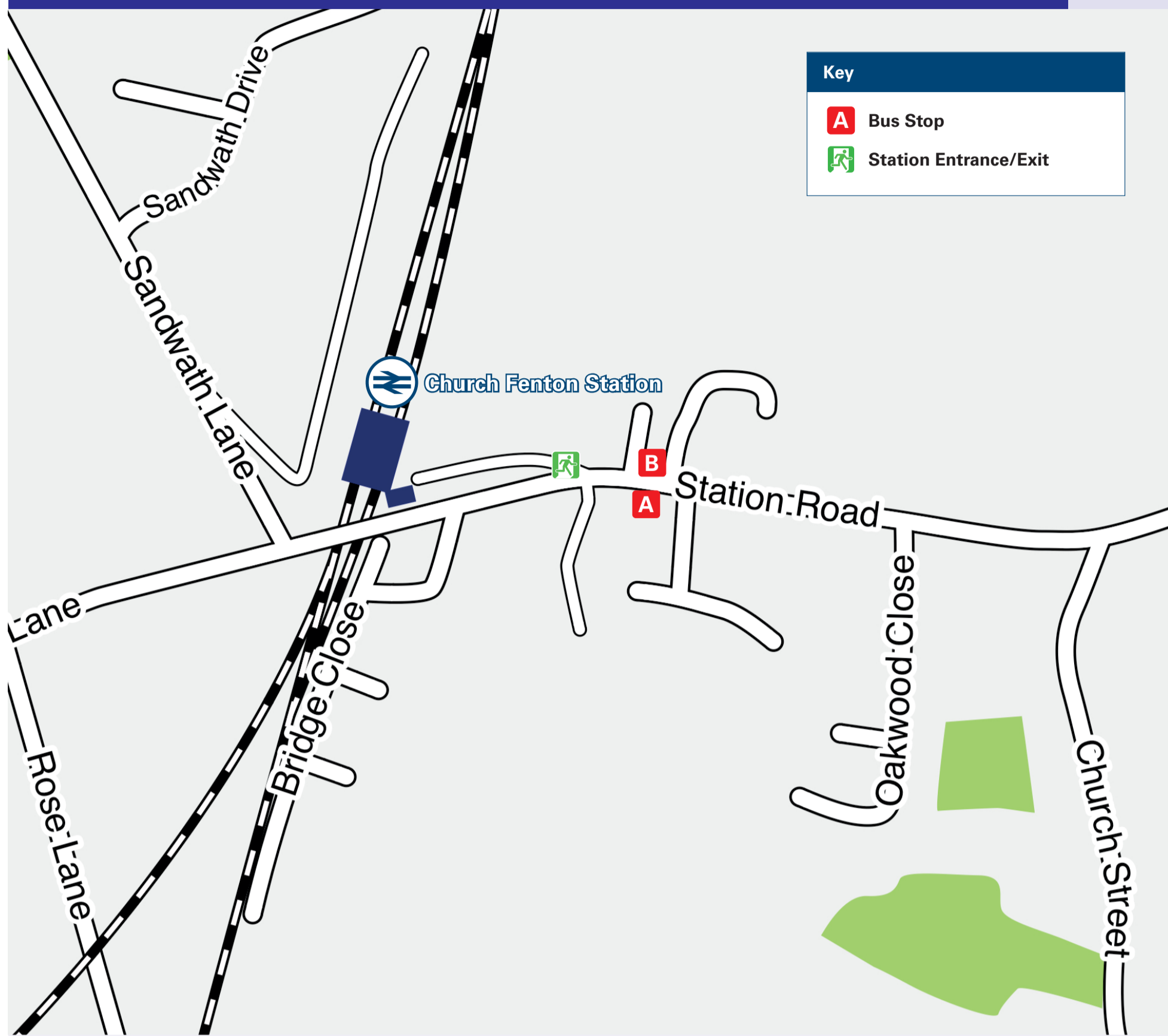

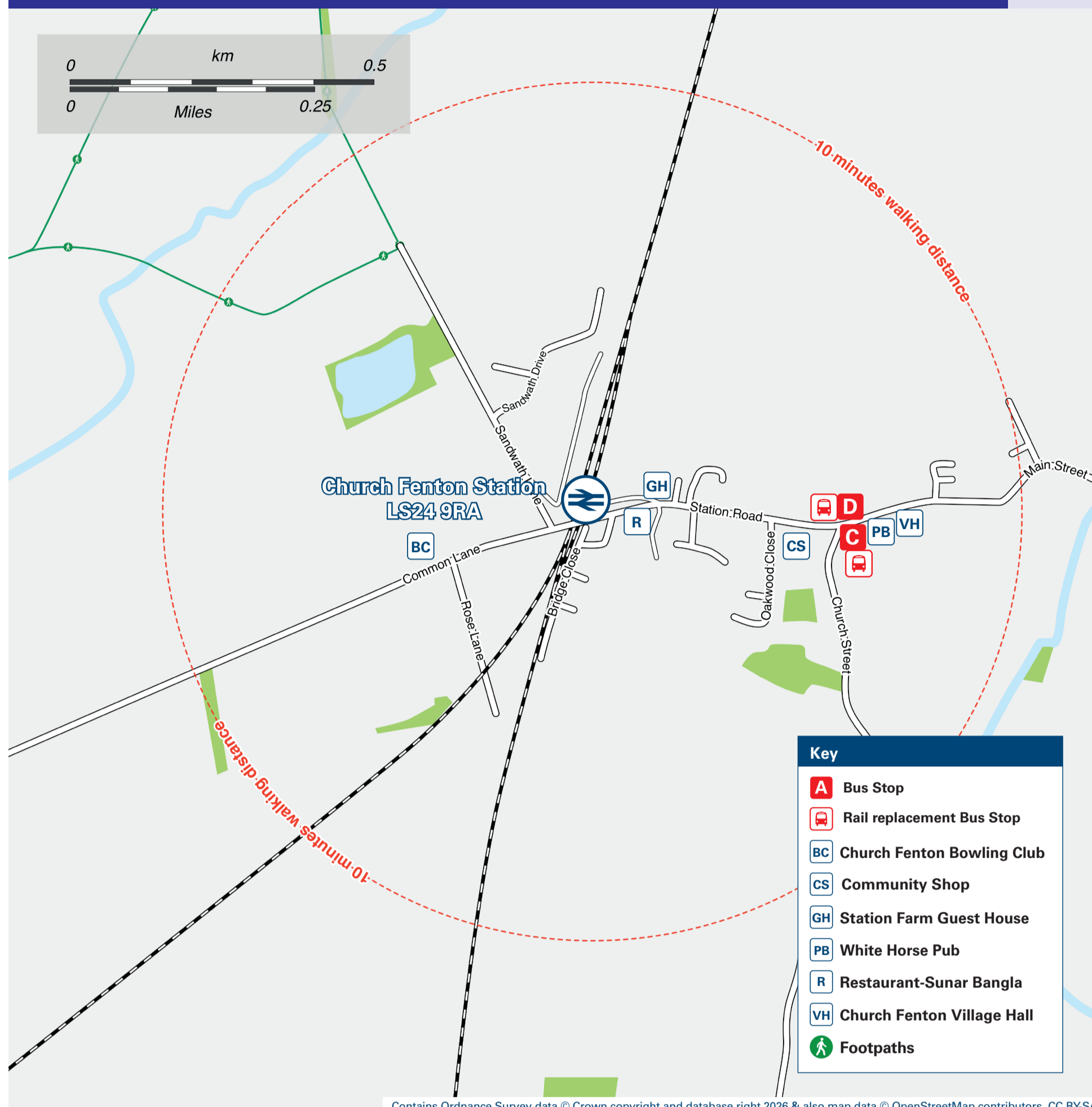
Church Fenton Station
