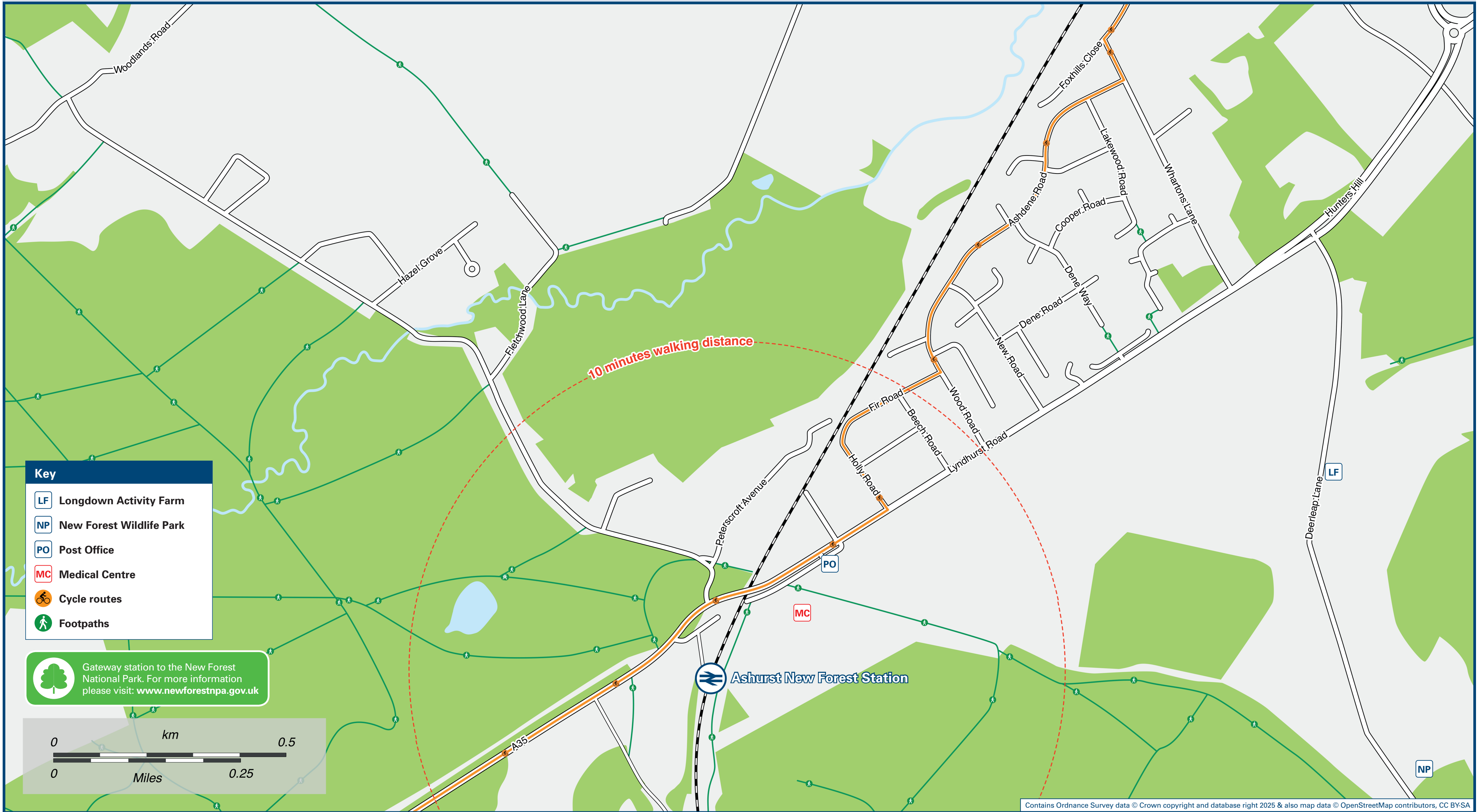




Ashurst New Forest Station
