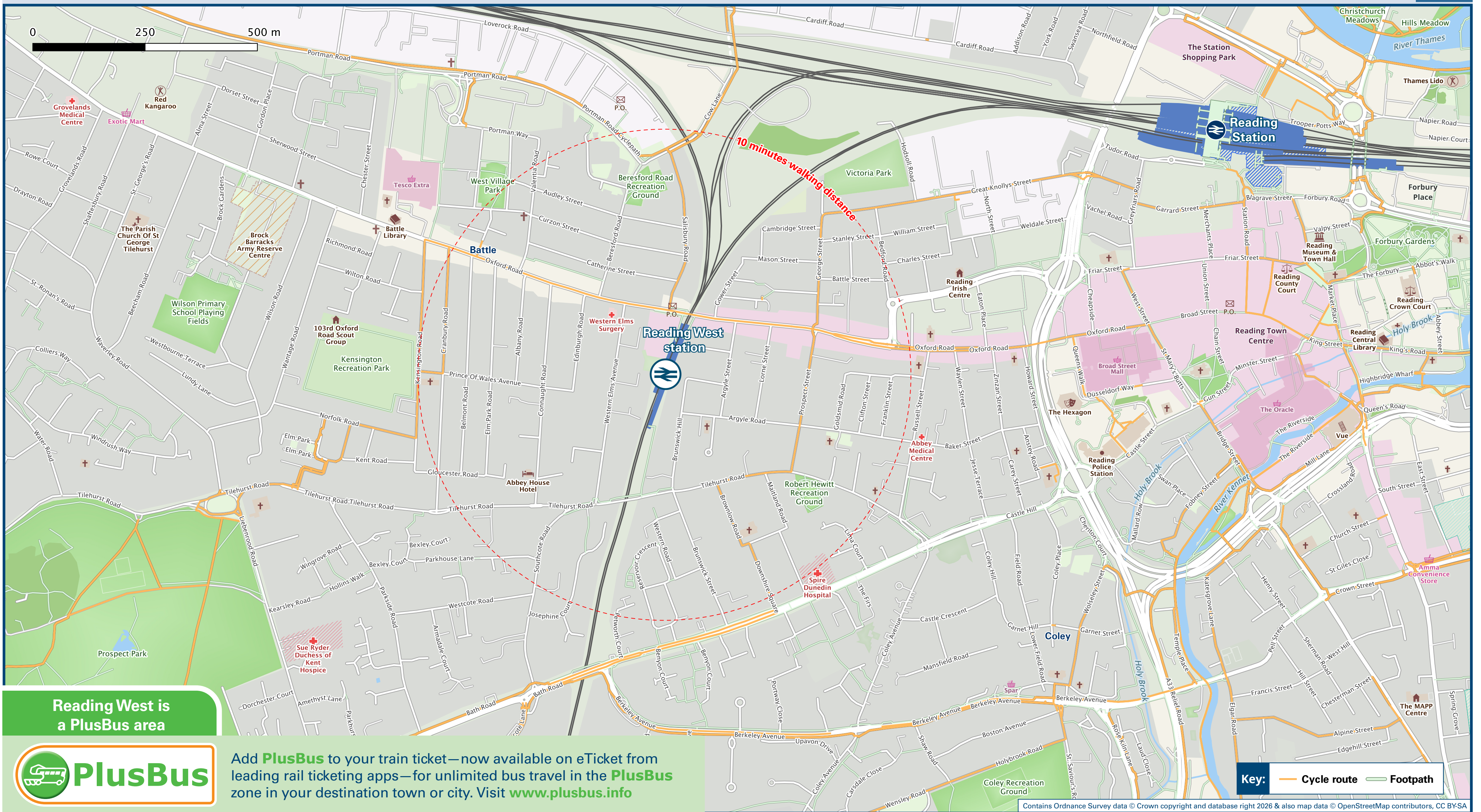

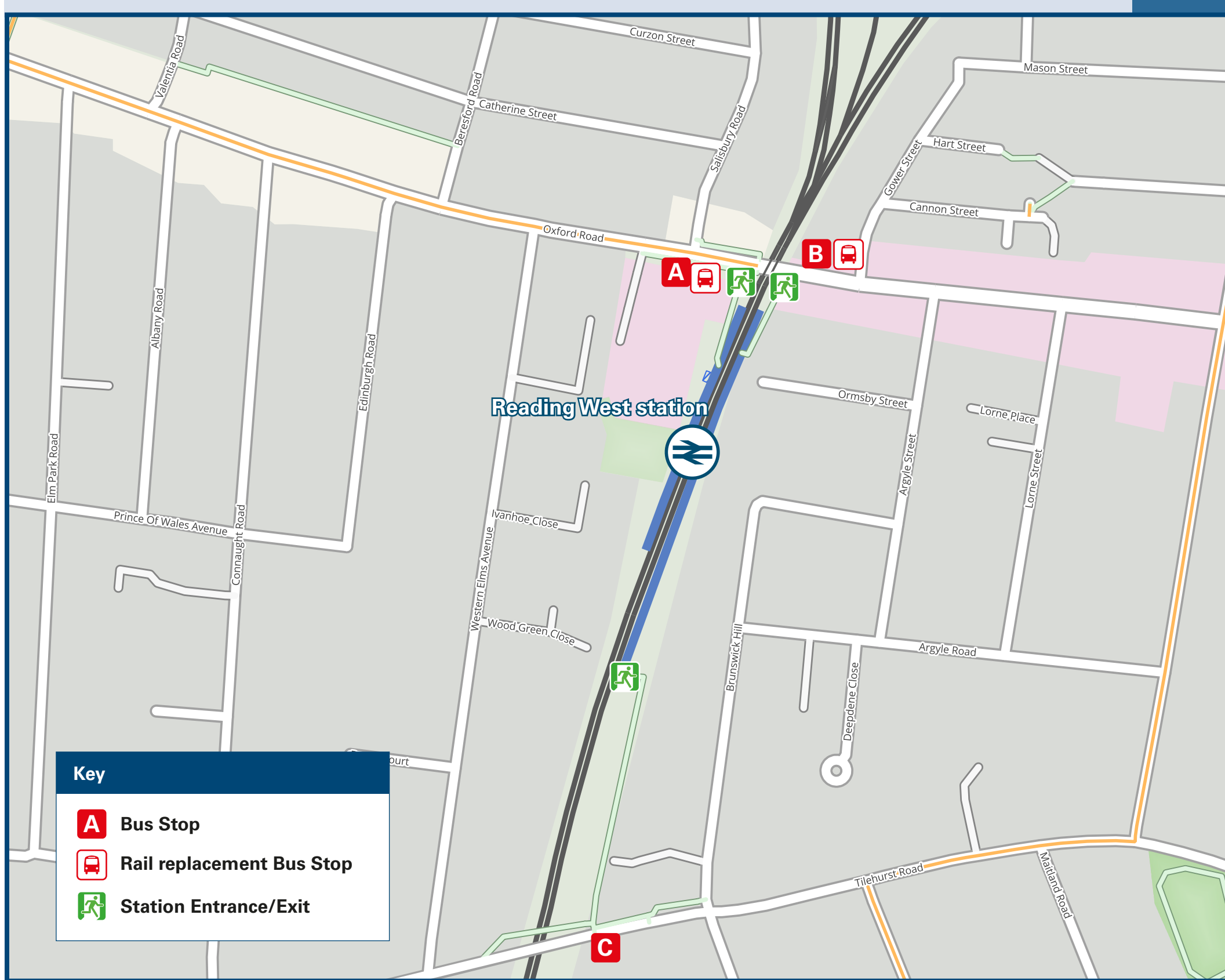
Local area map

- **PLUSBUS** destination, please see below for details. Bus routes 15, 16, 17 and 33 operate daily services. Bus route 15a operates a Mondays to Saturdays service, only. No Sunday service. For bus times and days of operation please contact Traveline on www.traveline.info or call: 0871 200 22 33. Extensive bus connections to all parts of Reading and beyond from bus stops at Reading station.
- Ⓞ Direct trains operate from Reading West station to Reading station.
- Ⓞ For connecting train services to this destination, please change trains at Reading or see how to get to Tilehurst station for trains to Goring & Stratley and Pangbourne.
- # Bus route 43 operates a limited daytime service on Mondays to Saturdays, only. No evenings or Sundays services.
- * Bus route 17 runs a daily service, and also night buses.
- Alight bus at Kentwood Circle roundabout and walk 5 minutes along Oxford Road to Tilehurst Station.
