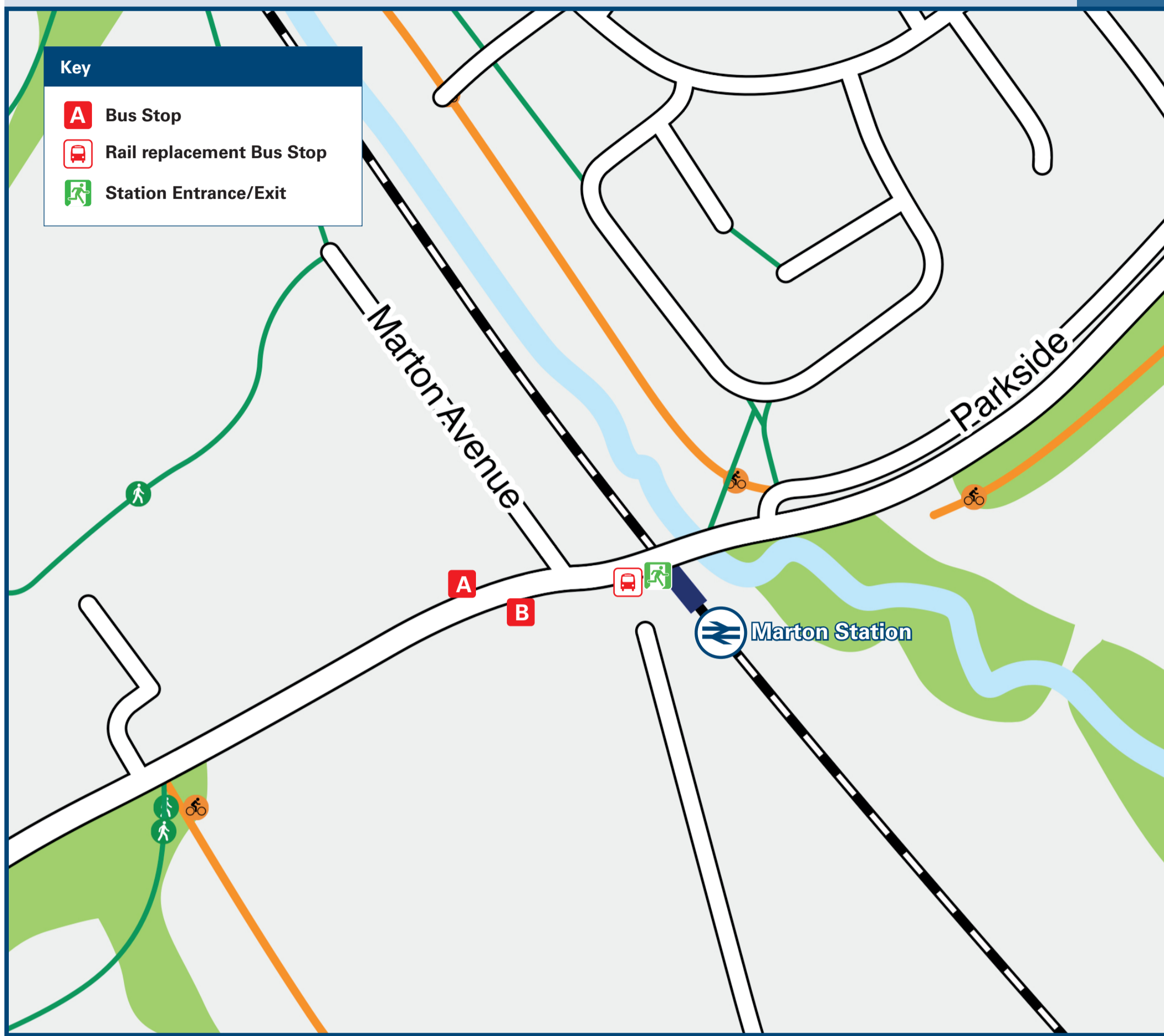

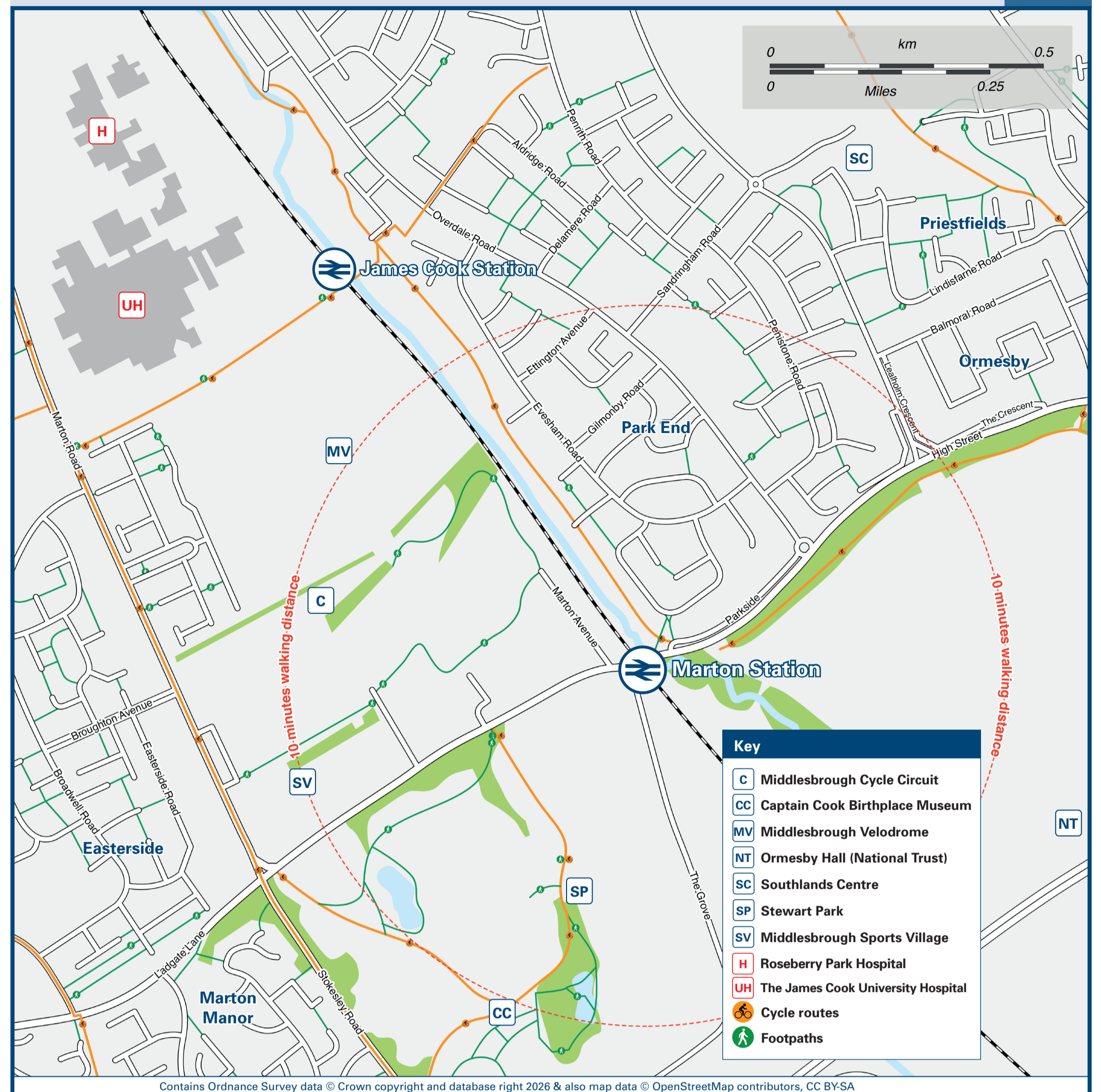
# Onward Travel Information
