- PlusBus destination, please see below for details. Bus routes 6, 7, 19, 25, 42 and 43 operate Mondays to Saturdays. Bus routes 19a, 21 and 22 operate daily, Mondays to Sundays. Nottsbus Connect 108 operates Mondays to Saturdays from Workshop bus station to most parts of Workshop, contact Traveline for times and calling points. For bus times please see bus stop or bus station timetables or contact Traveline on 0871 200 22 33.
- Direct trains operate to this destination from Workshop.
- It's a 10 to 15 minutes walk from this station to Workshop town centre and bus station, see Local area map for walking route.
- # Additional bus services including Workshop town service and out of town bus routes depart from the bus station.
- + Bus routes 21 and 25 continue as route 5 from Workshop bus station to Sandy Lane for Asda & Sainsbury's stores, no need to change buses.
