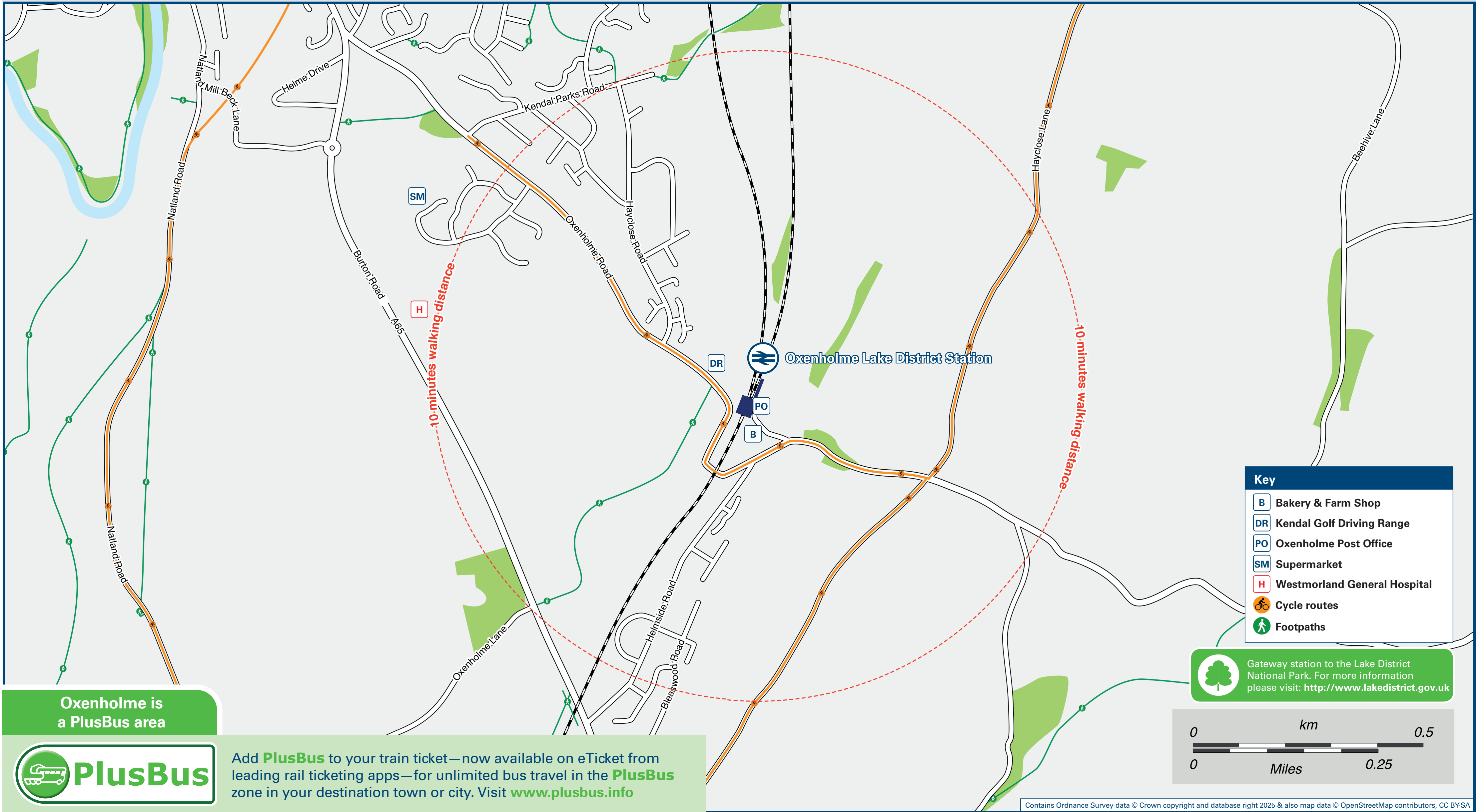




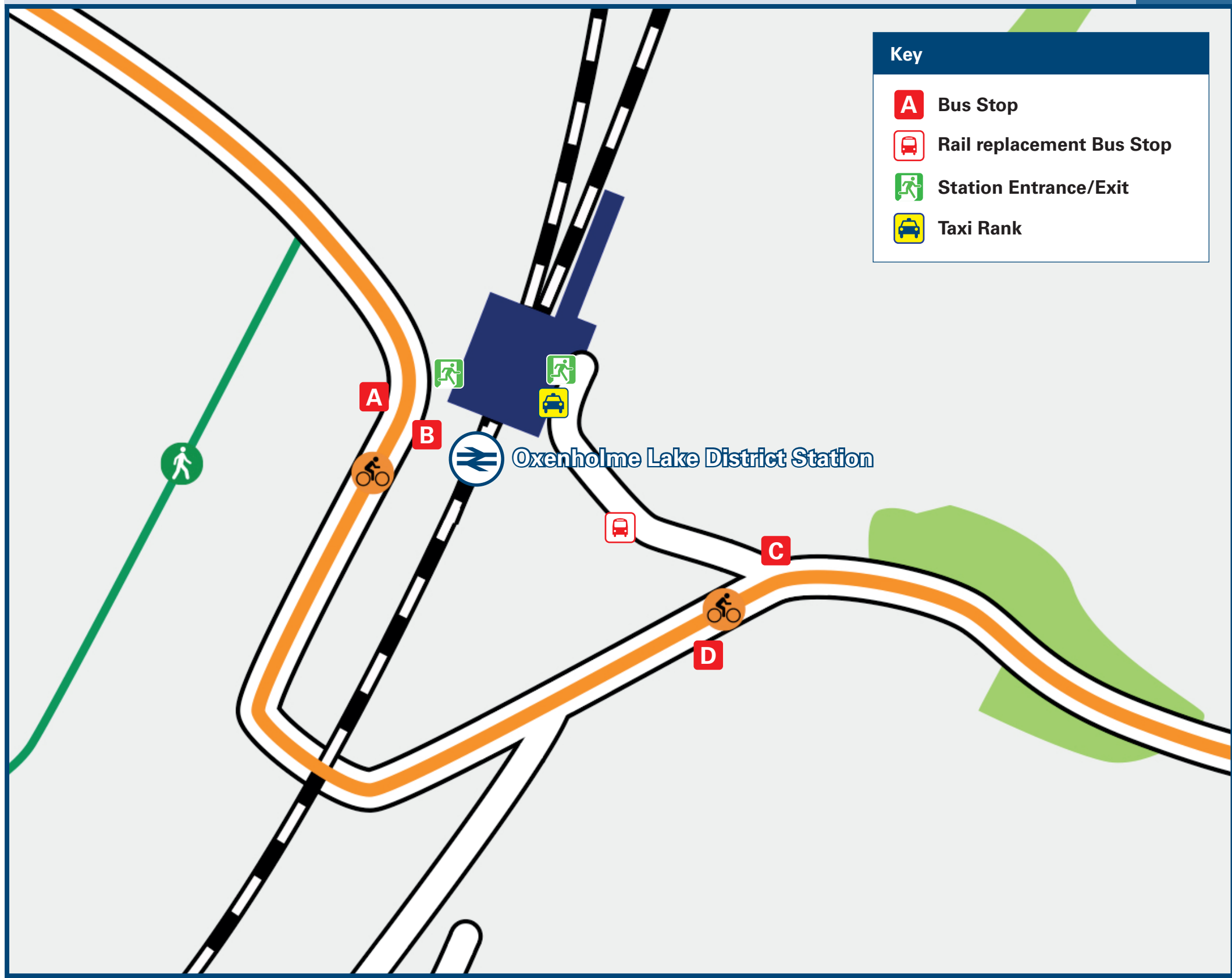
Oxenholme Lake District Station
