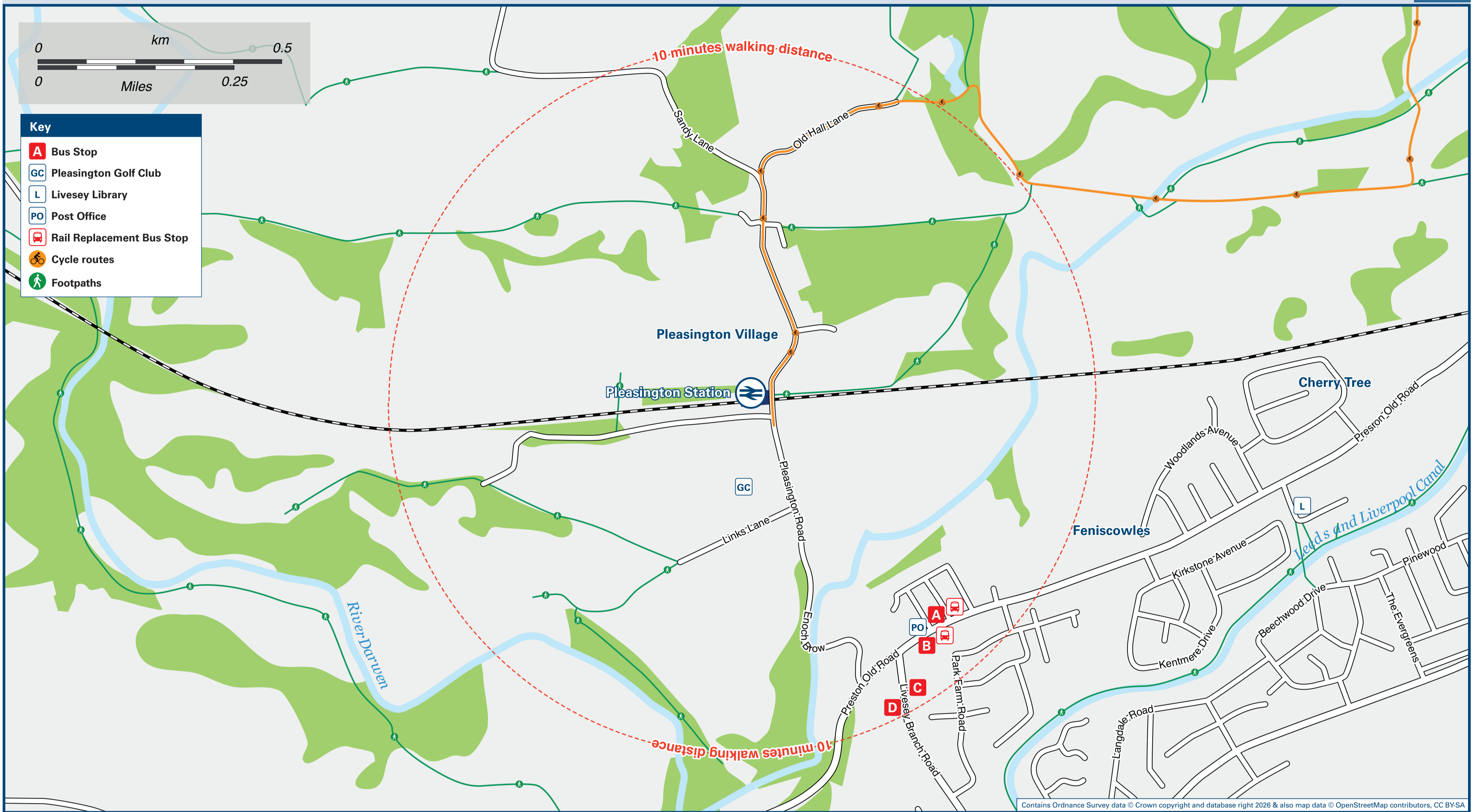




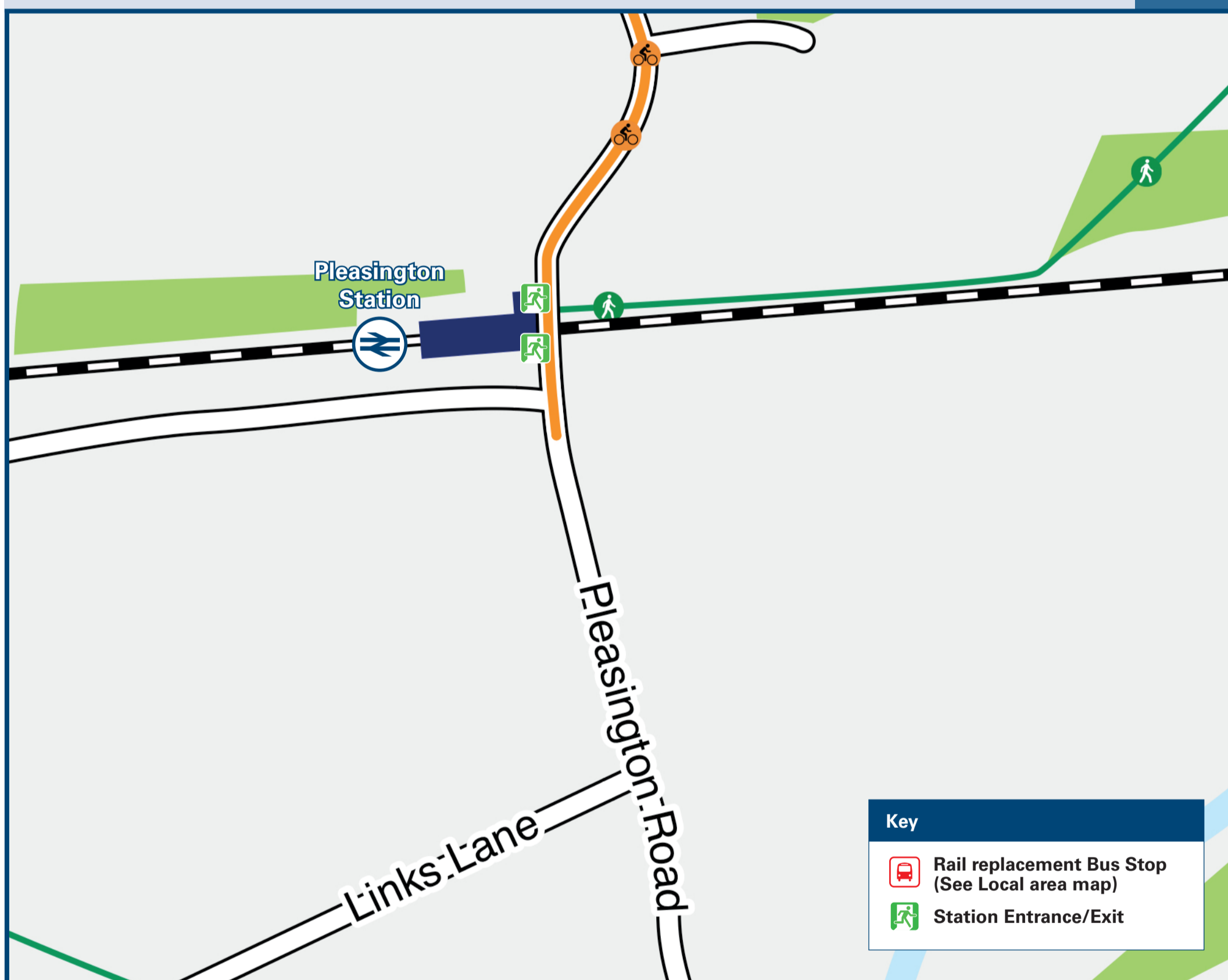

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING PLEASINGTON RAILWAY STATION

The nearest bus stops are located at Feniscowles on the Old Preston Road and Livesey Branch Road, a 15 minutes walk from this station, see the Local area map.

From bus stop **A** bus route 152 runs daily including evenings to Blackburn.

From bus stop **B** bus route 152 runs daily including evenings to Preston.

From bus stop **C** bus route 2 runs daily including evenings, and bus route 2A runs Mondays to Saturdays to Blackburn via Ewood.

From bus stop **D** bus route 2 runs daily including evenings, and bus route 2A runs Mondays to Saturdays to Chorley via Abbey Village, Brinscall and Wheelton
