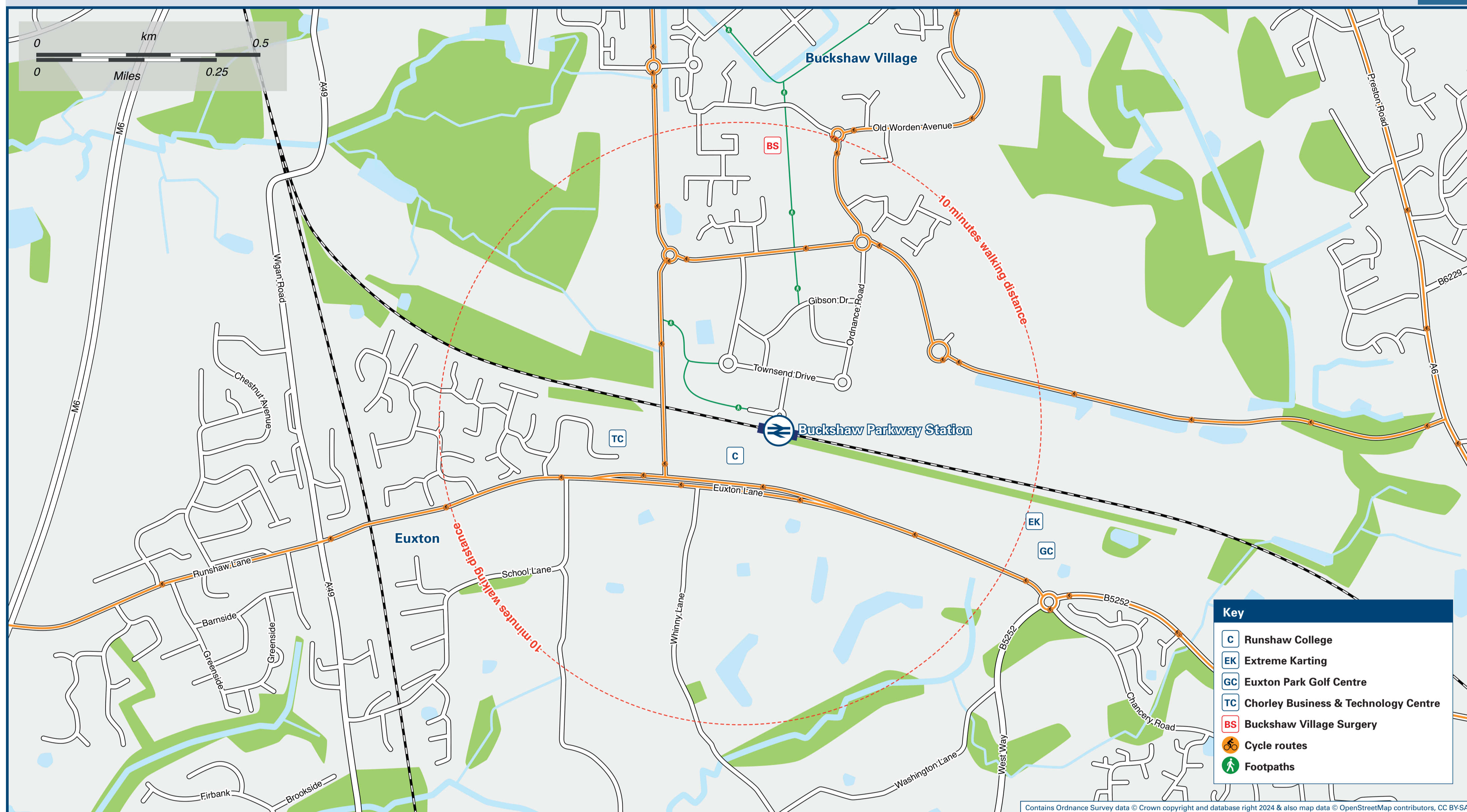




Buckshaw Parkway Station
