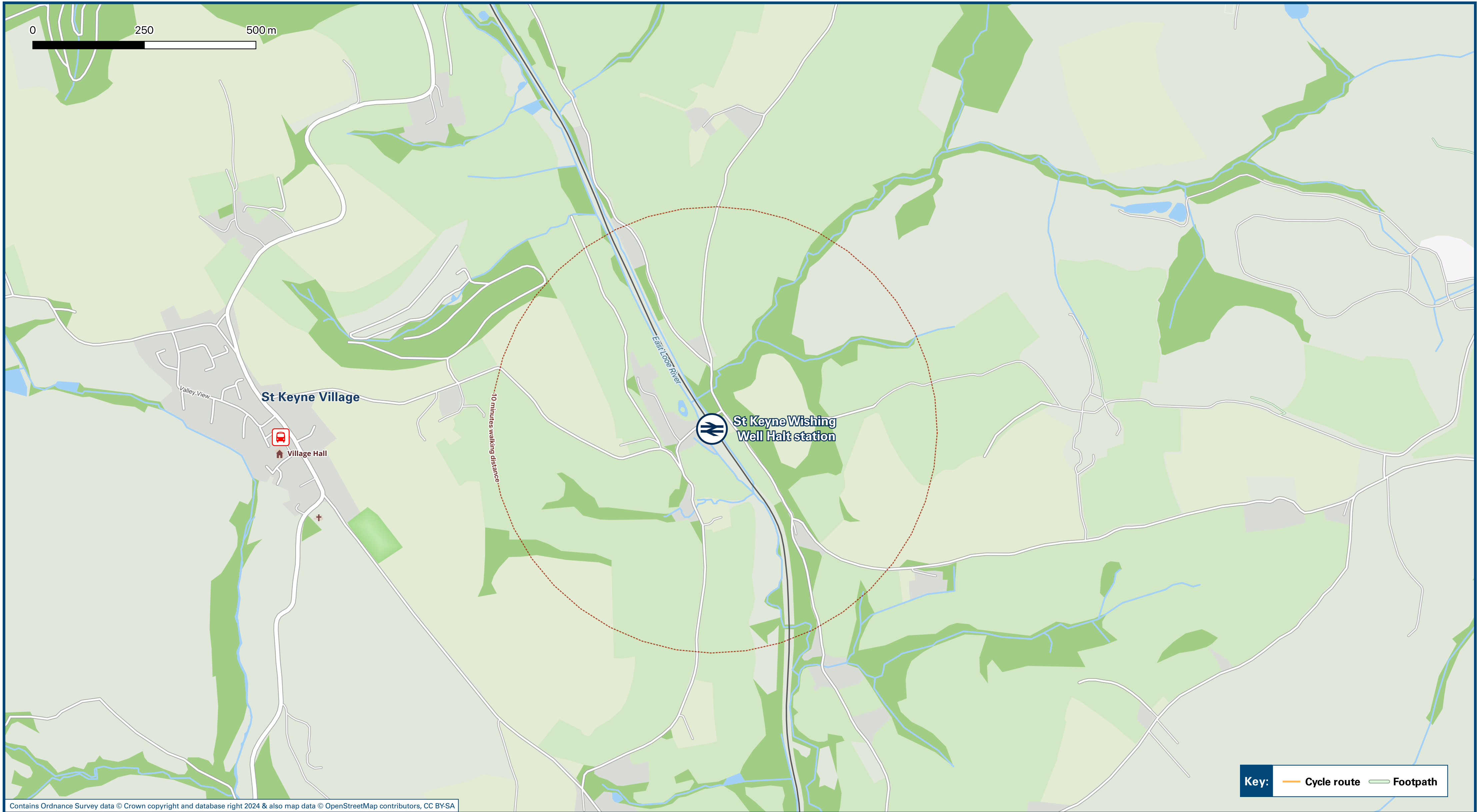




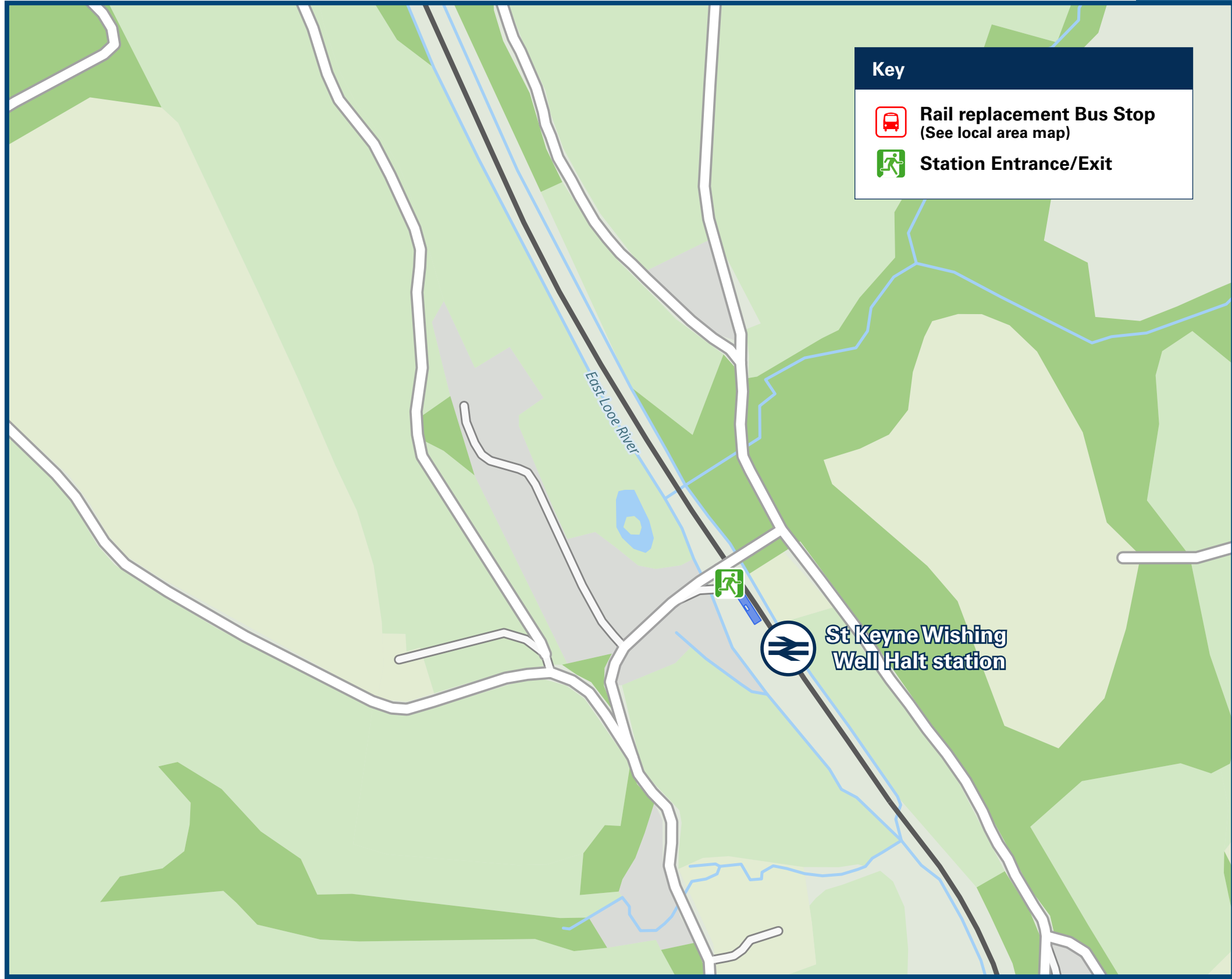
# St Keyne Wishing Well Halt Station
