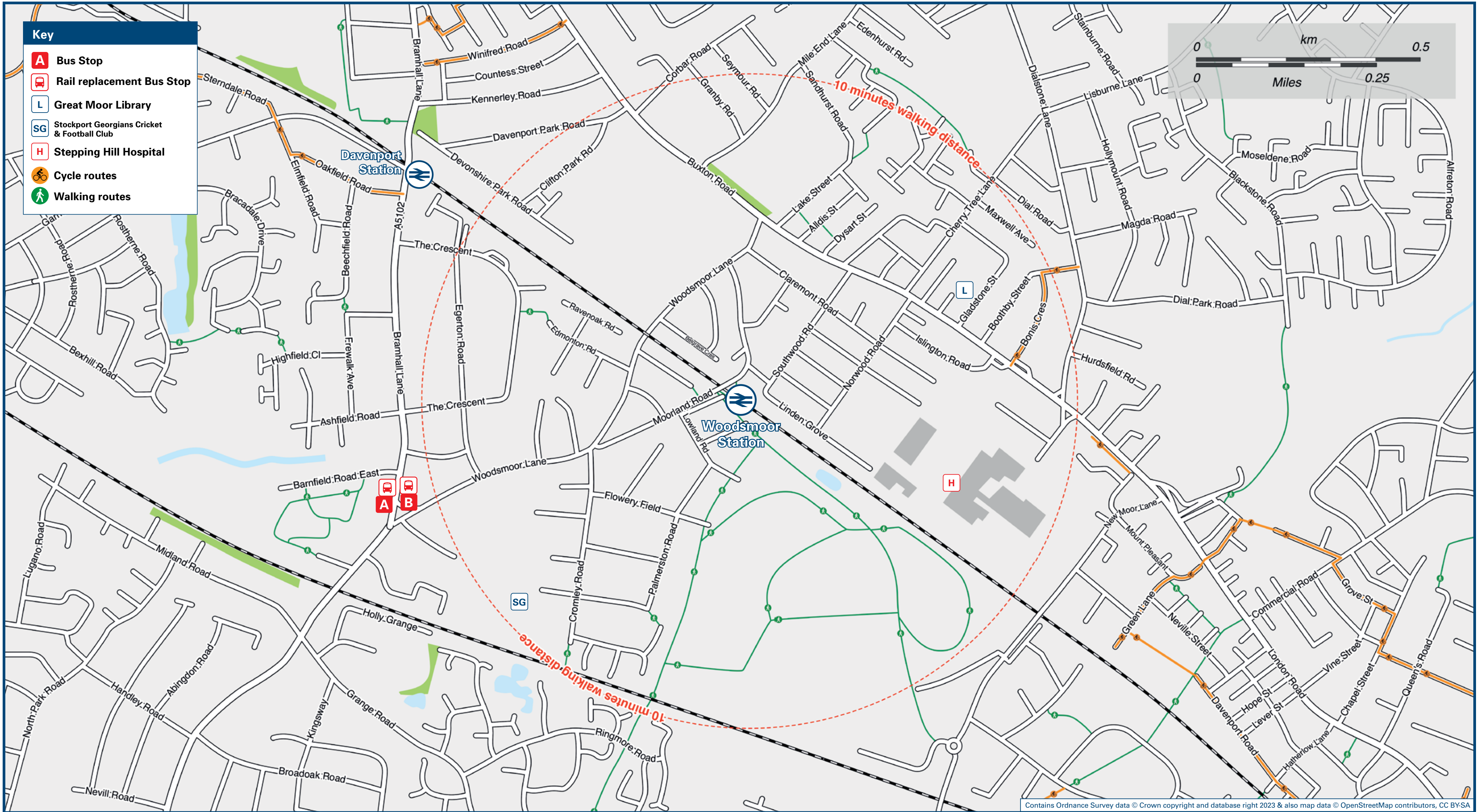




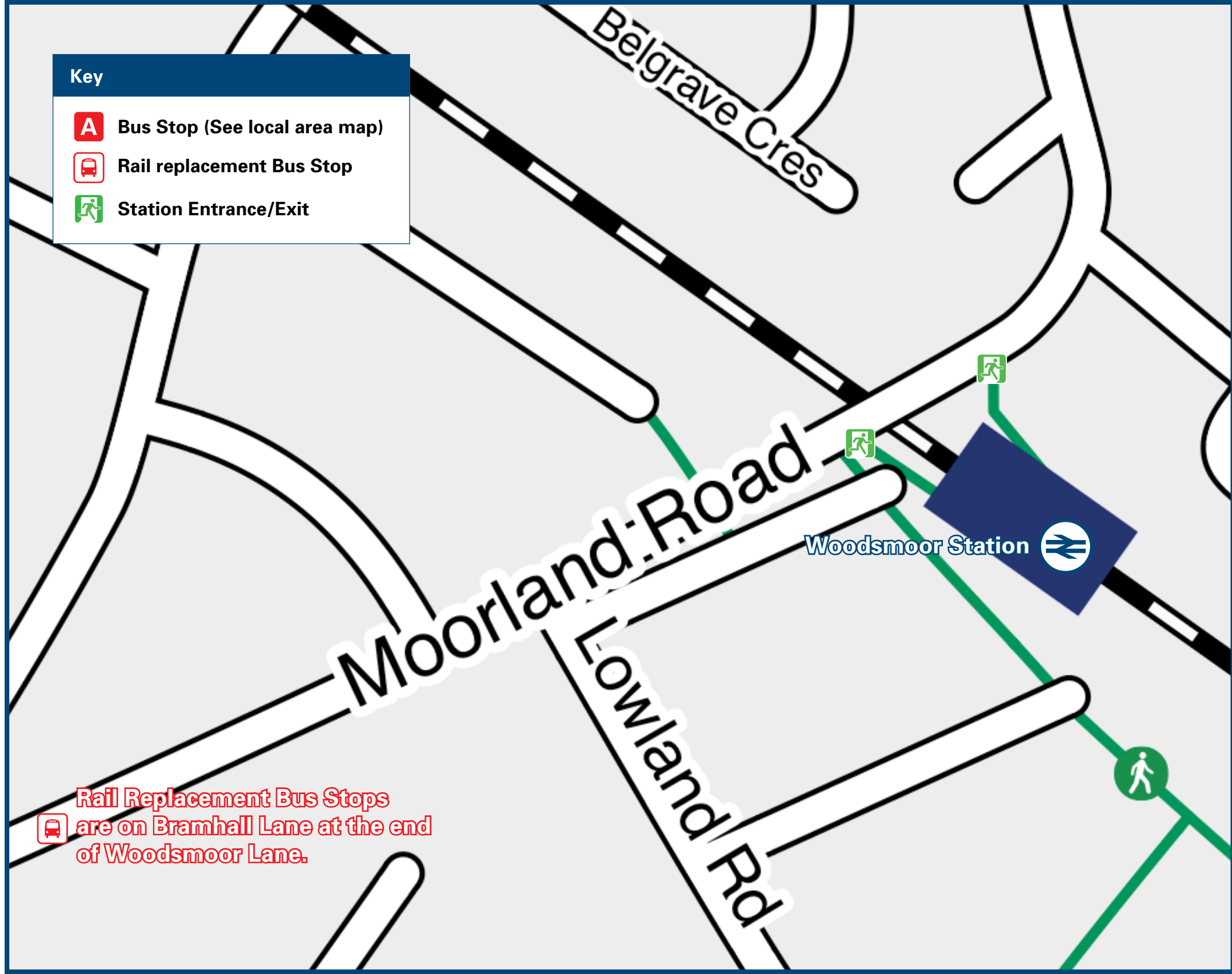
Woodsmoor Station

Rail replacement buses to Manchester and Stockport will stop at bus stop on Bramhall Lane between Barnfield Road and Ashfield Road. Buses to Hazel Grove will stop at bus stop on Bramhall Lane north of the junction with Woodend Road.
