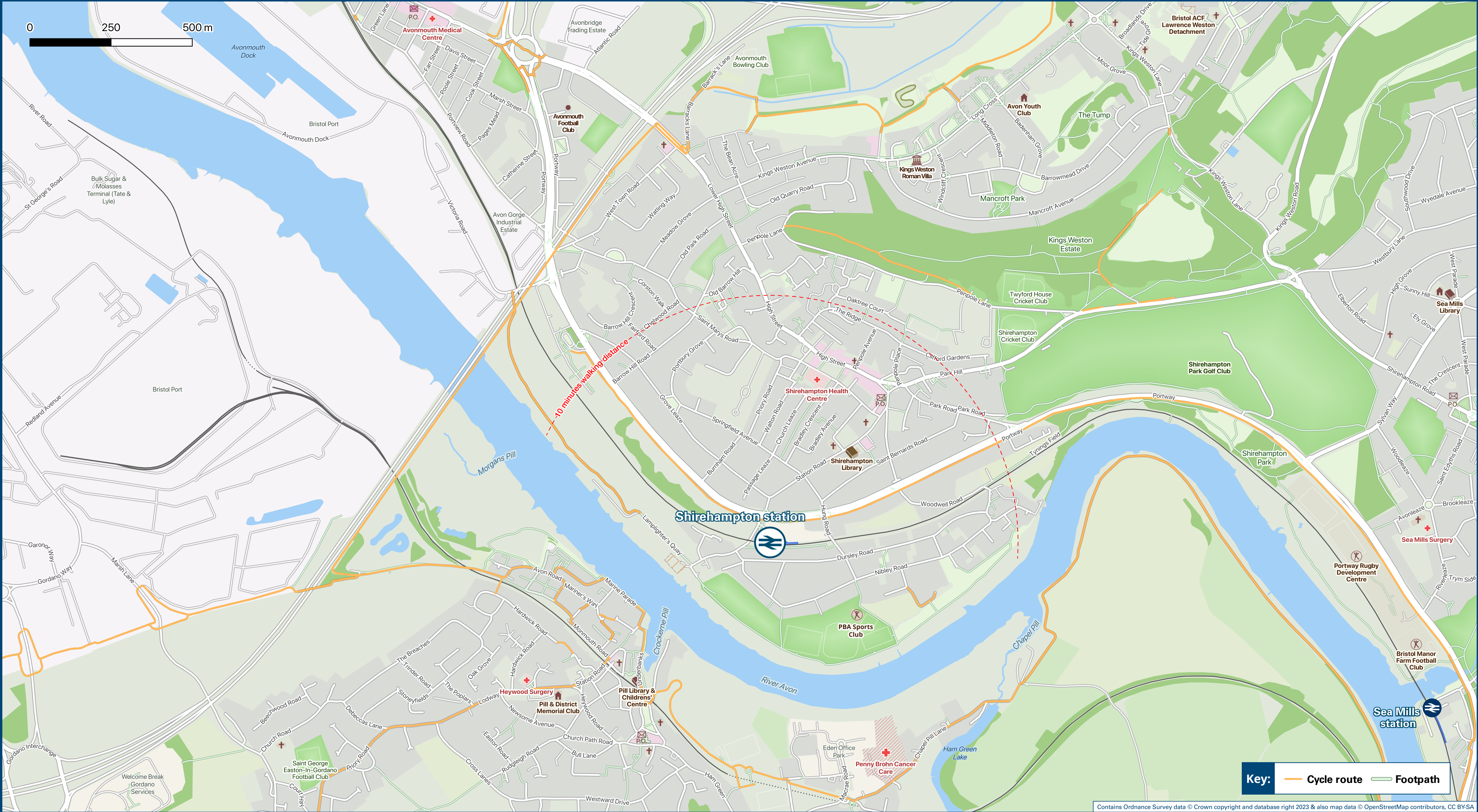




Shirehampton Station

When it is necessary to run rail replacement bus or taxi services these can usually be found at the bus laybys on A4 Portway, both sides on the road. Taxis depart from the station approach road.

Notes

Bus route 13 operates on Mondays to Saturdays, only. No Sunday/Public Holiday service.

Bus route 9 runs a daily service, operating Mondays to Sundays and Public Holidays.
