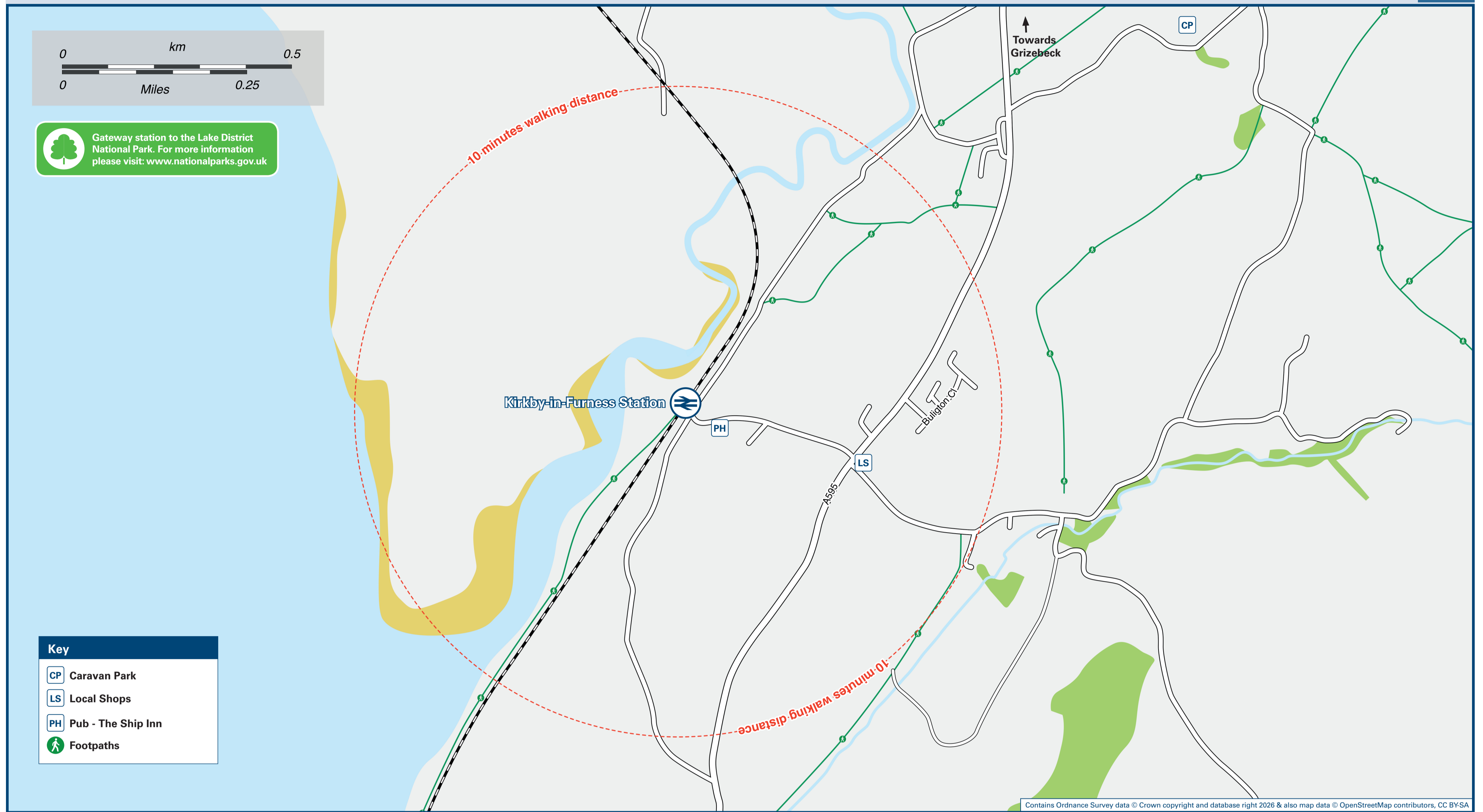




Kirkby-in-Furness Station

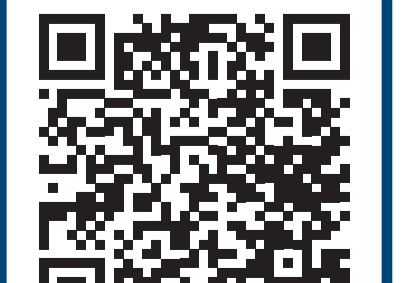
