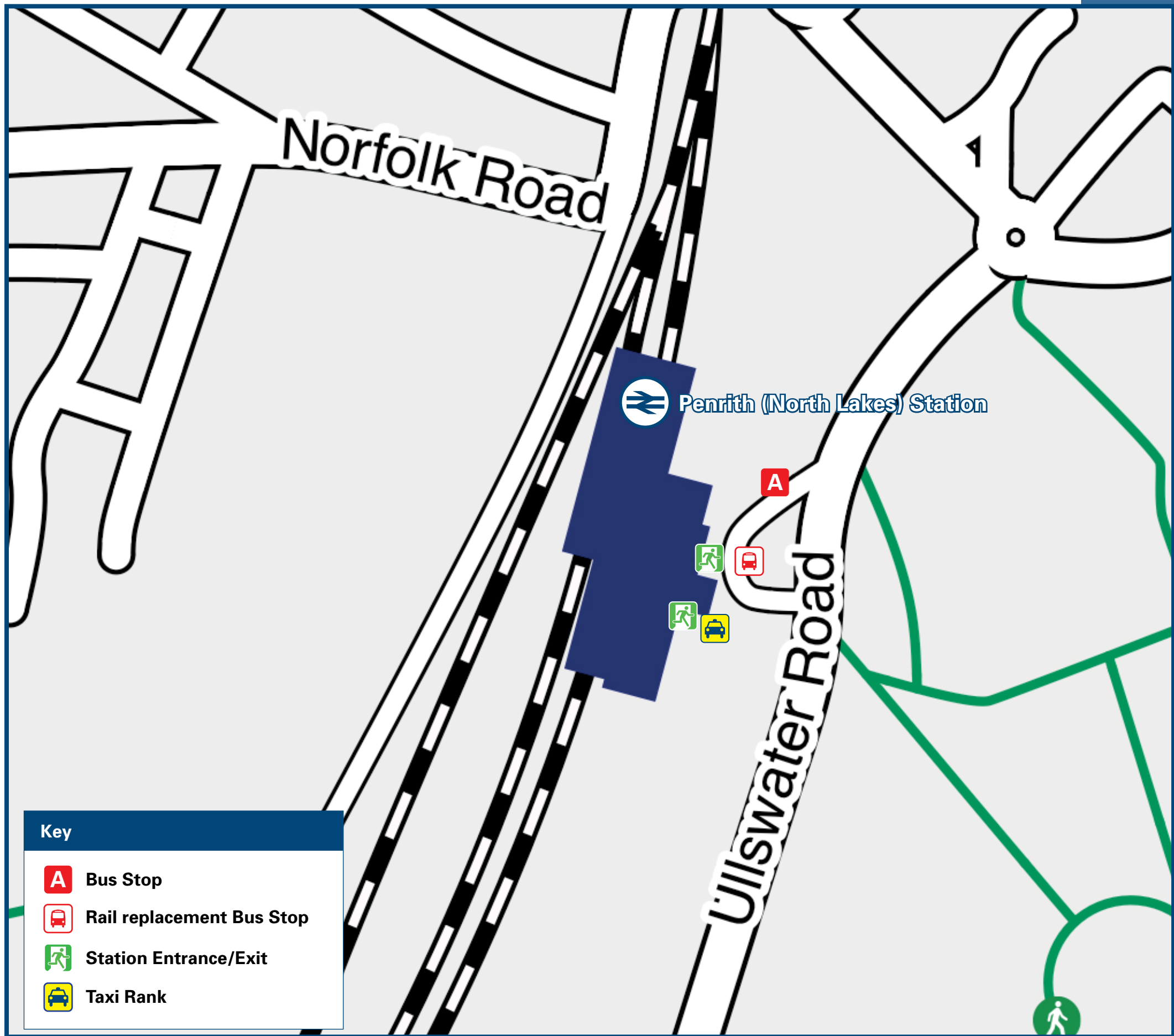




# Penrith Station
