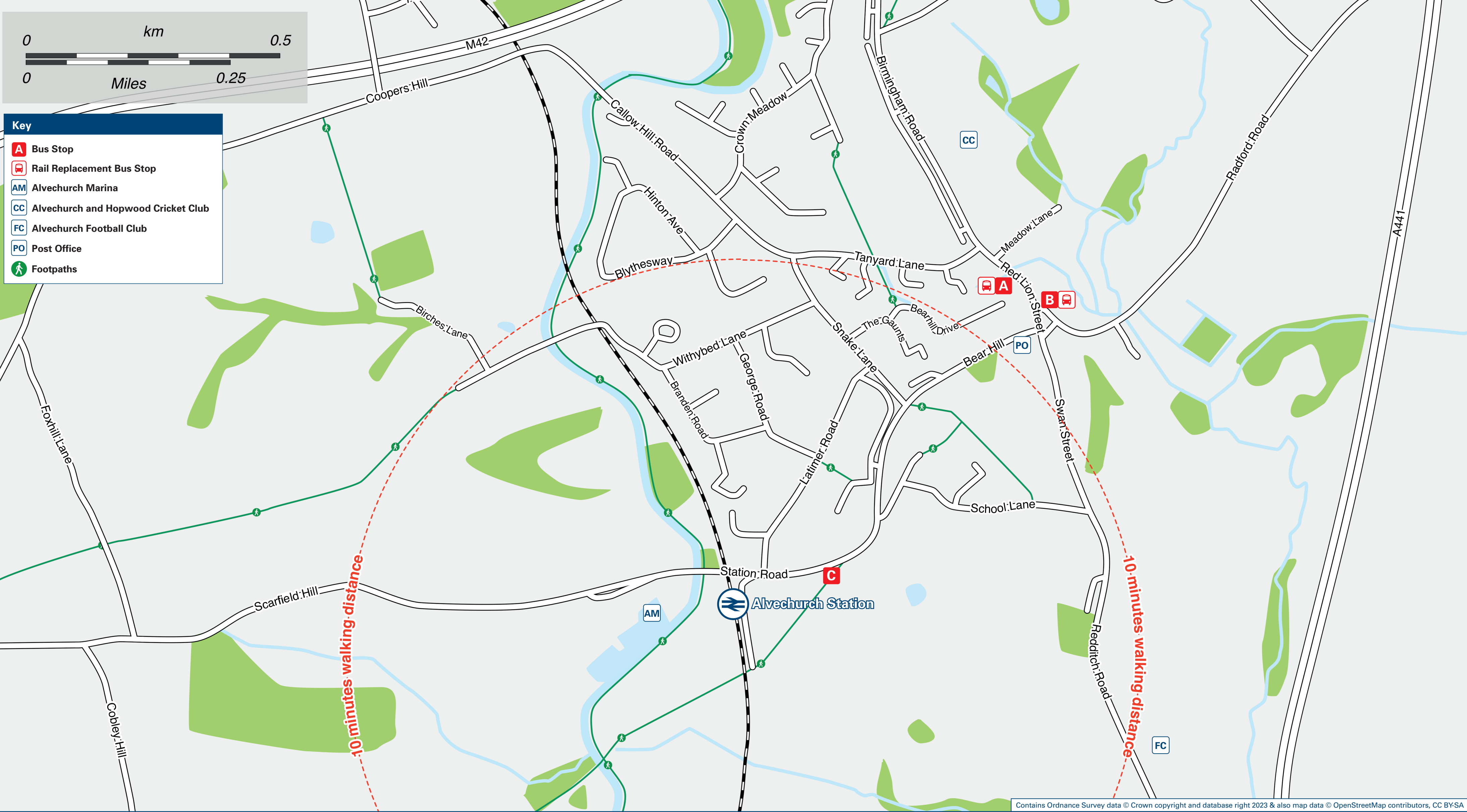




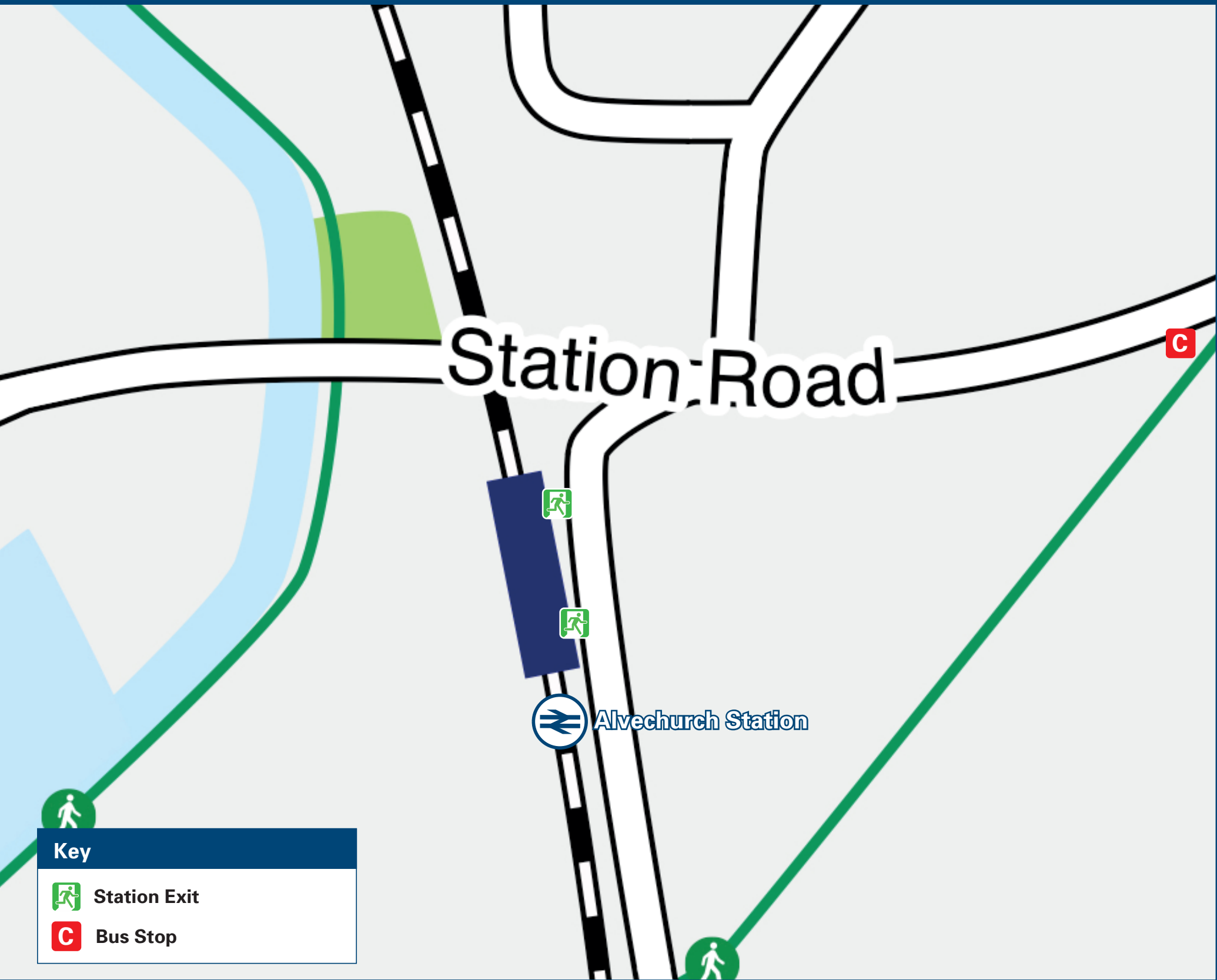

THERE ARE NO FREQUENT BUS SERVICES SERVING ALVECHURCH RAILWAY STATION

Bus routes 182 and 183 operate a limited service Mondays to Fridays only:

Bus route 182 operates from stop **C** at 09:49 to Rowney Green and Redditch - buses also call at stop **B**.

Bus route 183 operates from stop **C** at 10:34 to Hopwood, Barnt Green, Cofton Hackett, Lickey, Lickey End and Bromsgrove - buses also call at stop **A**.

Bus route 182 operates from stop **C** at 12:43 to Hopwood, Barnt Green, Cofton Hackett, Lickey, Lickey End and Bromsgrove - buses also call at stop **A**.

Bus route 183 operates from stop **C** at 13:56 to Rowney Green and Redditch - buses also call at stop **B**.
