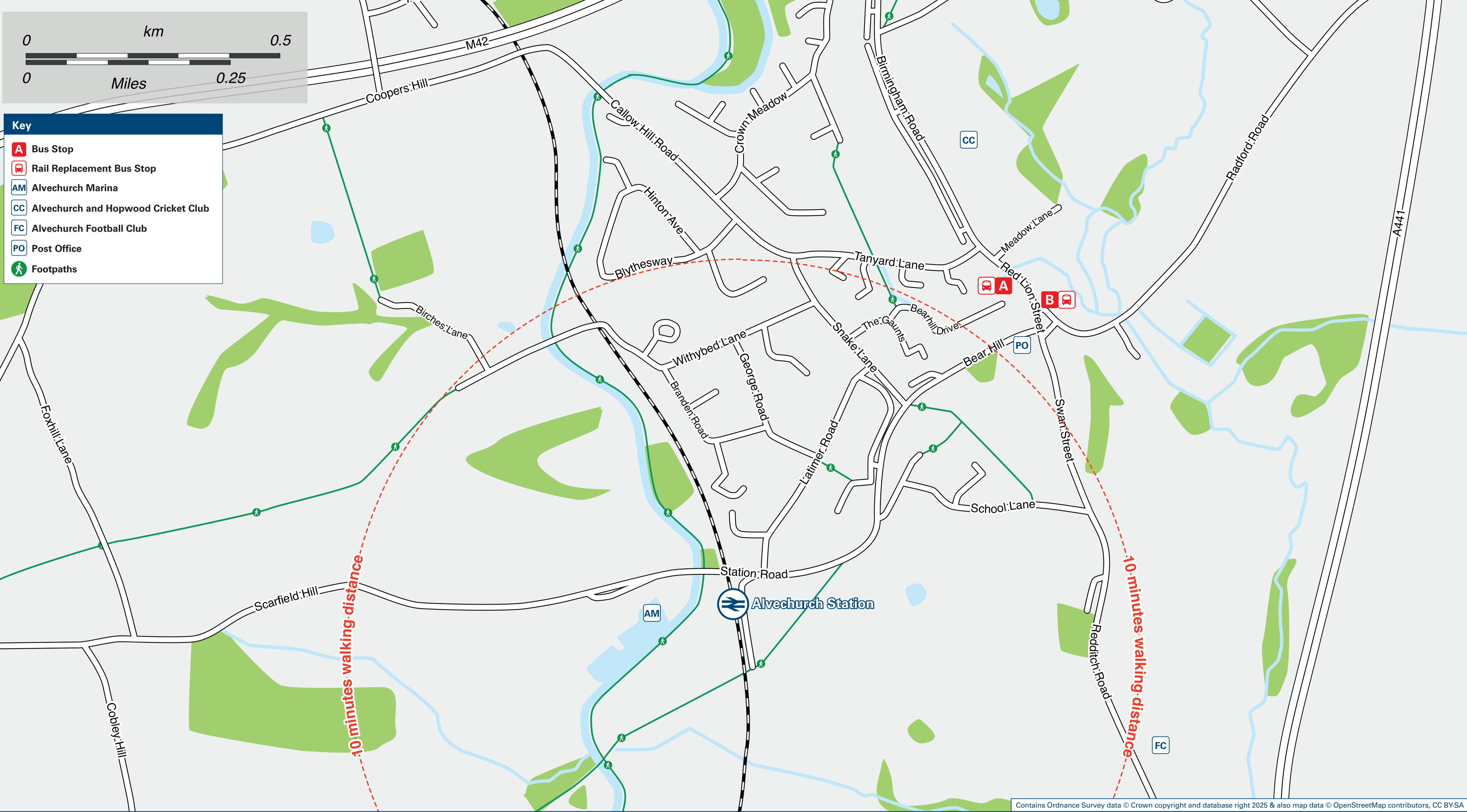




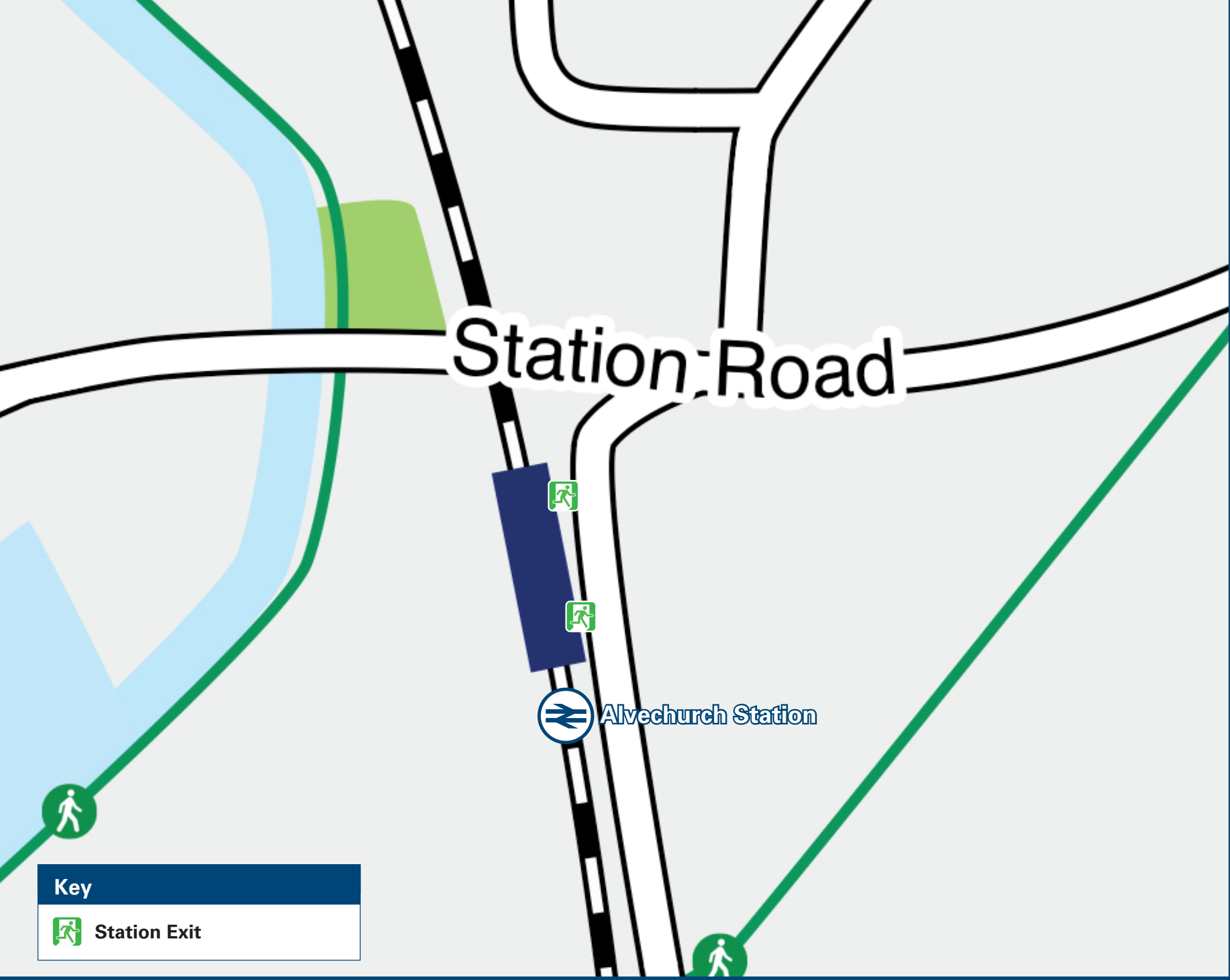
Alvechurch Station
